- COMEBACK FALLS JUST SHORT: The Augusta GreenJackets three game
 winning streak came to end on Wednesday as the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers
 held on in the final inning despite a great rally effort where the GreenJackets
 scored three times and put the tying run at third with the winning run at
 second but they were left stranded there as Augusta fell just short 7-6.
- DURBIN RACKING UP THE RBIS: Caleb Durbin made it back-to-back games with two RBIs as he remains the club leader in runs batted in with 28 and is currently ranked seventh in all the Carolina League in that department.
- CONLEY HEATING UP: Cal Conley like Caleb Durbin also has two RBIs in back-to-back games and is coming off a nice month of May on the base paths as the Augusta shortstop scored 21 times during the month, which was third best in the league during that stretch. Conley has touched home a total of 34 time, good for the fourth best mark in the league.
- VARGAS CARRIES THE TORCH: Despite taking the loss on Wednesday, Luis Vargas delivered one of the best starts of his young career dealing six innings with nine Ks. Over the last five games, the Augusta starters have combined for 27.2 innings, allowing just 7 runs (2.32 ERA) with 27 Ks and 3 BBs.
- START A NEW STREAK: Landon Leach gets the ball for game three as the GreenJackets three game win streak eight-gamer against the Cannon Ballers ended following Wednesday's loss.

CURRENT NOTES: (4/29 vs DEL) Tossed 5.2 innings and came up one out short of back-to-back quality starts but earned his first win by allowing just two runs, leading Augusta to a 6-4 win. (4/24 vs FAY) Tossed the first Quality Start of the Season for Augusta by throwing 6, magnificent innings allowing just one batter over the minimum while striking out a season-best 8 batters. (4/12 @ MB) Made his first start of the season and impressed by pitching five, shutout innings with 7 strikeouts. Released by the Minnesota Twins on February 18, 2022. Agreed to a minor-league contract with the Atlanta Braves on March 16 and will begin season in Augusta.

2021: Began 2021 with the GCL Twins. Made 3 short starts before being promoted to the Fort Meyer Mighty Muscle (Twins Low-A). Made 6 starts for Fort Meyers but ran into problem with his command during the month of July and struggled to go deep into games. Was moved to the bullpen for the final month of the season and had 3 total outings where he allowed 6 earned runs in 8 innings. Leach finished the season with a 6.06 ERA in 12 total appearances between the FCL Twins and Fort Meyers with 33 strikeouts and 26 walks in 35.2 innings.

CAREER: Drafted by the Minnesota Twins in the 2nd round and 37th overall pick in the 2017 MLB Draft. Was assigned to the GCL Twins following his selection and pitched well during his brief season there. Made 5 appearances with 2 starts and finished with a 2-0 record with both of wins coming in relief. Showed his potential in his best outing when he struck out 5 in 3 innings of relief against the Red Sox affiliate on August 11. Pitched for the GCL Twins again in 2018 but missed most of the season due to a significant injury and was also out all of 2019. Did not pitch in 2020 due to COVID-19.

HIGH SCHOOL: Played at Pickering High School in Ajax, Ontario. Was regarded as one of the top amateur pitchers in Canada due to a dominate fastball that worked low-mid 90's and topping at 96 while complimenting that with a slider and change up. Had the attention of professional scouts as a high draft pick in 2017. He committed to the University of Texas but ultimately was drafted by the Twins and elected to go to the pros rather than college.

Picked up 31 strikeouts and 9 walks with 21 hits allowed. Was put onto the injured list on May 13 and was not activated off until July 9. Assumed the role as the team's closer upon his return from the injured list as he converted 3 saves each in the months of August and September. Finished the season strong by not allowing any runs in his final 7 appearances and just once in his final 10.

CAREER: Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 20th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Catawba College (NC). Started the 2019 after being drafted with the GCL Braves before being promoted to the Danville Braves (Rookie) for the rest of the season. Had an up-and-down first season in the Braves Organization as he posted a 6.23 ERA in 13 appearances with Danville. His first 4 outings were starts before transitioning to his more natural position as a bullpen arm where he settled in with a 3.55 ERA in 9 appearances and 15.2 innings. Did not pitch in 2020 due to COVID-19 Pandemic.

