YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels picked up their sixth consecutive win, beating the Fightin Phils, 14-5. **Marco Luciano** opened the scoring with an RBI double in the third. **Shane Matheny** added an RBI double and **Andy Thomas** hit a two-run homer later in the frame to open a 4-0 lead. In the third, Reading's Cody Roberts cut the score to 4-2 with a two-run homer. **Logan Wyatt** hit a solo homer, his second at Double-A, in the sixth to extend the lead to 5-2. Reading tied the game, 5-5, in the bottom of the sixth when Ethan Wilson hit a two-run triple and scored on an error. The Flying Squirrels scored seven runs in the seventh to pull ahead, 12-5. **Vaun Brown** hit a go-ahead, two-run homer. **Carter Williams** brought in a run with a gorundout, Wyatt hit a two-run double in the frame. Wyatt added an RBI groundout in the eighth and Brown plated a run with a double in the ninth to extend the Flying Squirrels' advantage to 14-6. **Matt Frisbee** picked up his sixth win, tying the league lead. **Wil Jensen** worked the final three frames and was credited with his first professional save.

TUDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. This series is the second of the year between the two teams. The Flying Squirrels opened the season with a three-game sweep against the Fightin Phils at The Diamond on April 8 and 9.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 33-36 in the first half, finishing in fourth place in the Southwest Division. They were 14-7 through their first 21 games but are 20-29 since May 3. However, they have won six straight, their longest winning streak of the year. It is their longest winning streak since they won seven straight from April 28-May 5, 2022. Over the last six games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .313 (62-for-198) with seven homers, 17 doubles and have scored 43 runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels 3.80 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 254.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 353.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.29 ERA, which is the lowest in Double-A and is fifth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS were 28-40 in the first half of the season, which was last in the Eastern League. Last week, Reading won four-of-six at Portland, including three straight wins to open the series, which tied their longest win streak of the season. The Fightin Phils opened the season 0-5, including a three-game sweep at The Diamond to begin the year. The Reading offense leads the league in batting average (.265), hits (629), total bases (1027), triples (16), OBP (.352) and OPS (.784). Reading's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Philles prospects, including RHP Mick Abel (No. 2), RHP Griff McGarry (No. 4), OF Johan Rojas (No. 5), OF Ethan Wilson (No. 11), OF Carlos De La Cruz (No. 17) and OF Jhailyn Ortiz (No. 22). McGarry is rated by Baseball America as having the best fastball, Ortiz is rated as having the best outfield arm and Baron Radcliff is rated as the best power hitter. MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospect list includes Abel (No. 2), McGarry (No. 4), Rojas (No. 6), De La Cruz (No. 9), Wilson (No. 14) and Ortiz (No. 18).

FOR RICHMONE: Right-hander Landen Roupp makes his 10th start of the season and the first of his career against the Fightin Phils. He last pitched on Saturday against the Senators and allowed one run over four innings with four strikeouts. In his nine starts this year, Roupp has worked three scoreless outings and six starts allowing one run. His 1.95 ERA is seventh-lowest in the Eastern League (min. 25 IP). In his first full professional season in 2022, Roupp climbed three levels in the Giants system. He began the year working primarily as a reliever with Low-A San Jose, going 5-2 with a 2.59 ERA in 140 utings. Roupp moved to High-A Eugene in late-June for seven starts, going 3-0 with a 1.67 ERA. He was promoted to Richmond on August 18 for the remainder of the season and went 2-1 with a 3.76 ERA in five starts. Roupp made one start against the SeaWolves last year, allowing two runs over five innings in his final outing of the year on September 15 at The Diamond. Roupp was selected by the Giants in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of UNC Wilmington, where he was the 2021 CAA Pitcher of the Year. For more on Roupp, see page two.

FOR READING: Right-hander Griff McGarry makes his ninth start of the season and his eighth with the Fightin Phils. Last time out, he worked 3.2 innings and allowed one run in a no-decision at Portland last Thursday. Over his last three starts since June 10, McGarry has posted a 2.53 ERA (3 ER/10.2 IP). On June 10, he worked five hitless innings against the Rumble Ponies and set a season high with eight strikeouts. McGarry began the season on the injured list and made one start for Low-A Clearwater on a rehab assignment on May 5. He joined the Fightin Phils on May 11. McGarry, a San Francisco native, was selected in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Phillies out of the University of Virginia. He was originally drafted by the Rangers in the 31st round in 2017 but opted to head to Charlottesville for his collegiate career. He pitched four seasons for the Cavaliers from 2018-2021. In the 2021 College World Series, McGarry took a no-hitter into the eighth inning against eventual champs Mississippi State in a game Virginia ended up losing. He first reached Double-A last year and went 1-3 with a 2.20 ERA in eight outings. He made his Double-A debut at The Diamond on July 6, 2022 and allowed three runs in 2.1 innings in a loss. He also made seven relief appearances for Triple-A Lehigh Valley to close out the season. McGarry is rated by Baseball America and MLB.com as the No. 4 Phillies prospect.

