#### Abstract

TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a sixgame home series against Tennessee. This will be the last series between the two clubs who will meet a total of 12 times this season. ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves walked off for the third time in nine games on an error by the Smokies second baseman. Franklin was at the plate as a pinch hitter and walked it off for the M-Braves. Domingo Robles tossed 6.2 innings of one-run ball.


REMATCH! The M-Braves lost five of six games to Tennessee from July 18-23. In the lone win on Sunday, Luis De Avila pitched six no-hit innings in a 3-1 win. Four games were within two runs. The series featured 17 combined home runs ( 8 by MIS), and the Tennessee offense exploded for a . 916 OPS in six games.
JESSE'S STREAK: Jesse Franklin $V$ had his onbase streak end at 23 games after he failed to reach in the completion of the suspended game from August 13. This streak would have increased to 33 games. Over the streak hit . 278 with four home runs, two doubles, nine walks, 14 RBI, and a . 387 OBP. The streak was the longest by an M-Brave this season. He has reached base in 37 of the last 41 games.
Other top on-base streaks: Christian Bethancourt (40, 2013, club record), Ozzie Albies (36, 2016), Michael Harris II (31, 2022), Drew Waters (30, 2019).
FINALLY CATCHING A BREAK: After dropping 12 of 14 one-run games, the M-Braves have won four of their last six one-run games. The club won their first series since July 3 with a win on Sunday and have three walk off wins in the last nine games. The M-Braves are 20-29 since the All-Star Break and are 1-7-1 in their last eight series.
YEAH, WE GOT PROSPECTS: The M-Braves had some movement on the prospect list, most notably a huge bump for LHP Luis De Avila and the arrival of RHP Hurston Waldrep.
The prospects include No. 2 RHP Hurston Waldrep, No. 14 LHP Luis De Avila, No. 21 INF Cal Conley, No. 22 OF Jesse Franklin V, No. 27 RHP Tyler Owens, and No. 28 C Drake Baldwin.
IOP PITCHING STAFF: The M-Braves lead the Southern League, and rank 3rd in Double-A, with a 3.98 ERA. The pitching staff has given up just 92 home runs, the fewest, by 11, in Dou-ble-A. The M-Braves bullpen is 3rd in Double-A with a 3.73 ERA.
RETURN OF THE PEARL CITY BOMBERS: The M-Braves have two of the top-six home run hitters in the league with Drew Lugbauer (22, 3rd), and Landon Stephens ( 20,7 th). Cade Bunnell (15), and Jesse Franklin V (14) have double digit long balls.
M-Braves opponents have just 27 home runs at Trustmark Park this season.
20-HOMER CLUB: With a homer on August 26, Landon Stephens became the fifth M-Braves player to hit 20 home runs in a season. He joined Drew Lugbauer $(2022,2023)$, Shea Langeliers (2021), Ryan Casteel (2019), and Ernesto Mejia (2011). Stephens hit 10 homers from June 2-July 3 (24 games).

SLUGBAUER TO TRIPLE-A: 1B Drew Lugbauer was promoted to Triple-A Gwinnett on August 15. He recorded his first career three-homer game and the first in Trustmark Park history on August 5 vs Montgomery. He went on a 14 game hitting streak from June 1-July 23, batting .465 with $52 \mathrm{~B}, 4 \mathrm{HR}, 11 \mathrm{RBI}, 8 \mathrm{BB}, .558$ OBP, and 1.418 OPS over the streak. It's the club's longest hitting streak this season.
He's the first M-Braves player to ever have multiple 20-home run seasons. In 283 games for the M-Braves, Lugbauer slashed .231/.342/.491 with 68 home runs, 53 doubles, two triples, and 191 RBI.
The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record, and Double-A franchise record 68 home runs over parts of three seasons. Lugbauer also has a club-record 191 RBI. He hit 18 homers in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022.
WADDYYY: Luke Waddell is 3rd in the league with a .290 batting average and ranks 6th in the league with a .389 OBP.
COUNTIN' ON CAL: Cal Conley leads all of Dou-ble-A with 127 games played, and ranks among the league leaders in hits ( $112, \mathrm{~T}-4 \mathrm{th}$ ) and stolen bases ( 31,8 th).
HOT SOUP COMIN' THROUGH: Drew Campbell reached base in 15 of 16 games from July 30-August 26. In August, Campbell slashed .352/.444/. 500 with two home runs, two doubles and four RBI.
RANGEL'S RESURGENCE: Alan Rangel took his game to another level in August, posting a 2.30 ERA in five starts. The right-hander allowed seven earned runs in 27.1 innings with five walks and 30 strikeouts. Despite this, he was unlucky 1-4 in August. To start September, Rangel spun seven innings of one-hit ball with a career-high 12 strikeouts against Rocket City on Sunday, earning SL Pitcher of the Week.

Atlanta promoted Rangel to Triple-A Gwinnett on Tuesday.
MORE ROSTER MOVES: The M-Braves have made 25 roster moves since August 22, most notably adding Atlanta's No. 2 prospect and 2023 first round pick RHP Hurston Waldrep, No. 28 prospect C Drake Baldwin and No. 16 prospect and 2023 second round pick RHP Drue Hackenberg.
DE AVILA DELIVERS: Luis De Avila has 14 shutout innings, five hits allowed and 17 strikeouts in his last two starts. The lefty ranks among the league leaders in ERA (3.32, 3rd), innings pitched (119.2, 2nd), strikeouts (124, 7th), opponent average (.220, 3rd), and WHIP (1.28, 7th).
ANOTHER TO THE SHOW: RHP Darius Vines was promoted to the Atlanta Braves on Monday, marking the 166th M-Brave that has been called up to the MLB. He shined in his Double-A debut, going six two-run innings at Coors Field in Colorado. Vines went 7-4 with a 3.95 ERA in 107 innings over 20 starts for the M-Braves last season.
