MESA JR. HELPS SHRIMP WALK OFF ON TIDES

Victor Mesa Jr.'s walk-off double capped a 4-3 Jacksonville win in Tuesday's series opener over Norfolk. After neither side scored in the first three innings, Mesa Jr. smashed a home run in the fourth for the contest's first run. Jonah Bride lashed an RBI double in the fifth before a Jonathan Davis RBI single an inning later put the score at 3-0. Patrick Monteverde fanned six in 5.0 scoreless innings, but the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen faltered in the eighth, ceding three runs for the Tides to knot the score. Mesa Jr. won it in the ninth and finished 3-for-4.

FRIENDS CLOSE. ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 11 of Jacksonville's 16 games (68.8 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have excelled in these contests, going 9-2 in those closely-decided affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

EIGHT CRAZY WINS

Jacksonville began the season by losing two of three games against Gwinnett, but since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have won eight of their last 13 games. All eight of those victories have come by three runs or fewer, with opponents actually outscoring Jacksonville by a 62-53 margin. Relatedly, those 53 runs scored rank third-fewest in Triple-A during this stretch. Conversely, the Jumbo Shrimp's 4.42 ERA ranks seventh in Triple-A over this run.

YES WAY, JOSÉ

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **José Devers** has reached base in 12 consecutive games entering play on Wednesday, tied for the fourth-longest active streak in the International League. Over this stretch, Devers is 14-for-42, batting .333/.391/.595/.986 with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, six RBIs, three walks and eight runs scored. Thus far in 2024, the native of Samana in the Dominican Republic has increased his line drive rate to 25.6 percent from 20.1 percent with Double-A Pensacola in 2023, while dropping his ground ball rate from 41.1 percent to 33.3 percent.

DIRTY DOZEN

Heading into play on Wednesday, a pair of different Jumbo Shrimp boast 12-game on-base streaks, which is tied for the fourth-longest active run in the International League. José Devers has been excellent at the plate, batting 14-for-42 (.333/.391/.595/.986) three doubles, one triple, two home runs, six RBIs, three walks and eight runs scored. Dane Myers has reached base multiple times just twice during his 12-game on-base streak. He is just 9-for-45 (.200/.308/.289/.597) with one home run, three RBIs, five walks and seven runs scored. Tristan Gray's 11-game on-base streak Tuesday ended with an 0-for-5 contest. He was 11-for-42 over his streak to bat .262/.354/.714/1.068 with one double, six home runs, 10 RBIs, five walks and nine runs scored.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

Jacksonville has scored a run in 36 of their 142 offensive innings thus far in 2024. Over those 36 innings, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored multiple runs in nearly half of those, a total of 15 frames. The club's biggest inning came during a five-run ninth inning on April 5 at Durham. Outside of that, the Jumbo Shrimp have logged five frames of three runs and nine two-run innings. They have yet to score exactly four runs in a frame.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 16 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 59 runs (3.7 per game), in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 25-for-134 (.187/.313/.306/.619, ranking 29th, 29th, 29th and 30th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 109 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has just three stolen base attempts and two stolen bases in the 10 games since April 5. Both figures are the fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp and Chicago Cubs are the only professional baseball teams to not steal a base since April 11.

ABOUT DARREN

-McCaughan was originally selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2017 draft out of Long Beach State. McCaughan made his major league debut for the Mariners on July 21, 2021 by pitching 5.0 innings of one-run ball at Coors Field against the Colorado Rockies.

-On February 9, 2024, two days after being designated for assignment, McCaughan was dealt to the Marlins in exchange for cash considerations.

-A terrific collegiate pitcher, McCaughan earned Big West Pitcher of the Year following both his sophomore (2016) and junior (2017) seasons at Long Beach State. He also became the first Long Beach State pitcher since Jered Weaver (2003-04) to be receive multiple All-American honors in consecutive seasons.

-With 414 strikeouts in 84 starts with Triple-A Tacoma, McCaughan is the "Rainiers" all-time strikeout leader (during Seattle affiliation, since 1995), and has accumulated the third-most strikeouts in franchise history. Ron Herbel (443 K) and Steve Luebber (431 K) from the 1960s and 70s remain the only hurlers who've fanned more batters than McCaughan during Tacoma's Triple-A history (since 1960).

2024 SEASON

-Tabbed as Opening Day starter for Jacksonville, tossed six innings and struck out four en route to 5-4 win over Gwinnett.

2023 SEASON

-In 12 home starts for Tacoma, McCaughan went 4-1, allowing 31 R, 25 ER on 55 hits in 67.2 innings for a 3.33 ERA.

-Held opponents to a .218 batting average when pitching at home

-Led all Tacoma pitchers in IP (139.0), starts (25), complete games (T-1st, 1) and strikeouts (130).

2022 SEASON

-Led Tacoma pitching staff in starts (28), IP (154.1) and strikeouts (141).

-In night games, he totaled 116.1 innings with 107 strikeouts to just 31 walks and held opponents to a .215 batting average.

-Held left-handed hitters to a .213 batting average and notched 76 strikeouts.

2021 SEASON

-McCaughan made his major league debut for the Mariners on July 21, 2021 with 5.0 innings of one-run ball in a game against the Colorado Rockies at Coors Field. He did not allow a hit and also did not strike out a batter. He walked three Rockies hitters in a 6-3 Mariners' loss.

-In Triple-A, left-handed batters posted a .779 OPS against him in 252 plate appearances. Right-handed hitters compiled a .699 OPS against McCaughan in 221 plate appearances.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-McCaughan majored in civil engineering in college.

-An excellent all-around player in high school, McCaughan batted .371 during his senior season.
