#### ROSARIO MULTI-HR GAME NOT ENOUGH

Dalvy Rosario recorded his first career multi-homer game and Janson Junk allowed just one run in 6.0 innings on Saturday, but the Jumbo Shrimp faltered late in a 6-4 loss to the Bulls. Rosario broke a scoreless tie in the fifth, but Durham got the run back on **Brock Jones'** RBI double in the bottom of the fifth. Jacksonville plated three in the seventh, two from Rosario's second long ball of the game. However, in the bottom of the seventh, Tristan Peters notched an RBI single before the Bulls took the lead for good on a three-run homer from Jamie Westbrook. They added one more in the eighth to set the final margin at 6-4.

#### **BULL-Y PULPIT**

Jacksonville came into this set with Durham riding high, leading the minor leagues with 21 wins and coming off their second sweep of the season. Five days later, the Jumbo Shrimp are on a five-game losing streak - their longest skid since May 29-June 2 of last season, which ironically all came against the Bulls. Jacksonville is in jeopardy of being swept for the first time since Scranton/Wilkes-Barre broomed them in a six-game set from April 30-May 5, 2024. The Jumbo Shrimp have been outscored 37-15 during this current five-game losing streak.

#### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Of the Jumbo Shrimp's last 23 games, a whopping 19 have been decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 13-6 (.684) in these closely-decided affairs during this stretch. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 15-7 (.682) in games decided by no more than three runs, including a 10-3 (.769) mark in one-run games. Those 10 one-run victories are the most of any team in the minors.

#### MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 20 of their last 31 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have five games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte: Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp currently rank third in the minor leagues and first Triple-A with 81 stolen bases.

#### HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp are an extraordinary 16-2 at home this season, outscoring their opponents by a nearly 2:1 margin at 83-46 at VyStar Ballpark. Of the other 119 teams in Minor League Baseball, only one has even 14 home triumphs. The road, however, for Jacksonville has been a different story. The Jumbo Shrimp are 5-9 on the road, getting outscored by a 77-57 margin. Jacksonville has a team OPS of .767 and at home compared to .675 on the road. Their team ERA is 2.05 at home and 5.19 on the road

#### **JACK OF ALL TRADES**

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Jack Winkler played in just four of the club's first 11 games, going just 2-for-14 with seven strikeouts at the plate. The Littleton, Colo., native has appeared in 16 games since then, racking up seven multi-hit games. Over his last 16 contests, Winkler is 24-for-57 at the plate, slashing .421/.450/.596/1.046 with four doubles, two home runs, six RBIs, three walks, 10 runs scored and eight stolen bases.

#### A WEEK TO FORGET

Jacksonville relievers came into this series leading Triple-A in ERA by more than a full run at 2.40. The club's starting pitchers combined for a 2.86 ERA, good enough for second at the level. Jumbo Shrimp pitching has really struggled during this five-game series against the Bulls, yielding a total of 37 runs (7.4 per game) compared to 86 (3.2 per game) in the first 27 contests of the season. The Jacksonville bullpen has combined to surrender 22 runs, all earned, on 28 hits in 22.1 innings for an 8.87 ERA (7 BB, 27 K). Meanwhile, Jumbo Shrimp starters have gone a combined 17.2 innings in the five games, yielding 15 runs, 14 earned, on 15 hits for a 7.13 ERA (12 BB. 17 K).

#### SHRIMP BITES

Jakob Marsee leads the IL with 20 stolen bases. The two players in second place have 14 steals, meaning they are as close to Marsee in first place as to the eight players tied for 14th place with eight swipes... Maximo Acosta (T-4th, 12 SB). Troy Johnston (T-10th. 9 SB) and Andrew Pintar (T-10th. 9 SB) also rank in the IL top 10 in steals... The Jumbo Shrimp are taking the extra base on a hit 48.1 percent of the time, well above the MLB average of 42.0 percent.

#### ABOUT ROBINSON

-A native of San Cristobal in the Dominican Republic, Piña was originally signed by the Los Angeles Angels as an international free agent on February 15, 2017.

-Following the 2023 season, Piña elected free agency. He signed with the Philadelphia Phillies as a minor league free agent and spent the 2024 campaign between Double-A Reading and Triple-A Lehigh Valley.

#### 2024 SEASON

-Piña posted major platoon splits; While he held right-handed hitters to a .195/.245/.312/.557 batting line in 249 plate appearances, left-handed batters hit .324/.366/.591/.957 against him over 303 plate appearances.

-Piña posted an 8-2 record and 3.50 ERA over 12 starts during the season's first half (61.2 IP, 65 H, 8 BB, 70 K, .262 BAA). However, over 13 starts in the second half of the year, he went 5-6 with a 4.79 ERA (67.2 IP, 71 H, 19 BB, 62 K, .269 BAA)

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .279/.329/.487/.816 against Piña. Those figures dropped to .245/.285/.431/.716 with runners on and .217/.246/.433/.679 with runners in scoring position.

#### 2023 SEASON

-Piña posted fairly similar platoon splits, actually faring slightly better against left-handed hitting (.225/.338/.318/.656 in 213 plate appearances). Right-handed hitters batted .242/.351/.320/.671 against him over 210 plate appearances.

-With the bases empty, Piña held opponents to a .205/.323/.274/.597 line in 219 plate appearances. With runners on, however, that swelled to .267/.369/.373/.742 over 205 plate appearances.
