Round Rock and El Paso will start their six-game series on Tuesday night at Dell Diamond. Express RHP Kyle Cody is scheduled to start against Chihuahuas RHP Anderson Espinoza. First pitch is slated for 7:05 p.m. CT.

### LOST IN THE LATE INNINGS

The Express dropped the series finale on Sunday by a final of 7-5. 2B Michael Busch hit a two-run homer in the first to give the Dodgers a 2-0 lead. Round Rock 1B Blaine Crim tied the contest at two in the bottom of the first with a two-run homer of his own. Crim kept it going in the third with another two-run dinger that gave the Express a 4-2 lead. The Express took a 5-2 lead in the sixth when 2B Dio Arias and SS Davis Wendzel hit back-to-back doubles. Dodgers 1B Devin Mann tied things up thanks to a two-run homer in the eighth. CF Ben DeLuzio scored on a Busch double for the inning's first of three runs before Mann's shot. Oklahoma City broke the tie in the ninth as C Patrick Mazeika knocked a two-out double before a single from DeLuzio scored PR Bradley Zimmer. DeLuzio made it a 7-5 game after scoring on a Round Rock error.

### CALLING ON KYLE CODY

Express RHP Kyle Cody will make his eighth appearance and sixth start on Tuesday night. The righty is coming off a relief outing in which he tossed 4.2 frames and collected a season-high seven strikeouts while allowing one run. It's the most strikeouts he's had since August 20, 2017 while pitching for Low-A Down East.

### A FIRST FOR EVERYTHING

The Express were swept in six games for the first time in club history last week. Round Rock has lost seven consecutive games and now trails first-place Oklahoma City by 6.5 games in the Pacific Coast League standings. The E-Train we're outscored 34-16 in the six-game set.

### MAY STRUGGLES

Round Rock is 3-9 to start the month of May and has allowed five or more runs in seven of their last nine games. They own a 5.35 ERA (60 ER/101.0 IP) this month, and on offense, the E-Train are hitting .233 (91-for-390) thus far in May. Last month, the Express posted a 3.42 ERA (85 ER/224.0 IP).

### CRIM CRUSH...TWICE

Express 1B Blaine Crim tallied his third and fourth home runs of the season on Sunday afternoon and became the second Round Rock player to hit two home runs in one game this season. Crim logged two, two-home run games during the 2022 season while with Double-A Frisco, his latest being on August 31 in Amarillo. The righty is slashing .270/.367/.459/.826 with five doubles, two triples, four home runs, 12 RBI, 20 runs scored, 16 walks and 17 strikeouts.

### MLB DEBUT

Express LHP Cody Bradford had his contract selected by the Texas Rangers yesterday and made his Major League debut on the bump at Globe Life Field against the Atlanta Braves. Bradford got the loss after he went 5.0 innings and allowed six earned runs on seven hits with two walks and three strikeouts. Bradford was recently named the Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Month and the Texas Rangers Minor League Starting Pitcher of the Month for April.

### ROSTER MOVES

After LHP Cody Bradford made his MLB debut yesterday, RHP Yerry Rodriguez was optioned to Round Rock. After Bradford was optioned back to Round Rock on Tuesday, RHP Joe Barlow was recalled to Texas. Barlow went 2-0 with a 2.63 ERA (4 ER/13.2 IP) in 11 relief outings.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
