YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 10-3, in 10 innings. **Marco Luciano** opened the scoring with a solo homer in the first. Wenceel Perez tied the game in the third with an RBI double, the only run allowed by **Landen Roupp**, who set a season high with seven strikeouts. Richmond moved back in front in the fourth with an RBI single by **Carter Aldrete**. Erie took a 3-2 lead in the fifth a two-run double by Wenceel Perez. In the six, **Vaun Brown** hit a solo homer to tie the game, 3-3. Erie brought in seven runs in the top of the 10th inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Today is the 15th of 24 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 4-2 against the SeaWolves at The Diamond from April 18-23. Erie won five-of-six at UPMC Park from May 9-14. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will head back to Erie for six games to close the regular season from September 12-17.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are on their longest losing streak of the season, dropping six straight since last Thursday. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 18-of-their-last-25. Their 7-18 record since May 3 is the worst in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 159.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 234.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.11 ERA, which is the lowest in Double-A and the third-lowest of all 120 teams in Minor League Baseball, trailing Low-A Columbia (2.98) and Low-A Tampa (3.04).

THE SEAWOLVES are in first place in the Southwest Division, two games ahead of Altoona, and have won six-of-their-last-eight games. The SeaWolves' offense leads the Eastern League in runs scored (275), hits (405), total bases (668), triples (12), OBP (.354) and OPS (.769) and ranks second in batting average (.252), homers (55) and SLG (.415). Erie's roster includes seven of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 3), RHP Ty Madden (No. 4), INF Colt Keith (No. 5), C Dillon Dingler (No. 7), INF Wenceel Perez (No. 18), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 26) and INF Gage Workman (No. 27). Andrew Magno is rated by Baseball America as having the best curveball in Detroit's system, Dingler is rated as the best defensive catcher, Perez is rated as the best hitter for average and Workman is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB. com's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes Keith (No. 2), Flores (No. 4), Madden (No. 5), Perez (No. 8), Dingler (No. 14), Hurter (No. 21), Workman (No. 28) and Keider Montero (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Nick Zwack** makes his ninth start and ninth 10th of the season. He last pitched last Friday at Binghamton and allowed five runs over three innings in his first start against his former organization. Zwack has faced the SeaWolves three times this year. He made a start on April 20 at The Diamond and allowed two runs over two innings. On May 9 at UPMC Park, he allowed a season-high seven runs over three runs in a loss. He pitched out of the bullpen in Erie on May 14 and surrendered one run in four innings to pick up his first Double-A win. Zwack was selected in the 17th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets out of Xavier and traded to the Giants last August as part of the deal for Darin Ruf. After starting the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, Zwack earned a promotion to High-A Brooklyn, where he went 5-1 with a 1.84 ERA in 14 outings, landing the trade. Zwack, a native of Minneapolis, played his college career at Xavier, where he was a First-Team All-Big East selection in 2021 as a senior. *For more on Zwack, see page two.*

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Keider Montero makes his sixth Double-A start of the year and his third against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, Montero allowed two runs over five innings in a win against the Patriots on Friday. He first faced the Flying Squirrels in his Erie home debut on May 9 and picked up his first Double-A win, striking out a season-high-tying eight batters over five innings and allowing one unearned run. In the finale of the last series between these two teams, Montero allowed five runs over 3.2 innings in a loss. Montero signed with the Tigers as an international free agent out of Venezuela in 2016. He opened this year with the High-A West Michigan Whitecaps, his third season in the Midwest League, and posted a 2.81 ERA in four starts. Montero was promoted to Double-A Erie on May 2.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, they are again leading the level in average attendance (6,787) and rank second in total attendance (149,323), trailing Tulsa, who has hosted four more home dates. The Flying Squirrels are ranked seventh of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. Wednesday's game was the second official sellout of the season, joining the game on May 17 that drew 9,810 fans, an 11-4 Richmond win over Akron.

WHERE THERE'S A WILLIAMS THERE'S A WAY: Carter Williams has homered in back-to-back games dating back to Sunday's series finale in Binghamton. He hit a solo home run on Sunday night to help fuel the Flying Squirrels overcoming an early five-run hole before falling in extras. On Tuesday to open the series against the SeeaWolves, he clubbed a solo homer to bring in Richmond's only run of the game. Williams now has five home runs at Double-A this year. Over his last three games since Saturday, Williams his is batting .333 (4-for-12) with two homers, two RBIs and four runs scored. In his first full professional season in 2022, Williams hit .336 with 11 homers between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, earning a pick as an MiLB.com Giants Organization All-Star.

ALRIGHTY, ALDRETE: Carter Aldrete has driven in 10 runs over his last 13 games since May 17. In his last 21 games since May 6, he is batting .289 (24-for-93) with four homers, six doubles and 2 RBIs. Aldrete had hit safely in nine straight games prior to going 0-for-3 on Tuesday, which was the third-longest active hitting streak in the Eastern League. He has reached base in 15 straight games since May 14, which is the sixth-longest current streak in the league.

VAUN RETURNS: Outfielder Vaun Brown was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on May 16. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown has reached base in each of his eight games with Richmond.

GLOW SHOW: Infielder **Jimmy Glowenke** was assigned to Double-A Richmond on Tuesday and is slated to make his Double-A debut. He was selected in the second round (68th overall) by the Giants in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist. Glowenke started the season with High-A Eugene. Among Northwest League hitters (min. 100 PA) this year, Glowenke ranked sixth in OPS (.956), sixth in batting average (.313), sixth in wRC+ (146), seventh in OBP (.413), tied for seventh in doubles (10) and eighth in SLG (.542). He also had the fourth-lowest strikeouts percentage (14.3) in the league.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Luis Matos is ranked fourth in batting average (.304). Ismael Munguia is eighth in batting average (.300). Carter Aldrete is tied for seventh in RBIs (26). Hayden Cantrelle is sixth in OBP (.410) and tied for 10th in walks (29). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for second in triples (3). Evan Gates is tied for eighth in saves (4). Carson Seymour is sixth in ERA (3.11) and ninth in BAA (.219). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for sixth in strikeouts (52).

WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Colt Keith is second in batting average (.331), tied for sixth in homers (9), second in RBIs (39), ninth in OBP (.399), third in SLG (.571), third in OPS (.970), second in hits (58), tied for fourth in doubles (11), tied for third in extra-base hits (22), second in total bases (100) and tied for fifth in runs scored (31). Jake Holton is ninth in OBP (.399) and tied for sixth in walks (32). Trei Cruz is tied for fifth in runs scored (31) and Wenceel Perez is tied for ninth in runs scored (30).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 1, No. 30 overall), **Vaun Brown** (No. 6), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Landen Roupp** (No. 13), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Wade Meckler** (No. 23) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).

MAY WRAP: The Flying Squirrels went 8-18 in May, worst in the league. The pitching staff posted a 4.65 ERA, which was eighth in the EL. The offense hit .229, which was last. Hayden Cantrelle ranked eighth in the league in OBP (.417) and third in walks (22). Ismael Munguia ranked tied for sixth in doubles (7). The Flying Squirrels began the month in first place in the Southwest Division and closed the month in fifth.


