LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox fell to Altoona 5-3 on the Sunday before the All-Star Break from People's Natural Gas Field. Bowie took a 3-2 lead after the top of the 4th on a sac fly from **Dylan Beavers** and a bases loaded walk drawn by **Matthew Etzel** but Altoona scored three unanswered runs to retake the lead for good. The Baysox have now lost six of their last seven.

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

Last Saturday, C/1B **Samuel Basallo** represented the Orioles in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game. In the game, Basallo went 0-for-1 with a four-pitch walk. The No. 2 O's/No. 12 MLB prospect is tied for eighth in the Eastern League in home runs (12) and hits (78) and is the first teenager to hit double-digit home runs in an Eastern League season since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in 2018 (NH).

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is tied for second among active Eastern League players with 13 home runs on the season - tied for 10th-most in Double-A. After hitting 11 homers between May and June, the O's No. 11 prospect is still looking for his first homer in July.

FEAR THE BEARD

Between Double-A Bowie and High-A Aberdeen, OF/1B **Matthew Etzel's** 40 stolen bags this season are tied for ninth-most in all of MiLB. The first member of the O's '23 draft class to reach Double-A, Etzel has hits in 20 of his first 25 starts at the level, including in his last five straight.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 60 of 74 games played in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 6 prospect leads the team in walks (40), tied for the fifth-most in the Eastern League.

HEID-AND-GO-SEEK

RHP **Dylan Heid** has emerged as one of the most lights-out relievers in all of Minor League Baseball. Heid's 1.08 ERA ranks as the second-best in MiLB among pitchers with more than 40 innings.

ARMS RACE

The Baysox pitching staff has the third-best ERA since June 1 (3.43) and the most strikeouts this season (853). The Baysox bullpen has thrown the most innings (418.2) at Double-A with the third-best WHIP (1.21) in Double-A. The Bowie rotation has also done its part with the second-best ERA (2.38) in Double-A in July.

A DRY JULY

The Baysox offense has struggled mightily this month through the first 12 games, with a league-low .204 batting average. They have scored 30 runs, which is also tied for the league-low. After hitting 25 homers in June (5th-best), Bowie has hit only three this month.

THE GOATS ARE GRAZING

The Hartford Yard Goats visit Bowie for the first and only time this season. The Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies won the Northeast Division in the first half of the season. 11 of the Rockies' Top 30 prospects are on the active roster- IF Adael Amador (No. 2), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 4), OF Zac Veen (No. 5), 1B Sterlin Thompson (No. 6), SS Ryan Ritter (No. 12), LHP Carson Palmquist (No. 14), 3B Warming Bernabel (No. 16), LHP Mason Albright (No. 21), RHP Angel Chivilli (No. 24), RHP Jaden Hill (No. 26) and RHP Connor Van Scoyoc (No. 28).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Connor Van Scoyoc gets the start for Hartford in the series opener. The Rockies No. 28 prospect has thrown the second-most innings on the team (81.2) and the 13th-most in the Eastern League. Van Scoyoc's best month so far was in June when he recorded a 2.12 ERA in five starts, allowing only four walks in 29.2 innings. Van Scoyoc faced Bowie in his first start of the season and gave up four runs and four walks on four hits in 3.2 innings in game one of a doubleheader on April 13, including a three-run homer from **Frederick Bencosme**.

Enters season fully healthy for first time since '22 after rehabbing from TJ surgery in '23

Traded from TB to BAL on 8/1/22 in three-team deal that sent Trey Mancini to HOU

Arsenal: Fastball (94-96), Curveball (75-79), Slider (Mid-High 80s), Changeup (86-89)

2024: Threw 5.0 IP for second time this season, allowed just 1 R over 4 H and 4 K, but received no run support in loss on 7/10 @ ALT. First walk-less start of season. Has allowed just 8 ER over last 10 starts spanning 38.1 IP (1.88 ERA). 3rd-lowest ERA by a Eastern League starter since May 17 (minimum 30 IP). 4th-lowest ERA in month of June (1.65). Still looking for first Double-A win. Baysox are 7-9 when he starts. Owns a 2.93 ERA in eight home starts. Finished first half with a 3.07 ERA over 44.0 IP with 48 K/30 BB. On Tue. 6/4 vs BNG, struck out season-high 8 batters over 4.0 scoreless innings. First game with 8+ K since 5/20/22 with High-A Bowling Green. Finished month of May with a 2.79 ERA in five starts after recording a 4.38 ERA in four April starts. On the BAL 40-man roster. Named to 40-man back in Nov. '22. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

2022: Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston - just days before his operation in Texas.

2021: Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

2019: Debuted professionally with TB rookie ball affiliates in Princeton and GCL Rays.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Rays out of Campbell with the 40th overall selection in the 2019 Draft. At the time, was the highest-drafted player in Campbell history. A former two-way player at Louisburg (N.C.) junior college as a shortstop before committing to pitching full time at Campbell. Was his first time pitching since age 12. Convinced his junior college coaches to let him pitch in games after clocking 92 mph on a teammate's Pocket Radar during an off day.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Coaching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.
