LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones returned to the win column on Thursday night with a 6-1 win over the BlueClaws...18 Chase Estep got Brooklyn's offense in gear early with a solo home run in the 2nd and an RBI single in the 4th...CF Omar De Los Santos picked up 3 hits, including an RBI single in the 5th and a 2-run homer in the 7th...2B César Berbesi garnered a pair of doubles and an RBI in the 7th...RHP Jeffrey Colón punched out 7 and permitted 1 run over 5.2 innings to earn his first win of 2023...RHP Dylan Tebrake and RHP Wilkin Ramos united for 3.1 frames of scoreless relief...1B Rixon Wingrove and 2B Wilfredo Flores each collected multi-hit games for Jersey Shore.

UP TO PAR-ADA: C Kevin Parada extended his hitting streak to 6 games with a knock in Thursday's win...The 21-year-old is 8-for-his-last-23 (.348) with a run scored, 2 doubles, 2 RBI, and a pair of walks...He is tied with Greenville's INF Blaze Jordan for 3rd in the SAL in doubles (13)...Only Winston-Salem OF Wilfred Veras (20) and Hudson Valley OF Spencer Jones (16) have collected more...In May, Parada was tied for 3rd in the circuit in two-baggers (9) and tied for 4th in the league in extra-base hits (12).

MATEO MASH: INF Mateo Gil has reached base safely in 10 of his last 11 games dating back to May 18 at Hudson Valley...While the 22-year-old is slashing only .235/.366/.559, he has registered an impressive .925 OPS in that time...Gil is 8-for-34 at the plate (.235) with 7 runs scored, 2 doubles, 3 home runs, and 9 RBI adding 7 walks and a hit-by-pitch...Since that date, Gil is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in home runs (3)...The former 3rd-round pick also leads Brooklyn OPS (.925) and is tied for the team lead in RBI (9) during that stretch (min. 15 PA).

OMAR ON THE RUN: OF Omar De Los Santos has reached base safely in 5-straight games since Sunday vs. Winston-Salem...The 23-year-old is 6-for-his-last-19 (.316) with 2 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 5 RBI, and 3 stolen bases...Since the start of last week's homestand, De Los Santos leads Brooklyn in hits (10), total bases (20), doubles (4), home runs (2), RBI (8), and stolen bases (5)...In addition to his 19 stolen bases in 2023, he remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 89 stolen bases in that span, which is 4th most in Mil.B...Only Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (96), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Nuñez (95), and Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (94) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 51 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 38... Omar is already 13 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

THRILL OF THE 'CHASE': After a bumpy month of April, INF Chase Estep picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...In his last 20 games dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old slashes .313/.378/.552 with a .931 OPS...Estep has accumulated 11 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, and 12 RBI in 74 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 148 wRC+...Estep has garnered at least one knock in 16 of those 20 games...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21...Estep has also raised his batting average by 162 points in that time (.047 to .209).

THEY'RE NO. 1: The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 15 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 30 earned runs (37 total) on 95 hits through the last 127.2 innings...That is good for a 2.11 ERA...That mark is the best in the SAL and the High-A level...It is also the 2nd-best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball in that stretch...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads MiLB (2.02)...Cyclones' pitching has walked 56 (10.7 BB%) and struck out 158 in that span (30.2 K%)...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 67-37, over the 15-game stretch... Brooklyn is 10-5 during that span...On the year, the Cyclones lead the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.89).

BULL-PEN ON PARADE: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Friday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.20) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...Rome (3.48) is 2nd in the circuit and the Dodgers' High-A Great Lakes is 2nd (3.32) at the classification...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 5th best in all of MiLB.

JEFE JEFFREY: RHP Jeffrey Colón tossed another gem on Thursday night, earning his first win in 2023...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts last Friday vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 3 appearances (2 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3 ER in 13.1 IP), allowing 10 hits and 5 walks, striking out 17...In his last 2 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span.

RIDING THE 'D' TRAIN: RHP Dylan Tebrake has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 5 relief appearances...Tebrake has not allowed a run on 1 hit and walked only 3 over 7.1 innings, registering 10 strikeouts...That equates to a 38.5 k%

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn travels south to Jersey Shore for a 8-game set against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws posses 2 of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: RHPs **Orion Kerkering** (25) and RHP **Tommy McCollum** (29) are featured...INF **Hao Yu Lee** (6) is currently on the 7-day injured list...The Cyclones went dropped 2-of-3 to Jersey Shore in their last meeting at ShoreTown Ballpark from April 25-30... The final 3 games of that series were postponed due to weather...On the year, the Cyclones are 3-3 against the BlueClaws in 6 matchups.

GREAT SCOTT!: RHP Christian Scott punched out a career-high 8 batters, earning the victory on Saturday vs. Winston-Salem...The Coconut Creek, Fla. native posted 5 innings of 1-hit, shutout ball...Over his last 2 starts dating back to Game 2 of last Sunday's doubleheader at Hudson Valley, Scott has not yielded a run on 2 hits over 9 innings... The former Florida Gator has not walked a hitter and punched out 10...In 4 starts since returning to Brooklyn on May 5, Scott is 1-0 with a 3.07 ERA (5 ER in 14.2 IP), 1 walk, 15 K's, and a WHIP of 0.82.

