Leading Off

Tonight, the Reading Fightin Phils continue a six-game series at home against the Harrisburg Senators. It is the second of 12 matchups between the teams this season; one series in Reading and another series in Harrisburg from Aug. 22-27. In 2022, the Fightin Phils went 4-8 against the Senators, including dropping five-of-six games at home in April and split the six-game series in Harrisburg in August.

Morning Blues

It was an up-and-down morning yesterday for the Fightin Phils. Reading fell behind early 3-1, but put up four runs in the bottom of the fifth inning thanks to home runs from Carlos De La Cruz and Max McDowell, but five unanswered runs gave Harrisburg a 8-5 win to open the series.

Shutout Streak

Through 39 games this season, Reading has yet to be shut out. The Fightin Phils are one-of-three teams in double-A and one-of-14 in all of Minor League Baseball who have yet to be blanked. Reading's pitching has also not yet thrown a shutout this season either.

Elite Defender

Johan Rojas continues to play elite defense in center field for the R-Phils. He has two outfield assists on the season, which leads Reading outfielders. Rojas has nine defensive runs saved this season, which is tied for the most amongst minor league center fielders.

A Look at the Bullpen

In wins, Reading's bullpen has been flat-out dominant, posting a 2.39 ERA over the Fightin Phils' 15 wins. But, in losses, it has been the complete opposite. In Reading's 24 defeats this season, the bullpen has posted a 6.96 ERA. A drastic 4.57 earned-run difference between wins and losses.

Tatum's Resurgence

McCarthy Tatum has been red-hot with the bat. After a three-hit performance yesterday, Tatum now has hits in his last-six games and is hitting .455 with eight RBI over that span. Prior to that streak, Tatum had just one hit in his prior 23 at bats.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies fell again to the Diamondbacks 4-3 last night and finish the series today at 1:05. Lehigh Valley earned a morning win over Buffalo, defeating the Bisons 6-3. Jersey Shore returned to .500 at 18-18 with a 9-3 win at Aberdeen yesterday. Clearwater improved to a Minor League-best 30-10 with a 6-0 victory over the St. Lucie Mets.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 24, 1953: At Wilkes-Barre, Reading pounds the Barons, 10-3, in the first game of a double-header, then plays to a 2-2 tie in a game called on account of Pennsylvania's Sunday curfew law. The second game is called at 6:59 PM with the bases full of Barons and nobody out in the 9th inning.

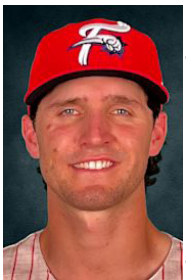
Coming from the Capital

This is the first series of the season between Reading and Harrisburg. The Senators sit tied for second in the Eastern League Southwest standings at 20-19 on the season. Last week, the Senators split a six-game series at home against Erie, winning the last two games like the R-Phils. Next week, Harrisburg stays on the road for a six-game series at Bowie.

On the Hill for Harrisburg

Righty, Michael Cuevas gets the start tonight for the Senators. He is 1-0, with a 5.16 ERA over seven starts. Cuevas has 22 strikeouts and 18 walks allowed over 29.2 innings. Against Erie last Thursday, he went 3.1 innings, allowing two runs on three hits, with five walks and two strikeouts. He spent all of 2022 with high-A Wilmington, going 6-12 with a 4.64 ERA over 26 games (24 starts). He was drafted out of high school in 2019.

Phillies Number Three Prosepect. Started season on injured list. McGarry has been a prospect since his high school days, when he was a late-round pick of the Rangers before honoring his commitment to Virginia. With the Cavaliers, he showed off his premium arm strength as well as a lack of familiarity with the strike zone, making him an intriguing, yet enigmatic college arm in 2021. The Phillies thought McGarry's stuff was worth taking in the fifth round, and he pitched his way from High-A to Triple-A in his first full season of pro ball. If you're just evaluating pure stuff, McGarry could be considered one of the better pitching prospects in the game. He's flirted with 100 mph in the past and was up to 99 mph at the upper levels in 2022, averaging over 95 mph. It's an elite pitch not just because of velocity, but because of his vertical approach angle as well. His mid-80s slider can be plus at times, missing a ton of bats, and he fools hitters with an upper-70s curve too. He doesn't throw his changeup nearly as much as the breaking stuff, but it has characteristics of a plus pitch. He added a hard cutter at the end of last year to give him a potential five-pitch mix. How often McGarry can land his elite-level stuff in the strike zone will determine exactly what he can be in the big leagues. A 13.9 K/9 rate to start off his pro career shows he can fool pro hitters, but even with some improvements since joining the Phillies, he's walked 5.4 per nine entering 2023. There's hope that as he adds mass to his loose 6-foot-2 frame, he can keep refining his delivery and throw enough strikes to start, a role he'll continue for now unless there's a need as a reliever in Philadelphia.
