Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Louisville Bats play game four of a six-game series tonight. A crazy back-and-forth game finally came to an end when Nashville's Derek Fisher delivered a walk-off single in the bottom of the 11th inning to give the Sounds a 5-4 win over the Bats last night. Right-hander Thomas Jankins starts for Nashville against right-hander Ashton Goudeau for Louisville.

Thomas Jankins: 26-year-old Thomas Jankins makes his 13th appearance (11th start) for the Sounds tonight. He last pitched at Gwinnett on July 10 and took his fourth loss. He allowed seven hits, one walk and struck out four over 5.0 innings. In 2019, Jankins went 11-5 with a 4.19 ERA in 25 games (23 starts) with Triple-A San Antonio and Double-A Biloxi. He finished tied for fifth in the Pacific Coast League for wins (10), logged 10 quality starts and four starts of 6+ IP and one or less runs allowed. The Brewers drafted Jankins in the 13th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 32, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Walk-Off Galore: Derek Fisher's walk-off single in the 11th inning gave the Sounds their eight walk-off win of the season last night. Nashville has posted three walk-off wins in the month of July, all against Louisville.

Home is Where the Sounds Are: The Sounds will play 19 home games at First Horizon Park over the next 27 days. They host Louisville for six games from July 13-18, Columbus comes to town for six games July 27-August 1 and Toledo visits Nashville for a seven-game series August 3-8. The Sounds have already played 33 (22-11) home games in 2021 – the second-most in the Triple-A East behind only Iowa's 34 home games at Principal Park.

The Longest Game of the Year: The Sounds played 11 innings last night vs. Louisville which is the longest game of the season innings-wise. Additionally, it was the fifth extra-inning game over the last 12 at First Horizon Park, four of which have been against Louisville.

Starter 6+ Innings = Winning Formula: Starting pitcher Josh Lindblom recorded a season-high in innings pitched (6.2) and pitches (100) last night. Lindblom threw at least 6.2 innings in affiliated baseball for the first time since June 26, 2014 with Sacramento vs. Las Vegas (7.0). The Sounds are 9-4 when their starting pitcher throws at least 6.0 innings.

Green's Game: Wednesday night's two-homer game by Zach Green was his second of the season (also 5/29 at Columbus) and the 13th of his career. The multi-homer game by Green was Nashville's seventh of the season and the club's first at First Horizon Park (also Weston Wilson - 5/28 at Columbus, Jace Peterson - 6/3 at Charlotte, Keston Hiura - 6/20 at Gwinnett, Jamie Westbrook - 7/6 at Gwinnett, Weston Wilson - 7/7 at Gwinnett). The two home runs give Green four at First Horizon Park compared to nine on the road.

Another Shutout: The Sounds notched their sixth shutout of the season on Wednesday night and their third in the last nine games. Prior to those nine games, the Nashville staff has recorded three shutouts in the first 52 games of the season. The six shutouts is the second-most in all of Triple-A Baseball behind only Durham's nine.

Westbrook Finds A Way: Infielder Jamie Westbrook has reached base safely in a team-high 27 consecutive games and has hit safely in 23 of those games. Since June 8 when the streak started, he is hitting .376 (38-for-101) with 20 runs, 9 doubles, 6 home runs, 26 RBI and 8 walks. His on-base percentage during the 27 games is .429.

Milner Shuts the Door: Reliever Hoby Milner tossed a third of an inning last night and is yet to allow a run with the Sounds in 15.2 IP. The left-hander has recorded four saves and is holding opponents to a .082 batting average.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,071-1,944. The 2,071 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team South-east Division.
