Tonight: The Lugnuts play the opener in a six-game series with the Peoria Chiefs, the only meetings of the year for Lansing with the Cardinals' High-A affiliate. Still, that's a step forward from not playing the Chiefs, which the Nuts did (or didn't do?) in 2020, 2021 and 2022. The last time that Lansing played Peoria, it was 1,433 days ago on July 12, 2019, and the last time that the Lugnuts hosted the Chiefs, it was 1,792 days on July 20, 2018. Lansing is coming off winning three of five games at South Bend, finished off with a rainout on Sunday. That game will not be made up, shortening the Lugnuts' overall schedule this year to 131 games.

Off the Field: Today is also Tacos and Tallboys, with \$4 tacos and \$4 margaritas, plus Pride Night!

Last Game: Lugnuts 3, Cubs 1. Jack Perkins, pitching in front of over 40 friends and family members, tossed seven scoreless innings with five strikeouts, and the Nuts won despite collecting only two hits: a Brayan Buelvas RBI double and a Jonny Butler no-doubt home run, his team-leading sixth of the year.

#### Lug•Notes

Series Victories: The Nuts have won four series this year: April 7-9 at Great Lakes, a three-game sweep; April 26-30, winning four of six against Quad Cities; May 16-21, winning four of seven against Lake County; and, most recently, June 6-10, winning three of five at South Bend.

Moving Up by Traveling South: Earlier today, Lugnuts pitcher Jack Perkins and infielder Sahid Valenzuela were promoted to Double-A Midland (Texas). The A's 2022 fifth-round selection from Indiana, the 23-year-old Perkins finished his time in Lansing with seven shutout innings on Saturday night at South Bend, his third consecutive quality start. He leads the Midwest League with a 0.97 WHIP and ranks second with a 2.52 ERA and third with a .182 batting average allowed. This is his first trip to Double-A. The 25-year-old Valenzuela previously spent 25 games in Midland in 2022. A 13th-rounder in 2019 from Cal State Fullerton, he batted .262 with three doubles in 30 games with the Lugnuts.

Welcome, and Welcome Back: Perkins' and Valenzuela's spots on the roster have been filled by pitcher Jose Dicochea, promoted from Single-A Stockton, and infielder Drew Swift, activated from the Injured List. Dicochea is one of the top rising pitching prospects in the Athletics' organization. Drafted from Sahuarita High School (Sahuarita, Ariz.) in the eighth round in 2019, the 22-year-old had been limited to 16 appearances in the last two years, but emerged this year with 47 strikeouts in 39 1/3 innings for the Ports, posting a 3.20 ERA in nine games, seven starts. Hea is slated to start for the Lugnuts on Thursday at 7:05 p.m. against the Chiefs. Swift, 24, opened 2023 on the Lugnuts' Injured List. Drafted in eighth round in 2021 from Arizona State, Swift spent 32 games in Lansing in 2021 before returning for an injury-shortened 59-game run in 2022, distinguishing himself with a .352 OBP and 21 steals in 23 attempts. He will start tonight in the home opener of a six-game series against Peoria, batting sixth and playing second base.

Pitcher's Best Friend: The Lugnuts have turned seven double plays in their last two games and lead the Midwest League with 51 for the year.

Among the MWL Leaders: Closer Tyler Baum is tied for third with six saves; outfielder Jonny Butler is second in the Midwest League with five triples; catcher Daniel Susac is fifth with 55 hits and seventh with a .291 batting average; and outfielder Junior Pérez is tied for eighth with 14 steals.

Bo Knows Hitting: 2017 Nut Bo Bichette is tied for first in MLB in base hits (91), ranks fourth in total bases (146) and fourth in batting average (.317).

**First-Round Pedigrees:** The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 22-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C **Tyler Soderstrom** (who tripled and homered yesterday and is tied for third in the Pacific Coast League with 31 extra-base hits, fourth in the PCL with 14 home runs, sixth with 45 RBIs and eighth with 115 total bases).

#### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2000: The Clinton LumberKings' Scott Dunn fired a 7-0 perfect game, the first time that the Lugnuts were no-hit in franchise history. It would not happen again until 2013... when the Lugnuts were no-hit three times in one season.

2007: Great Lakes southpaw Clayton Kershaw, the future NL Cy Young Award winner, fired seven scoreless innings with eight strikeouts, allowing four singles and two walks, and the host Loons topped the Lugnuts, 7-3.

2016: In his first appearance since 2014 and his first career professional start, future Blue Jays closer Jordan Romano fired a seven-inning complete game in Game 1 and the Lugnuts swept the Great Lakes Loons in a doubleheader (4-1 and 11-1) at Cooley Law School Stadium. Romano struck out seven Loons while allowing only two base runners.

In a Nutshell: Making tenth appearance, ninth start, of the season... before Myers, the last Pitt Panther to start a game for the Nuts was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in 2016, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016, spent last season with the Cincinnati Reds, and is currently in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A - Philadelphia)... @mitch\_myers9 on social media.

International Respect: Mitch is ranked No. 3 in the world in the video game Super Monkey Ball.

**Hometown Hero:** Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

**The Buc Starts Here:** Initially committed to University of Alabama, joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

**Onward to Pitt:** Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.

**2022 Professional Debut:** After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.
