INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Indy's struggles at Coolray Field continued last night in a 5-3 loss that sealed the series win for the Stripers. The Indians held a 2-1 lead at the midway point, but Gwinnett tied the game in the fifth when Cam Allred beamed Preston Tucker with the bases loaded to force home a run. Indianapolis retook the lead in the sixth on a run-scoring single by Travis Swaggerty that brought home Ji-Hwan Bae who had previously singled and swiped second base. The Stripers used a three-run bottom half, however, to put away Indy. John O'Reilly gave up three consecutive singles to start the frame before uncorking a wild pitch that scored a run. He then reloaded the bases with a walk and issued a second straight free pass to Kramer Robertson to force in another Gwinnett run. Indy's offense failed to produce a baserunner over the final three innings while striking out seven times.

NOT COOL, COOLRAY: The Indians' 5-3 setback last night marked the club's 20th loss in its last 25 games at Coolray Field dating back to the start of the 2018 season. Indy's 5-4 win on Friday night was Indianapolis' first at Coolray Field since July 19, 2018, a 10-3 triumph. That 2018 road win helped Indy avoid a four-game sweep at the hands of the Stripers.

BOUNCE BACK, PART VII: Indianapolis enters today's series finale at Gwinnett with a 31-32 record, marking the seventh time this season where the Indians have fallen one game below .500 (also: 0-1, 1-2, 7-8, 15-16, 16-17, 30-31). The Indians are a perfect 6-0 in contests immediately following the team slipping one game below .500.

MULTI-BAE: With eight multi-hit contests in 15 June games, Ji-Hwan Bae is hitting .333 (21-for-63) for the month. He leads the Indians with 17 multi-hit games this season while his .305 average (67-for-220) is second behind Madris (.308). Last night, Bae went 2-for-4 with a double, run scored and stolen base, his 15th in 21 attempts. Since his average bottomed out at .208 following an 0-for-4 performance on April 26 at Iowa, he has hit .335 (56-for-167) with a .968 OPS in his last 42 games. He is currently ranked among International League leaders in runs scored (2nd, 47), triples (T-5th, 4), total hits (T-6th), stolen bases (T-9th), total bases (10th, 106) and batting average (10th).

OLIVA-IT: Jared Oliva went 1-for-3 with a double and run scored last night to continue his strong month of June, in which he's hit safely in 10 of 12 contests. The speedy outfielder owns a .261 average (12-for-46) and six extra-base hits in June after batting just .221 (17-for-77) with eight extra-base hits through the first two months of the season (26 games).

THE QUARTER CLUB: Bligh Madris laced a second-inning double to extend his on-base streak to 25 games since 5/20 last night. It is the second-longest active streak in the league, following Jake Cave's International League-best 36-gamer for St. Paul. Since the beginning of his on-base streak, Madris has hit safely in 22 of 24 games with an official at-bat and is hitting .386 (34-for-88) with 17 extra-base hits (12 doubles, one triple, four homers), a .465 on-base percentage and 1.147 OPS during the 25-game streak. In 45 games with the Indians this season, Madris leads the team with a .526 slugging percentage and .916 OPS. Madris' 25-game on-base streak is the third-longest by an Indians batter this year, following Canaan Smith-Njigba and Ji-Hwan Bae who each notched 28-game streaks. This is the first time where Indy has had three players with 25-plus on-base streaks in a single season dating back to 2005.

MATTY ICE: Over his last six relief appearances, Matt Eckelman has posted a 1.69 ERA (2er/10.2ip) while yielding 11 hits and two walks with nine strikeouts. During the stretch, he has lowered his season WHIP from 2.76 to 2.06 along with trimming his average against to .336 from .397.

TODAY: The Indians and Stripers conclude their six-game series today at 1:05 PM ET at Coolray Field. Right-hander Mike Burrows is set to make his Triple-A debut against LHP Kyle Muller, Indianapolis has dropped five of its last six games overall after winning four of the first five contests last homestand against Columbus.

BE LIKE MIKE: Mike Burrows, 22, gets the nod in the series finale today for his Triple-A debut after mowing through Eastern League opponents. In his 12 starts with Double-A Altoona this year, Burrows compiled a 4-2 record, 2.94 ERA (17er/52.0ip) and 69 strikeouts against 19 walks. He struck out six-plus batters in eight of his 12 outings, including a season-high nine on 6/8 (1) at Reading (5.0ip). Two starts prior on May 26 at Harrisburg, he whiffed eight batters over a career-high 7.0 shutout innings. At the time of his promotion to Indy, Burrows ranked among league leaders in starts (T-1st), ERA (6th), average against (6th, .199), strikeouts (7th) and WHIP (10th, 1.10). He was selected by Pittsburgh in the 11th round (324th overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Waterford (Conn.) High School and is vying to become the first big leaguer from his high school.

THIS DATE IN 2017: Drew Hutchison improved to 4-2 on the season with a 10-strikeout performance to beat Toledo, 8-2. Despite giving up seven hits, Hutchison held a shutout through his 7.0-inning start. His 10 strikeouts marked his high for the season and was the most since he struck out 10 almost exactly a year before, on June 18 at Lehigh Valley. His 10-K game was one of eight for Indy that season, the other seven coming from Tyler Glasnow.