COLLEGE: Began college career at Pfeiffer University in Misenheimer, North Carolina. Finished his freshman season with a 2.08 ERA in 16 outings all in relief. He collected a team-best 7 saves with a .188 batting average against him. Transferred to Catawba College in Salisbury, North Carolina after one season at Pfeiffer and continued dominated. In his one season at Catawba, made 31 appearances for the Indians as he paced the pitching staff with a 2.43 ERA and 31 appearances that covered 37 innings. Struck out 55 batters with 17 walks while opponents hit just .181 against him. Williams became 28th player drafted in Catawba program history and 2nd player from the school that was drafted by the Braves joining Brian Boltz who was a 2nd round pick in 1989.

Was 3/3 on his save opportunities Was used as an opener as both of his starts as he pitched just 3 innings in his first start at Charleston on August 4 and 1 inning in his second start vs Columbia on September 12. Was one of the most dependable arms out of the bullpen for the GreenJackets as he allowed 1 or 0 runs in 25 of his 31 outings. Showed strong strikeout ability with 62 punch-outs in 47.2 innings of work to earn a K/9 of 11.8 Had 11 appearances with 3 strikeouts or more including a very impressive outing against Columbia on June 16 where he struck out 6 Fireflies in 2 innings.

CAREER: Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 29th round of the 2019 MLB Draft. Did not pitch at all in 2019 due to injury and was on the 60-day IL all season. Did not pitch in 2020 due to COVID-19 pandemic.

COLLEGE: Played two seasons at the University of Oregon for coach George Horton... As a sophomore in 2018, he finished with a 2-2 record, 6.65 earned runs average, and 31 strikeouts over 44.2 innings thrown... As a true freshman in 2017, he appeared in 19 games, finishing with a 1-1 record, 3.81 earned runs average, and 22 strikeouts over 26 innings pitched. Transferred to Azusa Pacific University in Azusa, Califromia after his sophomore season where he worked exclusively as a starter. In 7 starts, he earned a 2.51 ERA in 32.1 innings. Collected 28 strikeouts with 10 walks and a batting average against him .233.

2021: Assigned to Augusta at the beginning of the season where he entered as the Braves' No. 24 prospect according to MLB Pipeline but faced a mostly difficult season due to injury. He appeared in 6 total games with 4 starts and only covered 14 innings during that time. Owens finished the season with a 7.07 ERA and an 0-3 record with a small sample size as his season came to end after one month as he was placed on the injured list on June 10 and never returned after that.

CAREER: Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 13th round of the 2019 MLB Draft. Spent the ensuing season split between the GCL Braves and the Rookie affiliate Danville where he finished the season with a combined 0-3 record with a 4.23 ERA in 10 appearances and 9 starts that covered 27.1 innings. Collected 32 strikeouts throughout the course of the year with 12 walks while holding opponents to an impressive .184 batting average against him. Did not pitch in 2020 due to COVID-19 Pandemic.

HIGH SCHOOL: Played high school baseball at Trinity Catholic in Ocala, Florida, Was the No. 90 ranked recruit nationally by Perfect Game and the No. 31 overall right-handed pitcher. Caught the eyes of scouts due to his strong velocity on his fastball that was consistently around 92-93 mph while topping in the mid-upper 90s. That along with his slider led him to a commitment to the University of Florida. Elected to forgo his scholarship after being draft by the Braves.

2021: Promoted to Augusta fro GCL Braves following COVID year and saw his most work in any professional season, Pena pitched 50.2 innings, doubling his previous high of 25 from his first year in DSL. Was used almost exclusively as a reliever making 26 appearances with one of those being a short start against Myrtle Beach on July 10 where he dealt 3 innings to begin the game. Had a tough start to the season as he allowed earned runs in all 4 of his outings in May but started to settle-in towards the end of the season. Pena finished the year with a 3.35 ERA in the months of August and September combined and started to get a feel for his stuff during that stretch with 23 strikeouts in the two months in 16.1 innings, earning him a 12.8 K/9 during that run.

CAREER: Signed by the Braves as an international free agent in 2017 from the Dominican Republic. Following his signing, the Braves designated him to the Dominican Summer League where he pitched well with a 3.96 ERA in 15 appearances and 25 innings all out of the bullpen. Earned a promotion to the GCL Braves in the 2018 where he continued to work exclusively out of the bullpen. Pitched 23.2 innings in 14 outings with a 5.32 ERA. Pitched in the GCL again in 2019 and improved from the year prior as he dropped his ERA to 1.88. Did not pitch as much in 2018, but saw his strikeout numbers improve in 2019 in the small sample size as he averaged about a strikeout an inning. Did not pitch in 2020 due to COVID-19 Pandemic.