VAUN GONE WILD: Youn Brown is riding a six-game hit streak since June 22. He has homered three times in that stretch, includ-ing home runs in each of the first two games of this week's series. In his last six games, Brown is batting .333 (9-for-27) with three homers, two doubles and nine RBIs, adding two stolen bases. Over his previous nine games from June 9-20, Brown hit .057 (2-for-35) with three walks and 16 strikeouts.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Since his promotion to Double-A on June 13, Logan Wyatt is batting .321 (9-for-28) with two homers, two doubles and six RBIs. Between his time with High-A Eugene and with Richmond, Wyatt has homered 10 times this season in 61 games. Wyatt hit his first Double-A homer last Friday at The Diamond against the Senators. He hit his second Double-A home run on Thursday night at Reading and finished the game with four RBIs, which tied his career high.

RETURN OF THE MECK: In Game 1 of last Friday's doubleheader, **Wade Meckler** closed his historic performance with a two-run, walk-off single, giving the Flying Squirrels a 9-8 win in extras. Meckler went 5-for-5 and tied the single-game franchise record for hits. It was the 11th time a Richmond player has collected five hits in a game. In that game, Meckler set a new career high for hits and tied his career high with four RBIs. In the first two games of this week's series, Meckler has reached base eight times with six hits, including four on Thursday, and two walks. Meckler has now reached base in all 18 of his Double-A games, including 28 hits and 24 walks. His on-base streak is the second-longest active streak in the league and the longest by a Richmond player this season. Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 170 PA) this season with a .427 batting average and third in OBP (.494).

LOVE LUCI: On June 4, Marco Luciano hit a grand slam and a two-run homer in the Flying Squirrels' 11-2 win. It was the fourth multi-homer game of his career. He went deep again with a two-run homer on Sunday afternoon and added a 432-foot, op-posite-field two-run shot last Wednesday at Bowie. Luciano leads the team with 10 homers this year. He went on a five-game hit streak from June 10-14, during which he hit .588 (10-for-17) with four homers, a double, five walks and 10 RBIs. After going 1-for-20 over his next five games, Luciano has picked up eight hits in his last five games, including going 4-for-4 on Saturday and hitting a solo home run on Sunday.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: In his last four games since Saturday, Andy Thomas has driven in nine runs. On Saturday, he hit a two-run double in the first inning and added an RBI single in the seventh. On Sunday, Thomas again opened the scoring with a two-double in the third inning. In the first game of this week's series on Wednesday, he hit a two-run triple in the first inning, the first triple of his professional career. He hit a two-run homer on Thursday night. For the year, Thomas leads the team with 36 RBIs. He has driven in three-or-more runs three times, including a season-high four RBIs on May 28 at Binghamton.

RAGIN' CANTRELLE: In his last 11 games since June 14, **Hayden Cantrelle** has reached base 19 times, posting a .442 on-base percentage. In that stretch, he has picked up eight hits, walked nine times and been hit by a pitch twice in 43 plate appearances. This season, he has been hit by a pitch 13 times, the most in the Eastern League. He also ranks sixth in the league in on-base percentage (.395) and seventh in walks (44). He is also second among Giants minor leaguers in walks for the year.

DLD FRIENDS: Reading's roster includes former Flying Squirrels pitcher Matt Seelinger, who played with Richmond in 2021. The reliever spent that entire season with the Flying Squirrels, going 3-1 with a 3.07 ERA in 36 appearances. He was selected by the Phillies in the minor-league phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft. With Reading last year, Seelinger pitched against Richmond twice, both at The Diamond, and allowed one unearned run over 2.2 innings of work with four strikeouts. Seelinger is one of four former Richmond players in the Eastern League this year. Frankie Tostado, who was with the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is playing with the Senators. Diego Rincones, who was with the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for the Erie SeaWolves. Pitcher Grey Fenter, a member of the 2022 Flying Squirrels, is now with the Somerset Patriots

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Hayden Cantrelle is sixth in OBP (.395) and seventh in walks (44). Tyler Fitzger-ald is tied for third in triples (3). Carson Seymour is eighth in ERA (3.43), eighth in BAA (.225) and eighth in WHIP (1.20). Matt Frisbee is tied for first in wins (6). Mason Black is tied for first in starts (14).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 2), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 6), OF Vaun Brown (No. 8), RHP Mason Black (No. 9), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 14), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 15), OF Wade Meckler (No. 16), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 27) and RHP José Cruz (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Luciano as the best power hitter, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. Luciano is also ranked as Baseball America's No. 55-overall prospect. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes nine Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2), Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29). Luciano is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in baseball.
