HARRIS HOMERS, RIDERS FINALLY FALL WITH 7-2 LOSS:

The Northwest Arkansas Naturals slugged three home runs Wednesday night and brought a seven-game Frisco RoughRiders win streak to a close, topping Frisco with a 7-2 win at Riders Field. **Grant Anderson** shined on the mound for the Riders, striking out six batters in three innings of relief. In a multi-hit night, **Dustin Harris** extended his hit streak to eight games with his first Double-A home run. Northwest Arkansas (4-7) benefited from a season-high five innings from Drew Parrish (1-1), only allowing one run on the Harris homer. Yefri Del Rosario tossed three shutout innings against Frisco (9-2), setting up Nats reliever Zach Willeman to nail shut the ninth. Following a three-inning start from **Avery Weems** (0-1), the Riders turned to two innings from **Tai Tiedemann** who surrendered four runs on six hits. Northwest Arkansas slugged three home runs off the Riders. The Naturals entered the series with one in nine games, and have produced four in the first two games in Frisco. Trailing 3-1, Frisco looked to tie the game in the bottom of the third, beginning with a leadoff walk from **Trey Hair**. With one out, **Ezequiel Duran** slapped a ball on the right side of the infield, bringing in Hair and reaching on the only error of the night from Nats first baseman Robbie Glendinning. Northwest Arkansas then exploded for four runs on six consecutive hits to begin the top of the fifth. With one on and one out, Seuly Matias slugged a two-run big fly. Two hits later, Glendinning redeemed his error with a two-run double, ending his night with six total bases and three RBIs. Both teams were held scoreless after the fifth inning from sharp pitching out of both bullpens. Frisco singled four times in each of the final four innings but failed to score any more runs. The Riders ended Wednesday's game 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position.

DUSTIN BUSTER:

After starting the season 0-for-8, **Dustin Harris** is now on an eight-game hitting streak. Harris is hitting .387 (12-for-31)/.394/.516/.910 over his streak with a double, a home run and seven RBIs. The No. 6 prospect in the Rangers system was the Tom Grieve Ranger Minor League Player of the Year in 2021, hitting .327/.401/.542 with 20 home runs and 25 steals between Low-A Down East and High-A Hickory.

KEEP YOU FRIENDS CLOSE AND YOUR ENEMIES CLOSER:

Through 11 games, the RoughRiders have won eight of their nine victories by three runs or fewer. So, through those nine close wins the Riders have collected eight saves, the most in all of Minor League Baseball. Though Frisco is 9-2, their run differential is just +12, which is second best in the Texas League.

YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT:

Over the last nine games, the RoughRiders have banged out at least 10 hits in five contests. Their 80 hits in the last nine games are more than 34 teams in MiLB have all season. Overall, Frisco is hitting .278/.352/.382 to start the season, a batting average good for third in the Texas League and seventh in Minor League Baseball.

REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 961 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

WELCOME TO THE LEIT SHOW:

Rangers No. 1 prospect, RHP **Jack Leiter** was as-advertised on Saturday in his first start of his professional career. Over his three innings, Leiter whiffed seven while allowing just one run on one hit with two walks. The second-overall pick out of Vanderbilt in the 2021 draft, Leiter was a unanimous First-Team All-American in his final season with the Commodores while tying the NCAA lead in strikeouts on the year. The son of two-time All-Star and two-time World Series champ Al Leiter, Jack is ranked as the No. 17 prospect in baseball by MLB.com. In his second start of the season, he went four innings, allowing just one run on one hit again, striking out four against San Antonio.

LOOK AT ALL THAT TALENT:

While Leiter headlines the top 30 prospects talent on the squad, the Riders back up him with plenty of players to watch. INF **Ezequiel Duran** slots in as the No. 4 prospect in the organization after the Rangers acquired him from the Yankees as part of the **Joey Gallo** deal at the 2021 deadline. INF **Justin Foscue**, who joined the club after sustaining an injury during spring training, is the No. 5 prospect. OF **Dustin Harris** is the No. 6 prospect after his incredible 20-20 campaign a year ago. Another trade piece, Harris came to the Rangers when they dealt **Mike Minor** to the A's in 2020. LHP **Cody Bradford** is the No. 20 prospect. Bradford, a former Baylor Bear from Aledo, Texas, led all Rangers farmhands in strikeouts last season while Kent finished third in the organization in strikeout rate (31.9).

ABOUT JUSTIN

-5A Hallsville High School in Hallsville, Texas (a little over two hours from Frisco toward the Louisiana border). Thought he was going to play in junior college before owning a 1.49 ERA his senior year. He received an offer from University of New Mexico. Helped Hallsville to a 5A regional quarterfinal appearance in 2016 as a senior.

-At New Mexico, Slaten was a three-year player with two spent in the starting rotation. After owning a 7.02 ERA his sophomore season, Slaten went 5-5 with a 2.51 ERA while striking out 98 in 82.1 innings to earn 2nd-Team All-Mountain West Conference honors.

-His third-round selection (86th overall), made Slaten the highest New Mexico pitcher taken in the MLB draft since Kevin Andersh was taken in the first round (15th overall) by the Pirates in 1984.

-After being acquired in the offseason by the Rangers, catcher Mitch Garver is the only former Lobo on Texas. Garver was drafted out of New Mexico in 2013 by the Twins.

2022 SEASON

-First appearance for the Riders came out of the bullpen on Opening Night, throwing a scoreless inning with a pair of strikeouts.

2021 SEASON

-Finished the 2021 season as the No. 29 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Ended the year with the 5th-most strikeouts (110) and 10th-most innings (82.1) among Rangers minor leaguers in his 20 games (19 starts) with High-A Hickory.

-Over last 12 games, Slaten went 4-4 with a 4.14 ERA to conclude the year.

-Entered the season as the No. 15 prospect in the system by Fangraphs.
