BACK HOME: After splitting last week's series at Carolina, the FredNats are eliminated from first half contention in the Carolina League North Division. This week, FXBG plays a familiar foe, the Down East Wood Ducks, Single-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers. This is the third series of the first half between the two, with FXBG winning the first one at home four games to two, and Down East returning the favor in Kinston three weeks ago. The first three games of this week are the final three games of the first half, and then the weekend games will start the 66-game second half of this 132-game slate for FXBG. Seth Shuman makes the first of two starts this week for Fredericksburg.

ABOUT LAST WEEK: The FredNats dropped the first two games of the series with Carolina, but then ripped off three straights wins to split the six-game set. FXBG mounted a major comeback on Saturday in the 9th inning, turning a two-run deficit into a two-run lead after cluch RBIs from Brandon Pimentel and Roismar Quintana. The pitching staff spun its fourth shutout of the season in a 1-0 victory on Thursday as well. Pitching prospects Travis Sykora and Jarlin Susana continue to enjoy strong stretches for FXBG on the mound in the starting rotation.

UNBEATEN AFTER 7: The FredNats remain a perfect 26-0 when leading after seven this year, and also a perfect 27-0 when leading after eight innings. The winning formula all season has been the offense taking a lead in the middle innings, and the bullpen holding onto that lead each time.

BIG INNINGS: The last two wins, Fredericksburg has used a four-run inning to spring themselves to victory. On Friday, it was four runs in the 2nd inning that was the difference in a 5-2 victory, and in last night's come-from-behind victory, FXBG scored four runs in the 9th inning to turn a two-run 9th inning deficit into a two-run victory.

OH SUSANA: After a very rough month of May, Jarlin Susana has turned his season around big time in his last three starts. In those starts, he's covered 15 innings, allowed just two total runs, and has 24 strikeouts to only seven walks. Susana's strike throwing and overall effectiveness with his plus stuff has vastly improved throughout this season.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 24-5 this season when scoring first, including 21 out of the last 22 wins. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses the last two weeks, and has scored first in its last three wins, and two of them on the last road trip against Down East. The Freddies have scored first in two out of the last three wins against the Mudcats.

RBI KING: Brandon Pimentel continues to lead the Carolina League in RBI with 51. This year, Pimentel is hitting .355 with runners in scoring position, and is 12-for-27 (.444) with runners in scoring position and two outs. He's also 5-for-8 with three doubles, two home runs and 18 RBI with the bases loaded this season, being at his very best with the stakes high.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 174-149 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Seth Shuman continues his rehab assignment with the Fredericksburg Nationals tonight, making his third start with FXBG

Shuman was in the midst of a strong season in the Wilmington rotation in 2022, before needing Tommy John surgery that summer. The right-hander had made 14 starts for the Blue Rocks, and sportted a 3.23 ERA across 61.1 IP. Shuman struck out 55 batters against just 14 walks, and opponents hit just .238 against him.

CROSS COUNTRY: Shuman was initially drafted by the Oakland Athletics, in the 6th round of the 2019 MLB draft. He impressed with the Lansing Lugnuts in 2021 with a 2.25 ERA in 11 appearances (eight starts), before Washington acquired him in a trade with the A's. The Nats sent Yan Gomes and Josh Harrison out west for Shuman, Drew Millas, and Richard Guasch.

GO EAGLES: Seth played three years for the Georgia Southern Eagles, and was almost exclusively in the starting rotation. Shuman amassed 246.1 innings from 2017-2019, posting a 22-10 record with a 3.95 ERA. He walked just 66 men in that span, a trait that has followed him into his pro career.

LAST TIME OUT: Shuman fired three scoreless innings against Carolina last week, scattering two base hits and not walking anyone, while striking out a pair of Mudcats.
