CARDINALS SWEEP IN DOUBLEHEADER BY TULSA: The Tulsa Drillers rode big innings in each game to 7-1 and 5-3 victories as the Cardinals were swept in a doubleheader for the first time the season on Wednesday night at Hammons Field. **Nathan Church** continued a big week for Springfield going 2-for-4 with a home run and 3 RBIs in the second game, and **Noah Mendlinger** collected three hits in game one. **Jacob Buchberger** went 2-for-3 in the first game to extend his hitting streak to 8 games. Both Cardinal starters, **Max Rajcic** and **Edwin Nuñez**, struck out 7 Drillers.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Jared Karros** makes his second Double-A start for the Drillers... Allowed 6 ER on 7 H with 6 BB in 3.2 IP in his debut with Tulsa on Friday against Wichita at ONEOK Field...Did not factor in the decision, an 8-6 Drillers win...Began the season with High-A Great Lakes and pitched well going 5-0 with a 1.59 ERA in 7 starts...Racked up 36 K to just 7 BB in 34.0 IP while allowing just 21 hits...Opponents batted .174 against him in the Midwest League...Split the 2023 season between Low-A Rancho Cucamonga and Great Lakes going a combined 4-4 with a 3.44 ERA in 22 appearances (18 starts), striking out 86 while walking 23 in 83.2 IP...Allowed just 2 HR, and none so far this season... Selected by the Dodgers in the 16th round of the 2022 draft out of UCLA...Did not pitch in 2022 due to a back injury...Was the Bruins' Opening Day starter in 2021 but did not pitch after March 28 due to the same back ailment...Went 2-1 with a 3.33 ERA in over 7 appearances (3 starts) in 2021...Served as the Bruins' midweek starter in 2020...Played in college with his brother Kyle, who was drafted as a 3B by the Rockies in the 5th round of the 2023 draft out of UCLA and plays for the Spokane Indians...Son of Eric Karros who hit 270 HR over a 14 year big league career and won the 1992 NL Rookie of the Year...23 years old

LONGEST HOMESTAND OF 2024 CONTINUES WITH SEVEN AGAINST THE DRILLERS: For the first time this season, the Cardinals play host to the Tulsa Drillers (Double-A, Los Angeles Dodgers) as the two teams play a seven-game series at Hammons Field this week. The Cardinals won 4 out of 5 at ONEOK Field from April 30-May 4. The Cards and Drillers will play a doubleheader on Wednesday to make up for the postponement on May 5.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

RIDING THE ROLLER COASTER: The Cardinals come into play on Thursday night just 5-10 over their last 15 games since May 7, a stretch that includes a six-game losing streak. During that time the Cards have been outscored 91-70 and have seen their run differential drop from +17 to -4. Since winning 9 straight to start the season, the Cardinals are 13-18.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cards have struck out just 292 times in 41 games, the 3rd-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. In the Texas League, Springfield trails the Frisco RoughRiders (279 K's in 39 games) for 2nd-fewest in the circuit. The Birds are averaging just 7.1 K's per game. Of teams that have played at least 40 games, the Cards trail only the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers who have K'd 283 times in 41 contests.

CARDS PLAGUED BY BIG INNINGS: So far in 2024, the Cardinals have had a hard time limiting the big inning. Springfield has surrendered 33 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 33 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 126 of the 231 total runs scored by the opposition, 54.5% of the runs the Birds have allowed this season. Springfield has allowed that production in just 9.4% of their innings pitched. In the other 316.2 IP Springfield has allowed 102 runs, which comes out to 2.89 runs per 9 innings.

SEARCHING FOR LONGBALL ELIXIR: So far this season the Cardinals have been victims of the longball, getting dinged for 50 home runs in just 41 games. That number leads the Texas League; the Amarillo Sod Poodles are next having allowed 46 homers. Overall opponents are batting .258 against Springfield pitching, tied with Tulsa for the second-highest mark in the circuit.

HE GETS ON BASE...AND HITS TANKS: Despite having his on-base streak snapped in game one on Wednesday, **Matt Lloyd** has still reached base in 19 of his last 20 games. His 18 on base streak was the third longest on the club this season; **Bryan Torres** had a 23-game streak from April 5-May 9 and **Jeremy Rivas** had a 20-gamer from April 14-May 12. **Lloyd** has walked a team-high 24 times, also leads the Cardinals with 7 home runs and has an OBP of .390. He finished a triple shy of the cycle in the series finale against Midland on Sunday.

HOT CORNER, HOT BAT: After a slow start to the season, Cardinals INF **Jacob Buchberger** has gotten hot over the last month. Since coming into play on April 14 batting .087, Springfield's 3B is batting .346 (27-for-78) over his last 23 games, and has hit safely in all but 3 of them. He has two separate 8-game hitting streaks during that stretch.

Buchberger has hit safely in 8 straight games, the 3rd-longest active streak in the Texas League. During his hitting streak, **Buchberger** is batting .467 (14-for-30) with a double and home run. He has multiple hits in 5 straight games and 6 of his last 7.

TABLE SETTERS: The hitters that occupy the top two spots in the Cardinal lineup on the most regular basis, **Bryan Torres** and **Nathan Church**, have been the fuel to Springfield's league-leading offense. Combined, **Torres** and **Church** are batting .315 (90-for-286) with 49 R, 16 2B, 24 SB, 4 CS and have struck out a combined 39 times compared to 30 walks.

Springfield leadoff hitters are batting .286 (4th in the Texas League) and .304 out of the 2-hole, the top mark in the circuit. Combined, the Cardinals batting .295 between the two spots in the lineup, tops in the league.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: In search of more power this season, Cardinals OF **Nathan Church** has found the juice so far this season with a career-high 6 HR in just 39 games. Last season with Peoria, Church hit 3 HR in 119 games.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 19 straight games without a home run.
