Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fourth in a six-game series with the Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds, playing the 13th game in a 22-game season series. The Lugnuts have won seven of their last 10 games and are three games back of division-leading Lake County and one game behind West Michigan and Great Lakes in the East Division with 12 games remaining in the first half.

On the Air: Today's game can be seen on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with the audio stream on StreamGuys with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa on the call.

Last Night: Dragons 4, Lugnuts 0. Johnathan Harmon fired seven scoreless innings, scattering five singles, and Victor Acosta lined a two-run homer to lift Dayton to a second consecutive victory. Colby Halter went 2-for-2 with a walk and Jonny Butler finished 2-for-4 in the losing effort for Lansing. The game was completed in a swift two hours and five minutes.

On Deck: The Nuts and Dragons play through Sunday, and then Lansing returns home for a six-game series with 2023 champion Cedar Rapids from June 11-16.

In Case of a Tie: Should the Lugnuts finish the first half in a tie atop the East Division, the tiebreakers would work as follows:

1. Best overall winning percentage: At this time, Lansing, Lake County, Great Lakes and West Michigan have all played

- the same number of games with no games canceled, so a tie would leave the teams with the same winning percentage.

 2. Head-to-head record: the Lugnuts win the tiebreaker against Lake County (8-4); but Great Lakes (6-6) and West Michigan
- 2. Head-to-head record: the Lugnuts win the tiebreaker against Lake County (8-4); but Great Lakes (6-6) and West Michigan (0-0) are not decided here, so we move to...
- **3. Best overall winning percentage over the past 20 games:** Over the last 20 games, West Michigan is 14-6, Lansing and Lake County are both 11-9 and Great Lakes is 9-11. The Whitecaps thus have a leg up... but 13 games still remain and Lake County maintains a two-game lead over Great Lakes and West Michigan and a three-game lead over Lansing.

Series Analysis:

- The Lugnuts are 5-7 against the Dragons this season in large part due to gems from Dayton's starters, who have combined to post a 2.89 ERA in 56 innings; the Dragons' bullpen, however, has a 7.53 ERA against the Lansing lineup, allowing 41 earned runs in 49 innings. In the current series, Dayton's three starters Ryan Cardona, Javi Rivera and Johnathan Harmon have combined to allow only one run in 19 innings, while the Nuts' series-opening win was accomplished with nine runs in 1 2/3 innings against reliever Brock Bell.
- In the five Nuts wins against the Dragons, Lansing has scored 1 run, 11 runs, 9 runs, 10 runs and 9 runs. In their seven losses, the Lugnuts have scored 5 runs, 6 runs, 3 runs, 10 runs, 4 runs, 1 run and 0 runs.

Henry at the Bat: Center fielder Henry Bolte has struck out four times in each of the first three games of this series and has fanned in each of his last nine at-bats. The longest consecutive strikeout streak for a Lugnuts batter occurred from August 19-September 3, 2022, when Lazaro Armenteros struck out in 10 consecutive at-bats, broken here in Dayton with a groundout to shortstop. (He then struck out in his next five straight at-bats.) Bolte is 6th in Minor League Baseball with 81 strikeouts in 52 games (a category led by former Dayton Dragon Rece Hinds at the MiLB level, with 91 K's in 54 games for Louisville, and by former Dayton Dragon Elly De La Cruz at the MLB level, with 84 K's in 63 games for Cincinnati, followed by Reds teammate and former Lake County Captain Will Benson's 83 K's in 60 games). Back to Bolte: when the 20-year-old has made contact this year, he is hitting a cool .353 (55-for-156), and his 47 runs scored is tied for 4th in all of Minor League Baseball.

A'round the A's Farm: 18-year-old 2023 third-rounder **Steven Echavarria** turned in his finest professional outing, tossing four scoreless one-hit innings while striking out five batters in a 3-0 Stockton Ports shutout of San Jose... **Daniel Susac** was hitting below .200 two weeks into May, but he collected his third three-hit game of the season last night in a 6-5 Midland win over San Antonio, raising his batting average to .259; the 2023 Midwest League batting champ has 22 hits in his last 68 at-bats (.324).

In a Nutshell: One of five undrafted free agents on the Nuts, joining pitchers Dylan Hall and Jack Owen, infielder Casey Yamauchi and outfielder Cameron Masterman... last Iowa player to suit up for Lansing: former Major League lefty Matt Dermody... started the Crosstown Showdown against Michigan State and tossed four scoreless two-hit innings in 18-0 win, April 3... notable splits:

- Home: 2.21 ERA, 0.98 WHIP in 20 1/3 IP | Road: 6.39 ERA, 1.58 WHIP in 12 2/3 IP
- Starter: 0.84 ERA, 1.03 WHIP in 21 1/3 IP | Reliever: 9.26 ERA, 1.54 WHIP in 11 2/3 IP
- vs. lefties: .262/.348/.426, 3 HR, 8 BB, 14 K | vs. righties: .200/.235/.323, 2 HR, 3 BB, 15 K

Family of Athletes: Father, Rob, played college baseball at Central College of Iowa, located in his hometown of Pella, as did both of his brothers, Jordan and Blake; his mother, Shannon, played golf in college.

At Pella High School: 2016 lowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-lowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

International Stage: With lowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams... can often be seen at this time of year wearing his Boston Bruins Patrice Bergeron uniform.


Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.

2023 Retrospective: Opened the campaign pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win... finished with 18 appearances, 84 1/3 IP.
