FRES-NOTES

DOUBLE FEATURE: Jack Natili and Ronny Ugarte both went deep against Inland Empire on Aug. 28, Fresno's first multi-homer game against the 66ers in 10 meetings. Natili is hitting .333 with a 1.333 OPS in two games against Inland Empire, while Ugarte has added a .273 average and a .969 OPS of his own in the series. After managing just two home runs across the first seven meetings with Inland Empire this season, Fresno's power came back to life down the stretch — three homers in the last three games, with Friday's homers helping erase an early four-run deficit.

AHEAD OF THE GAME: The Grizzlies Friday night win secured at least a .500 record below the Grapevine this season with two road games left in the regular season. Fresno is 32-26 overall against the South Division this year with a 17-13 mark at home and currently a 15-13 record on the road. Fresno carries a 6-4 edge in the season series with Inland Empire into the final two meetings this year, needing just one more win to lock up the season series against the 66ers outright. The Grizzlies hold a winning head-to-head mark against three of the four South clubs — Inland Empire (6-4), Lake Elsinore (7-5) and Ontario (10-8) — while splitting even with Rancho Cucamonga (9-9).

STRIKING DISTANCE: Fresno's pitching staff has racked up 1,247 strikeouts this season, third-most in the California League behind only Rancho Cucamonga and Ontario. Grizzlies pitchers struck out 15 in each of the last two games, the 10th and 11th times this season the staff has hit that mark in a single outing. Those 30 strikeouts over the last two games against Inland Empire are part of a stretch that's produced five double-digit strikeout performances in the last eight games, a run that's pushed Fresno within shouting distance of the league's strikeout leaders as the season winds down.
