Today's Game: The Charleston RiverDogs (affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays) welcome the first half champion Kannapolis Cannon Ballers (affiliate of the Chicago White Sox) to The Joe for a six-game series. Tonight's game is the third installment of the series. The RiverDogs own a 6-5 record against Kannapolis this season. The teams opened the season with a three-game set in Charleston in April. **RiverDogs-Cannon Ballers Season Series in 2024**: Overall: RiverDogs 6, Cannon Ballers 5. At The Joe: RiverDogs 4, Cannon Ballers 1.

Last Time Out: The RiverDogs won another close game on Wednesday night, emerging with a 7-5 win over the Cannon Ballers in the second game of the series. Kannapolis quickly took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning with an RBI triple from George Wolkow. The RiverDogs didn't take long to even the score with a sacrifice fly from Carlos Colmenarez in the second. The big inning came in the RiverDogs third when the offense broke through with a five-spot. Following a 25-minute rain delay, Jake Bockenstedt struggled with his command, walking three of the first four batters to force in a run. Jhon Diaz increased the lead with a ground-rule double to the right field corner. The margin grew to 6-1 with a sacrifice fly from Angel Mateo and RBI single from Raudelis Martinez. Drake Logan connected on a solo home run in the fourth to make it 6-2, but Charleston reestablished a five-run advantage with a Colmenarez run-scoring triple in the fifth. The lead held at 7-2 entering the ninth when Arxy Hernandez pounded a three-run double to bring the tying run to the plate. Gerlin Rosario entered and earned the save by striking out Ronny Hernandez to finish the game.

Twice as Nice: Outfielder Jhon Diaz hit two solo home runs in the second game of a doubleheader on Saturday, providing all the offense in the 3-2 loss. The long balls were his third and fourth of the year since joining the RiverDogs in early June. He became the first player to hit multiple home runs in the same game for the RiverDogs this season. Ryan Cermak was the last player to do so, hitting a pair of home runs in Columbia on August 13, 2023. He has hit three home runs with five RBI in the last four games.

King of Thieves: The RiverDogs have been one of the most prolific base stealing teams in Minor League Baseball this season. The team's total of 240 stolen bases is atop the Carolina League and second in MiLB as a whole, 22 behind the Aberdeen Ironbirds. On July 6, against Myrtle Beach, the team broke the franchise record by going 13-13 in stolen base attempts. Adrian Santana leads the team with 40 stolen bases, ranking second in the league. The franchise record for stole bases in a single season is 255, a mark set in 1997. This year's club is on pace for 351. The current Minor League record for stolen bases in a single season is 372, set by the San Jose Giants in 1974.

Attendance is Mandatory: The RiverDogs currently lead the Carolina League in average attendance for home games this season. The RiverDogs are averaging 4,380 fans per contest, trailing only the Fresno Grizzlies among all 30 Single-A teams in Minor League Baseball. The RiverDogs paced all of Single-A in attendance in 2023 with an average of 4,288 fans per game.

Dreaming of Déjà vu: The RiverDogs turned a last place finish in the first half into a Carolina League championship during the 2023 season. They were the first team since 2007 to accomplish that feat. After a disappointing first half this season, the team is looking to repeat history. The RiverDogs closed the first half with a 27-38 record, tied for last in the south division. They are currently leading the division by 2.5 games over both Fayetteville and Columbia.

It's Not How You Start: The RiverDogs starting rotation has been one of the most successful in the Carolina League. However, the bullpen has struggled to match that performance. The RiverDogs contingent of starting pitchers has combined to post an ERA of 3.16. That number places them in a tie for first among teams in the circuit. On the other hand, the bullpen's ERA has ballooned to 4.63, placing them 11th in the 12-team league.

Prized Pups: The RiverDogs roster currently contains three members of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Rays prospects. The highest-rated is 18-year-old shortstop Adrian Santana who slots in at #6. Sitting at #9, pitcher Santiago Suarez returns to the Holy City after making his full-season debut with the RiverDogs late last season. Finally, pitcher Andrew Lindsey rounds out the list at #29. Lindsey is currently on the injured list.

RIVERDOGS FIELD STAFF

Manager: Sean Smedley

Smedley's coaching career began when he was the video coordinator for the rookie-level Princeton Rays in 2016. In 2017, he returned to Princeton, this time as the bench coach. For the next two seasons, Smedley was part of Blake Butera's staff as the bench coach for the Hudson Valley Renegades. The native of Colorado was announced as the manager in Princeton for the 2020 season, but COVID-19 canceled the season and, when play resumed, he joined Butera in Charleston. During his playing days as a catcher, Smedley was a prep standout at Desert Vista High School in Phoenix, Arizona. He played one year of junior college ball at Yavapai College before transferring to Division II Texas A&M International. He went undrafted at the end of his college career but was signed as a free agent by the Rays shortly after the draft's conclusion. In three professional seasons, he appeared in 24 games total between the Gulf Coast League Rays and Single-A Bowling Green. This is Smedley's second season managing the RiverDogs.

Pitching Coach: Levi Romero

Romero returns for a second year as the RiverDogs pitching coach after serving in the same role with the FCL Rays in 2021. Romero was the pitching coach for one of the Rays two entries in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. His professional career began in 2003 when he was signed out of Venezuela by the Houston Astros. In all, he pitched for five years in Minor League Baseball with the Astros and Texas Rangers before embarking on a seven-year international career that included stops in Venezuela and Japan and ended in 2015.

Hitting Coach: Brett Schneider

Schneider heads to the Lowcountry as the RiverDogs hitting coach in his first year as a member of the Rays organization. He spent the previous four years as a hitting coach in the Seattle Mariners farm system, including with the Arizona Complex League Mariners in 2023. His roster in the ACL finished with the most home runs in the 17-team circuit and hit a combined .263. Prior to coaching in the professional ranks, Schneider was a volunteer assistant coach at Florida Atlantic University. He also served as hitting coach for the Green Bay Bullfrogs of the Northwoods League in 2016 and managed the Great Lakes Collegiate League's Richmond Jazz in 2017.

Coach: Ronnie Richardson

Richardson is embarking on his fourth season with the Rays, and second with Charleston, following two years in the Florida Complex League. Richardson previously coached in the Miami Marlins organization, with Hillsborough Community College and in the Northwoods League with the Madison Mallards and Wisconsin Woodchucks. He was selected out of Central Florida University in the 16th round of the 2012 MLB Draft by the San Diego Padres. He played three seasons in their farm system, posting a .262 career batting average.

Athletic Trainer: Halee Williams

Williams begins her fifth year with the Rays and second with the RiverDogs. She served in the same role with the Florida Complex League Rays in 2022. Williams graduated with her bachelor's degree in athletic training from Indiana Wesleyan University. While in school, she interned with the Arizona Diamondbacks and, after graduating, spent a season with the Oakland Athletics. She began working with the Rays in 2019 while completing her Global master's degree in Sports Management and Legal Skills through Instituto Superior de Derecho y Economía and FC Barcelona in 2020. This winter, Williams worked for the Bravos de Margarita of the Venezuelan Professional Baseball League.

Strength Coach: Gio Caraballo

This will be Caraballo's first season as the RiverDogs Strength & Conditioning coach after a brief stint working in Charleston last summer. Caraballo was hired by the Rays in late 2022 and spent last season in the same role with the Florida Complex League Rays at their facility in Sarasota. A New Jersey native, Caraballo began his career with the Houston Astros after graduating from Montclair State University with a Bachelor of Science with a major in Physical Education.
