PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 27 games over .500 with a 64-37 record (.634 winning percentage).

- 64 wins are the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, just behind 65 from the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, Houston's Triple-A affiliate.
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .634 winning percentage overall this year is the 4th-best the Minors ... the top team in MiLB is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (.62-34 / .646), Milwaukee's High-A team.
- The Storm Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
- Omaha is currently on pace for 93 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990 ... the best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

62 of Omaha's 101 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 23 of 37 losses in 2024, with 12 of 37 losses by just one run (36%).

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 10 of its last 19 save opportunities, since June 5 (52%).
- Omaha is 19-12 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as tied for the 7th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... four teams have 21 1-run wins this year.
- As a team, Omaha's 30 saves are the 5th-most of any Minor League team, 2nd-most in Triple-A and the top mark in the league ... Evan Sisk has recorded the team's last four saves, but 7 different Storm Chasers arms have 2 or more saves this year.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 568 to 469 this season, a +99 run differential.

- A +99 run differential this year ranks as both the 2nd-best mark in the International League and tops at the Triple-A level, behind the Syracuse Mets (+101).
- Omaha is 8th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Modesto Nuts lead the Minors at +170 (640 to 470).

JULY, JULY!

A pair of Omaha hitters are in their best stretches of this season in the month of July.

- In 20 games this month, outfielder Tyler Gentry is hitting .423 (30-for-71) with a 1.162 OPS this month and leads the team in hits (30) and total bases (47) ... Gentry has a case to be the league's player of the month in July, leading the IL in hits, with the highest average among qualifiers (min. 59 PA), and the 2nd-best OPS ... he enters today's game on a career-best 12-game hitting streak as well.
- Over 11 July games, catcher Brian O'Keefe has thrived despite limited playing time, hitting .412 (14-for-34) in July, with a 1.336 OPS ... he is 2nd on the team this month in HR (4), 3rd in RBI (11) ... O'Keefe is on a career-best 21-game on-base streak while the 12-game hitting streak he is on is tied for the longest of his career.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

Storm Chasers infielder CJ Alexander finds himself among the league's top hitters in the league entering today's game.

- Alexander leads the International League with a .317 batting average, while he ranks 3rd in slugging percentage (.569) and 4th in OPS (.933).
- In last week's series at St. Paul, Alexander's 20 total bases lead the team ... he went 9-for-22 (.409) with 5 doubles and 2 homers, paired with 5 RBI and 4 walks.
- Alexander's average has been over .300 since May 17 & for almost 80% of his season.

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 36 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (57%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 14 of the 35 comeback wins, with 6 victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 9 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.
- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 10 occasions.

TODAY'S START

Cameron is making his Triple-A debut today ... this is his **1st start with Omaha** and his **17th overall start** this season ... after opening the season in Double-A with NW Arkansas, Chandler made 16 starts for the Naturals before being promoted to Omaha on Sunday, July 28.

In 2024, ranks tied 3rd among Royals Minor League pitchers in strikeouts (87) and tied 5th in starts (16).
Ranked by MLB Pipeline as the No. 18 Royals prospect ... Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 15 Royals prospect.

LAST OUTING: THURSDAY, JULY 25 VS. ARKANSAS

Worked 4.0 innings in his final Double-A start, took a no-decision in a Naturals win ... two doubles and a home run scored 3 runs in the top of the 1st inning ... ended the day with 3.0 scoreless innings, retired 10 of his final 12, just allowed singles in the 2nd and 3rd innings, struck out the side in the 4th to end his day ... did not come out for the 5th inning.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Started opening day for Double-A Northwest Arkansas, but took the loss, allowed 2 earned runs over 4.2 innings on April 5 vs. Tulsa (LAD) ... finished 5.0 innings in 10 of 16 starts with the Naturals, including five straight after the season opener.
- On the Injured List from May 10 to May 30 with left forearm tightness, only missed 18 games.
- Threw a pair of quality starts with NWA: June 29 @ Wichita (MIN) and July 19 vs. Tulsa (LAD), both within the span of his last 5 at the Double-A level ... struck out 7+ on 6 occasions ... worked 3 scoreless starts with NW Arkansas.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023**
 Split the season between Quad Cities (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA) and combined to go 5-12 over 24 starts between the two levels, with a 5.28 ERA (63 ER in 107.1 IP) and 132 strikeouts to just 35 walks (3.77 K/BB).
 Ranked 3rd among Royals Minor League pitchers in strikeouts (132), tied 4th in starts (24) and tied 9th in innings pitched (107.1) ... among those in the system with at least 100.0 innings pitched, ranked 1st in K/9 (11.07) and K/BB (3.77).
 In High-A, walked just 9 to 58 strikeouts (6.44 K/BB), but after being promoted to Double-A on May 19, walked 26 compared to 74 strikeouts (2.85 K/BB) with NWA.
 Made the first 4 quality starts of his professional career, two with each the River Bandits and Naturals ... in his Double-A debut on May 24 at Tulsa (LAD), threw a career-high 7.0 shutout innings with just 3 hits and 1 walk allowed and 6 strikeouts.
