Today is Military Appreciation Night, as the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, play the fourth in a six-game series. The Nuts are 2-1 this week and 2-7 this year vs. West Michigan, 235-266 vs. the Whitecaps all-time.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 6, Whitecaps 1. Zane Taylor twirled 6 2/3 innings, and the Lugnuts used three big swings – an Ali Camarillo RBI double, a Camarillo three-run homer, and a Casey Yamauchi two-run double – to dispatch the Whitecaps in two hours and 19 minutes. Griffin Kirm added 1 1/3 scoreless innings in relief before Gerlin Rosario finished things off with a scoreless ninth.

LUG-NOTES

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**) and No. 24 (**Nate Nankil**). Baseball America's recent re-ranking of A's prospects puts Devin Taylor at No. 10, Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

1K Nuts: **Griffin Kirm** became the 1,000th player in Lansing Lugnuts history when he appeared out of the bullpen last night; of that 1,000, 213 have appeared in a Major League game, 19 have made the All-Star Game, eight won the World Series, five have pitched a no-hitter, and two have hit for the cycle.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts have turned 63 double plays (in 48 games), which leads Minor League Baseball (2nd - OKC Comets, 56 in 53 games) and Major League Baseball (1st - SF Giants, 58 in 56 games). The Nuts executed three double plays yesterday behind **Zane Taylor** after turning four double plays behind **Samuel Dutton**.

Starting Strong: Lansing's trio of starters in this series have combined to allow two runs in 19 innings: **Steven Echavarria** gave up one run in 5 1/3 innings on Tuesday; **Samuel Dutton** fired seven shutout innings on Wednesday; and **Zane Taylor** allowed just a first-inning run in 6 2/3 innings on Thursday.

Spare the Pen: The Nuts' starters aren't the only pitchers going deep in the A's organization. 2025 Lugnuts right-hander **Corey Avant** gave up one unearned run in eight innings for Double-A Midland yesterday a day after Triple-A Las Vegas starter **Kade Morris** tossed seven innings (one run allowed), Double-A Midland starter **Jamie Arnold** went 6 2/3 innings, and Single-A Stockton starter **Jackson Phipps** fired six scoreless innings.

Making the Jump: 2025 Lugnuts Opening Day starter **Gage Jump** fired five innings for the A's Tuesday night, striking out five while allowing four runs on nine hits in five innings, to become the 204th all-time Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues and the fourth this season (**Daniel Susac** with the Giants, **Eduardo Rivera** with the Red Sox, and **Henry Bolte** with the A's). Jump, 23 years old (sharing the exact same birthday as Lugnuts leadoff hitter **Rodney Green, Jr.**), went 4-1 with a 2.32 ERA in 31 innings in the Midwest League last year (45 K : 5 walks!), finished last season with Double-A Midland, and had 56 strikeouts in 38 innings across nine innings for Triple-A Las Vegas.

Patience is a Virtue: No player in Minor League Baseball has seen more pitches outside the zone than **Devin Taylor** (427 in 213 PAs, an average of 2.005 balls per plate appearance). Taylor has received 949 pitches overall in 213 PAs, leading the MWL by 101 pitches: 4.46 per plate appearance. Taylor has also played in all 48 games this year for Lansing.

Green Power: On May 12, **Rodney Green, Jr.** launched a 490-foot home run into the second floor of the Outfield Lofts apartments, the longest tracked home run of the 2026 season, Major League or Minor League.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

MAY 29 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2017: Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., blew his top, and the Lugnuts lost at home to the Loons, 5-3, on two Great Lakes runs in the ninth. Bo Bichette had tied the score at both 2-2 and 3-3 with RBI singles in the fifth and seventh innings respectively. After Keibert Ruiz and Gersel Pitre provided RBI singles for the Loons in the ninth, the Nuts put the tying runs at the corners for Vladdy, but Christian Stolo struck out the 18-year-old on the 11th pitch of an at-bat to end the game. Guerrero and his teammates argued that he had foul-tipped the pitch, which was smothered in the dirt by catcher Stevie Berman, who was then inadvertently struck in the head by Guerrero's backswing and crumpled in a heap. The game's final image saw the Lugnuts swarming and shouting at home plate umpire Tanner Dobson, who hurriedly made his exit, while the downed Berman received medical attention. Why did Ruiz not have to tag Guerrero on a strike-three in the dirt? Rule 6.06©: "If a batter strikes at a ball and misses and swings so hard he carries the bat all the way around and, in the umpire's judgment, unintentionally hits the catcher or the ball in back of him on the backswing before the catcher has securely held the ball, it shall be called a strike only (not interference). The ball will be dead, however, and no runner shall advance on the play."

2019: His 50-game suspension over, 2018 second-rounder Griffin Conine joined the Lugnuts and delivered a tie-breaking RBI single in the sixth inning for his first Midwest League hit, and Josh Winckowski posted seven scoreless innings with eight strikeouts in a 3-1 victory at Dayton.

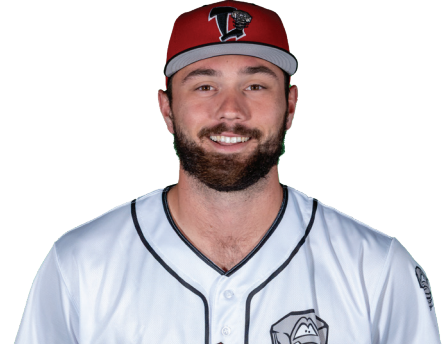

In a Nutshell: Made his Lugnuts debut on July 30, 2025, becoming the 973rd all-time Lansing Lugnuts player... joined the Lugnuts from Single-A Stockton, where he ranked 7th in the California League in strikeouts (77)... opened up the 2026 season in the Lugnuts' bullpen before receiving a spot start May 15 when Kyle Robinson was traded to Pittsburgh for Alika Williams.

Last Time Out: Tossed 2 2/3 innings at Lake County in a no-decision, May 22, allowing four hits and one run (one earned), no walks and three strikeouts; 55 pitches, 41 strikes... works today on a 60-pitch limit.

College Days: Two-way standout... played at Cisco College 2020-21, transferred to Cochise College, sat out 2022 and spent 2023 slugging at Division II Florida Southern (CSC Academic All-District), graduating with a degree in accounting... transferred to Mizzou as a grad student and converted to full-time pitching, posting 1-3 record with 4.63 ERA, 14 G, 4 GS, 35 IP, 11 BB, 37 K... notable Missouri Tigers include Max Scherzer, Ian Kinzler, Kameron Misner, and former Lugnut Luke Mann... signed for \$35,000 as the first pick in the 14th round of the 2024 draft.
