THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On July 6, 2017, infielder Renato Nunez knocked two homers to pad his PCL league lead to 24. He went 3-for-5 overall and drove in 5 runs in the 11-7 win over Colorado Springs.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds travel to Gwinnett, Georgia to begin a seven-game series in six days. The two teams have played 11 games against each other so far in 2021. Tonight, left-hander Ethan Small starts for Nashville against right-hander Nolan Kingham for Gwinnett.

Ethan Small: 24-year-old Ethan Small gets the ball for Nashville tonight. The left-hander is making his third start with the Sounds and is 0-0 with a 2.08 ERA. In 8.2 innings with Nashville, Small has allowed 2 runs on 6 hits. He has issued 7 walks to go along with 5 strikeouts. The southpaw was recently promoted from Double-A Biloxi where he went 2-2 with a 1.96 ERA in 8 starts. In 41.1 innings with the Shuckers, Small allowed 10 runs on 26 hits and racked up 67 strikeouts. He held Double-A hitters to a .184 batting average. Small was recently named as a participant in the MLB All-Star Futures Game. The Spring Hill, Tennessee resident was drafted by the Brewers in the 1st round (28th overall) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State University where he garnered multiple national accolades as a junior.

Nolan Kingham: 24-year-old Nolan Kingham starts for Gwinnett in the opener. The right-hander is making his 11th start of the season and 2nd with Gwinnett. Kingham joined the Stripers on June 29 and made his Triple-A debut against Durham that night. He allowed a season-high 6 runs on 9 hits and was tagged with the loss. In nine starts with Double-A Mississippi, Kingham went 5-1 with a 2.29 ERA. In 55.0 innings with the M-Braves, he allowed 48 hits and 9 walks to go along with 37 strikeouts. Kingham is the brother of former big leaguer Nick Kingham of the Pirates and Blue Jays. He was drafted by the Braves in the 12th round of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 21, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

On the Road Again: Nashville plays its first game on the road since June 20 when they were at Gwinnett. At 14-8, the Sounds have played the fewest road games in the Triple-A East. Nashville's pitching has been superb on the road with a 3.35 ERA. In 185.1 innings on the road, Nashville pitchers have held opponents to a .185 batting average with 221 strikeouts compared to 82 walks.

Success Against the Stripers: Two Nashville hitters have done heavy damage against the Stripers. In five games against Gwinnett, infielder Jamie Westbrook is hitting .474 (9-for-19) with 4 runs, 3 doubles, 2 RBI and 3 walks. In 10 games against the Stripers, infielder Zach Green is hitting .316 (12-for-38) with 4 runs, 4 doubles, 1 home run, 7 RBI and 2 walks.

Wilson's World: Infielder/outfielder Weston Wilson has hit safely in 10 of his last 12 games dating back to June 22. During the torrid stretch, Wilson is hitting .348 (16-for-46) with 7 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 4 home runs, 8 RBI and 4 walks. Hit batting average has gone from .218 to .263.

Loud Bark: Reliever Luke Barker picked up on Friday where he left off in June. Barker delivered 2.0 innings and did not allow an earned run in his third win of the season. In 11 appearances in the month of June, Barker went 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1 ER/12.0 IP). He held opponents to a .075 batting average and recorded 18 strikeouts without issuing a walk.

Start Me Up: Nashville's starting pitchers have done their part the last nine times out. Since June 25, all starters have allowed two or less runs in their starts. During the nine-game stretch, Nashville starters are 2-0 with a 1.81 ERA. In 49.2 innings, they have allowed 36 hits and 13 walks to go along with 42 strikeouts. However, the Sounds are just 5-4 during the stretch and Bowden Francis is the lone starter to notch a win (June 29 vs. Louisville and July 4 vs. Louisville).

COOOOOP: Sounds outfielder Cooper Hummel collected two walks on Sunday and has now reached safely in 15 consecutive games. Since the streak began on June 17, Hummel is hitting .353 (18-for-54) with 11 runs, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 3 home runs, 8 RBI and 10 walks.

Westbrook Finds A Way: Infielder/outfielder Jamie Westbrook has reached base safely in 19 consecutive games and has hit safely in 17 of those games. Since June 8 when the streak started, he is hitting .387 (29-for-75) with 14 runs, 8 doubles, 3 home runs, 18 RBI and 5 walks. His on-base percentage during the 19 games is .434.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,064-1,944. The 2,064 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

LAST OUTING: Small made his second start with Nashville on June 30 vs. Louisville. He tossed 6.0 shutout innings and struck out four. It was his third quality start of the season. He tied a career-high with 96 pitches and set a career-high with 69 strikes. He got a no-decision in Nashville's 2-1 loss.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Small is making his first career appearance against Gwinnett.
