The Frisco RoughRiders dropped to the Amarillo Sod Poodles 4-1 from HODGETOWN on Friday night. The RoughRiders (6-10, 44-40) struck first in the top of the second inning when **Keith Jones II** laced an RBI single into right, putting them up 1-0. The Sod Poodles (9-7, 41-44) then answered when Christian Cerda lifted a solo home run to left against Frisco starter **David Davalillo**. In his third Double-A start, Davalillo allowed just the one run over his 4.2 innings, surrendering four hits while striking out six and not walking a batter. The 1-1 score held until the seventh when **Josh Hatcher** blasted a solo homer down the right-field line, jumping Frisco in front 2-1. In the top of the ninth, the Riders put up a pair of insurance runs on an error and a fielder's choice to lead 4-1. The bullpen dominated in the game with **Larson Kindreich** (3-2) earning the victory after his 2.1 scoreless innings and **Nick Krauth** took in his first save by throwing the last two innings. Jimmy Endersby (1-1) was handed the tough-luck loss, surrendering just two runs over seven innings.

Abimelec Ortiz homered again in Amarillo on Wednesday. Head-to-head against Amarillo, Ortiz has 11 home runs against the Sod Poodles while batting .271/.340/.556/.896 with 27 RBIs in 33 games. At HODGETOWN, he has been even better, hitting .306 (22-for-82)/.390/.625/1.015 with seven home runs and 15 RBIs in 17 games. His seven homers are the most by a visiting player at Amarillo in the last two seasons and more than all but seven Amarillo players in HODGETOWN as well.

Keyber Rodriguez has been swinging a hot bat for the Riders recently. Since June 15th, in his last 18 games, he is hitting .385 (25-for-65)/.467/.477/.944 with six doubles, five RBIs, eight walks, 10 runs scored and just six strikeouts. In July, he is batting .379 (11for-29) over eight games.

CAULEY! CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:

Cam Cauley has been incredible for the RoughRiders lately on offense. In his last 53 games since May 7th, he is batting .275/.342/.475/.817 with 15 doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBIs and 14 stolen bases. In his last 17 games, he is slashing .310/.367/.577/.944 with five doubles, four home runs, 11 RBIs and seven steals.

EVERY DAY SHOULD BE BRATT-URDAY:

Starting pitcher Mitch Bratt has been one of the best in the Texas League this season and was dominant on Saturday against Arkansas, going six innings on one-run baseball. He is second in the league in ERA (2.55) while leading the league with 91 strikeouts this season. He is also sixth in innings (74.0), first in WHIP (1.08), first in strikeout rate (30.5 percent), first in walk rate (4.0 percent), second in left on base rate (83.1 percent) and first in swinging strike rate (14.0). Among full-season pitchers, his strikeout to walk ratio of 7.58 is third in all of Minor League Baseball.

SWIPE CITY:

The RoughRiders have now stolen at least one base in 16 of their last 17 games. Over those 17 games, they have stolen 30 total bases, which is third in the league. **Sebastian Walcott** is tied for the league lead with eight steals in that span while **Cam Cauley** is fourth with six. Overall this season, the Riders are tied for fifth in the league with 98 stolen bases.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

 $\overline{\text{After the RoughRiders committed 20 errors in 23 April games, which was sixth in the league, they have the fewest in the league$ overall with 57. They also have just committed just 38 errors in their last 61 games. That mark is also second-best in Double-A. Their 52 double plays turned since May 1st are also second in the league. Their 55 stolen bases allowed are the fewest in Double-A and are the third-rewest in Minor League Baseball. Against the best stolen base team in the league in Arkansas, Frisco allowed seven stolen bases over the six games, below the Travelers' season-average of 11 per series.

SAVE TONIGHT:

The RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. **Gavin Collyer** are leads the team saves (eight) for the Riders, a mark that second in the Texas League. Their 27 saves are tied for the most in Double-A. Their 4.24 bullpen ERA is seventh in the league. In June, their 3.62 reliever ERA was fourth in the Texas League.

WALLY'S WORLD:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239. but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.5 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.3 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 33 steals over 128 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22).

-Recorded RoughRiders first quality start of the season on 4/11 at NWA, allowing two runs over six innings with six strikeouts to no walks. He moved up a day in the rotation, pitching on five days rest.

-On May 10th at San Antonio, Bratt took a no-hitter into the sixth inning before allowing a bloop single into right. He struck out a career-high 10 batters in the game before leading after six innings. The RoughRiders fell 2-1 on a two-run walk-off home run from Romeo Sanabria.

-In May, Bratt went 3-0 over five starts, owning a 1.33 ERA, 27.0 IP, 24 H, 5 R, 4 ER, 3 BB, 31 K.

2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-After tough first start of the season (3.0 IP, 8 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 0 BB, 4 K vs. JS) with Hickory, has gone 6-3 with a 2.30 ERA over his last 16 games (14 starts) with 80 strikeouts to 16 walks over 74.1 innings

-In last 10 games in Hickory (nine starts), went 4-1 with 1.35 ERA, striking out 55 over $53.1\,\mathrm{IP}$ to 11 walks, holding opponents to .182 batting average.