AT HIS BECK-ON CALL: RHP Jace Beck has been a strikeout machine in the 2023 season...The 22-year-old tied a career-best with 7 strikeouts over 2.1 innings, earning the win at Jersey Shore on Tuesday...Beck had previously punched out 7 on August 19, 2021, with the Florida Complex Mets at the FCL Astros...Through his first 11 relief appearances this summer, the Tuttle, Okla. native has registered an eye-popping strikeout rate of 45.1% and 20.09 strikeouts-per-nine-innings...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched, Beck leads the circuit in K/9 (20.09) and is 4th in strikeout rate (45.1%)...His 20.09 K/9 mark is 2nd-best in MiLB among arms with at least 10.0 IP...Cleveland's RHP Tyler Thornton (20.54) leads at High-A Lake County.

THE DONUT SHOPPE: Brooklyn's pitching staff has made a habit of tossing donuts on the scoreboard...The Cyclones completed their 4th shutout of the 2023 season with an 8-0 win at Jersey Shore on Tuesday night...All 4 blankings for Brooklyn's pitching staff have occured in May...The Cyclones beat Aberdeen, 3-0, at home on May 7 and shutout Hudson Valley, 6-0, on the road in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21... Brooklyn's previous shutout was a 4-0 triumph vs. Winston-Salem last Wednesday afternoon...Tuesday marked the 'Clones first shutout over the BlueClaws since a 7-0 win at ShoreTown Ballpark on August 23, 2022...LHP Keyshawn Askew (6.0 IP) and RHP Jeffrey Colón (3.0) united on a 3-hitter that day.

BLADE RUNNER: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision on Tuesday, but hurled 3.2 innings of shutout ball...Over his last 3 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 2-0 with a 1.32 ERA (2 ER in 13.2 IP) with just 6 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 12 and struck out 19...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 32.8% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .130 batting average (6-46) against him...In that span, the 2022 2nd-round pick is tied for 4th in the SAL in strikeouts (19).

IN THE 'PALM' OF HIS HAND: IF/OF Jaylen Palmer has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Friday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (180), at-bats (592), plate appearances (709), runs scored (94), walks (97), and stolen bases (45)...Palmer passed INF Ronny Mauricio '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (65) on May 23, added an RBI on May 27, and is 4 behind INF José Peroza (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (189), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and 6th in hits (111).

BIG STU: At 6-foot-9, RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent and imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old had his scoreless inning streak snapped at 15.1 innings on Sunday, but permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May...Stuart leads the SAL — and all qualified High-A pitchers — in ERA (1.13) by nearly a full run over Wilmington's LHP **Dustin Saenz** (2.03)...Stuart is also 7th in the circuit in WHIP (1.15) and 8th in batting average against (.213)...The Kankakee, III. native is also 1st in LOB% (89.4%), 2nd in FIP (2.86), 3rd in xFIP (3.48), and 4th in strikeout rate (30.8%) plus strikeouts per 9 innings (11.08).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn boast the top 2 Mets per MLB Pipeline in C Kevin Parada and CF Alex Ramírez...They also hold 3 of the Top 10 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline and Baseball America and 5 of the Top 30...They include Parada (No. 1 MLB Pipeline/No. 4 Baseball America), Ramírez (2/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (5/9)... INF William Lugo (24/26) and RHP Christian Scott (28/26) also appears on both lists... OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 19 farmhand per MLB Pipeline.

GREAT SCOTT!: Scott punched out a career-high 8 batters, earning the victory last Saturday vs. Winston-Salem...Over his last 2 starts dating back to Game 2 of a doubleheader on May 21 at Hudson Valley, he has not yielded a run on 2 hits over 9.0 innings...The former Florida Gator has not walked a hitter and punched out 10.

2022: Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie on May 10...Collected a 3-3 mark with a 4.82 ERA (20 ER in 37.1 IP) and 52 strikeouts in 12 appearances (4 starts) with the Mets...Placed on the 7-day injured list on July 3 and reinstated on July 27...Transferred to High-A Brooklyn on August 8...Did not receive a decision and accrued a 3.80 ERA (9 ER in 21.1 IP) with 25 K's in 6 outings (5 starts) with the Cyclones...Did not appear for Brooklyn in the postseason.

FREE 'FALL'-IN: Following the 2022 Minor League season, Scott was one of several Mets prospect selected to participate in the prestigious Arizona Fall League...The 23-year-old made 4 starts for the Peoria Javelinas, tallying an 0-2 record and a 10.38 ERA (15 ER in 13.0 IP) with 10 strikeouts...Scott was teammates with fellow 2023 CycloneS OF Stanley Consuegra and INF Kevin Kendall, as well as former Brooklyn standouts OF Brandon McIlwain '22, INF Luke Ritter '21, and RHP Grant Hartwig '22.

PROSPECTS: Scott entered the 2023 season ranked as one of the New York Mets Top 30 prospects according to various publications...The right-hander is deemed New York's No. 26 farmhand by Baseball America and No. 28 by MLB Pipeline.
