Lansing has won each of the last two nights and is 3-3 against Dayton overall in the 21-game season series.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa call the game on StreamGuys for Lansing; the laudable Tom Nichols handles the Dragons' call.

Last Night: Lugnuts 9, Dragons 4. Trailing 4-1 entering the sixth inning, the Lugnuts took advantage of a run-scoring throwing error by third baseman Cam Collier, a two-run single from Jose Escorche and a two-run error by left fielder Yan Contreras to score six runs en route to a second straight victory in the series. Jonny Butler applied the finishing touches with a two-run single in the eighth.

LUG•NOTES

Where There's a Will, There's a Way: 1B Will Simpson has collected three hits each of the past two nights, knocking in three runs on Wednesday and two more runs yesterday, and has now reached base in his first 16 games to begin the season. Simpson leads the Midwest League in walks (18) and tops the Lugnuts in hits (20), batting average (.385, 2nd in the MWL), RBIs (18, 3rd in the MWL), OBP (.535, 3rd in the MWL), slugging (.577, 5th in the MWL) and OPS (1.112, 2nd in the MWL). Jonny Butler, who went 1-for-4 with a walk yesterday, has reached base in 12 consecutive games.

League Leaderboard, Will Excluded: Colby Halter's 17 walks place him 2nd in the league behind teammate Simpson. Brayan Buevas is tied for 2nd in runs scored (16) and tied for 3rd with Henry Bolte in stolen bases (8); Bolte is tied for 5th in runs scored (14); reliever Garrett Irvin is tied for 1st in appearances (7).

Patience: Lansing drew six more walks yesterday, giving the Lugnuts 38 walks drawn in six games vs. Dayton (and an overall .381 OBP against the Dragons' pitching) and 94 total walks for the year, most in the Midwest League.

Dragon Slayers: Notable Lugnuts who are excelling in the season series thus far against Dayton include Will Simpson (.412, 7-for-17, 7 walks in 5 games), Henry Bolte (.286, 7-for-23, 2 doubles, 1 HR, 7-for-7 steals), and CJ Rodriguez (.412, 7-for-17, .500 OBP).

Action on the Bases: In their six meetings, Lansing (18-for-22) and Dayton (7-for-8) have combined to swipe 25 bases, including five more from the Nuts yesterday, including a pair of double steals.

A Grand Start: On April 3, first baseman Will Simpson crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam off the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

EMU to The Show: The Lugnuts' first debuting Major Leaguer this year is 2021 super utilityman Max Schuemann, who made his Major League debut on April 12 as a pinch-runner for the Oakland Athletics, scoring the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th, and followed up on April 20 with a solo home run for his first MLB hit (in a 6-3 A's loss at Cleveland).

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 12) and first baseman Will Simpson (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2008: Future Major Leaguer Nefali Feliz struck out eight Lugnuts while allowing two hits and one walk in five scoreless innings, but the Lugnuts scored five runs in the 8th to win at Clinton, 6-1. Nuts starter Kyle Ginley turned in another gem, allowing one unearned run in 7 2/3 innings and striking out six. The game took two hours and eight minutes.

2011: SS Gustavo Pierre committed a franchise record four errors (two throwing, one missed catch, one fielding) and went 0-for-4 with three strikeouts in a 5-3 loss at home to Great Lakes. The bad day brought Pierre's error total to 15 errors in 17 Lugnuts games.

2019: Josh Winckowski struck out eight in seven scoreless innings, Jackson Rees handled the final two frames, and the Lugnuts blanked the high-scoring Hot Rods, 4-0, at Bowling Green Ballpark.

In a Nutshell: Goes familiarly by Li'i ("lee-ee")... became the ninth different pitcher to start a game for Lansing on April 14th... makes his 3rd professional start tonight.

Last Start: In second career professional start, allowed three runs in the 2nd inning, one in the 3rd, and then knocked out with four runs in the 4th inning, as the Loons routed the Lugnuts 12-4 in the Sunday series finale... allowed a solo home run to Dylan Campbell in the 3rd inning and a two-run homer to Chris Newell in the 4th... 68 pitches, 43 strikes... followed up with three scoreless innings at Lake County on April 20th.

Back Home: Signed for \$75,000... high school teammates with Hunter Breault, who was one year older at Kamehameha-Kapalama H.S... graduated HS with 3.5 GPA... played club ball for Team California Baseball, top 10 nationally ranked... First Team All-State as junior (0.95)... 2022 - junior year at Hawai'i: First Team All Big West, ranking 3rd in the conference in ERA (1.90) and leading Hawai'i in strikeouts (88)... joins Dustin Antolin as Lugnuts to hail from Mililani.

Minor League Path: Made pro debut in the Arizona Complex League in 2022 with a pair of scoreless innings, moving up to Stockton for two relief appearances by year's end... spent all of 2023 with the Ports, serving as their relief ace (11 saves in 15 chances) and only allowing three home runs in 61 1/3 innings... limited left-handed batters to .198 batting average / .530 OPS; right-handers hit .305 with .753 OPS.

In a Nutshell: Tallest Lugnut on the roster... youngest Lugnuts pitcher and the third youngest player on the team behind Henry Bolte and Elvis Rijo... making High-A debut this season in measured climb up the A's ladder after he was drafted from high school... part of "Pont-era" tandem combination with Blaze Pontes, opening fourth in the rotation.

Draft Day: Signed for \$125,000 out of Colegio Acelardo de Educación Secundaria (C.A.D.E.S.T.)... first ever player drafted from C.A.D.E.S.T.

Hometown Hero: Also born in San Juan: infielder Darell Hernaiz, recently sent down to Las Vegas from Oakland, as well as Bernie Williams, Danny Tartabull, Mike Lowell, Javy Lopez... home city of Vega Alta ("high/upper meadow"), founded 1775, is located in northern Puerto Rico, neighboring Vega Baja.

2021: Made professional debut on September 10 with a perfect inning against AzCL Giants Black, striking out one.

2022: Returned to action with the Arizona Complex League on July 5 with a hitless, scoreless inning against AzCL Brewers Gold... made eight appearances, none longer than 2 2/3 innings (August 6, striking out six Cubs).

2023: Joined Stockton in late May, making season debut on May 25... tossed three starts of at least six innings, peaking with 7-inning shutout gem on August 30 vs. Rancho Cucamonga (3 H, 3 BB, 5 K, 83 pitches, 50 strikes)... set career high in strikeouts with nine in five innings at Visalia, August 2... limited right-handers to .235 avg., .677 OPS (though they also hit the only three home runs he allowed all year); lefties batted .291 with an .849 OPS... 3.82 ERA in home games (8 G, 6 GS, 37 2/3 IP) compared to 7.18 ERA in road games (8 G, 6 GS, 31 1/3 IP).

Stoltz's Scouting Report: From Nathaniel Stoltz's Excessive Prospect Analysis: "Rivera has been the A's org's youngest pitcher in full-season ball by a full year, as he only recently just turned 20. As is to be expected from a young, huge (6'7", 237) pitcher who is light on pro experience, he's had bouts of inconsistency in Stockton, particularly on the command front, as the Puerto Rican southpaw is still figuring out how to corral his extended arm action and lengthy stride down the mound. He's got two good pitches to work with already, though: a 92-95 mph fastball that touches 96 and features big carry, and a wipeout mid-80s slider that he already shows signs of commanding... There's reason to expect a pitcher like this to possibly have lots of development remaining." In Stoltz's midseason review last year, he ranked Rivera as the A's No. 31 prospect.
