ABOUT LAST NIGHT: RHP **Luis Moreno** spun a career-high seven innings en route to a demonstrative 9-1 victory for the Brooklyn Cyclones over the Wilmington Blue Rocks. Moreno lowered his Brooklyn ERA to 2.96 with the effort. Offensively, DH **Jose Mena** went 4-for-4 with two doubles and C **Matt O'Neill** drove in three and scored three times in the victory. 1B **JT Schwartz** stayed hot, collecting three hits for the second-consecutive night. INF **Jose Peroza** extended his on-base streak to 30 games, going 1-for-5. The Cyclones lead the series two games to one.

DIVISION ON THE LINE: Including today, the Cyclones have nine games remaining and two series: three more games vs. Wilmington, and six games at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting in first place by a half game over the New York Yankees affiliate the Hudson Valley Renegades.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .893 over his past 43 games with a 30-game on-base streak. The 22-year-old Venezuelan has been on base in 41 of the past 43 games, hitting .325 with a .412 OBP. The Cyclones team record for consecutive games reaching base is held by INF **Jake Eigsti** who in 2007 reached base 32 consecutive times. Peroza is currently tied with OF **Justin Garber's** 30-game record from 2009 that is tied for the second-longest in team history.

JT JOLTING: Since returning from injury on August 17, 1B **JT Schwartz** is hitting .375 with a .955 OPS, going 21-56 with six doubles, a home run in 13 games. Coincidentally, Schwartz's first game back from injury was also the day he fell from the No. 19 spot in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Mets list to being out of the ranking.

LUGO LAUNCHING: Over his past four games, 3B

vs. WILMINGTON: The Washington Nationals affiliate comes back to Coney Island for the final meeting of 2022. The Blue Rocks, from Wilmington, DE are 12-11 against the Cyclones in 2022. Wilmington hosts three of Washington's Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline: No. 10 OF Jeremy De La Rosa, No. 27 LHP Mitchell Parker, and MLB rehabber No. 29 LHP Evan Lee. The Blue Rocks enter Friday's game eight games behind first place.

William Lugo has a double, two home runs, and eight RBIs, hitting .421 (8-19). Lugo has blasted four home runs with Brooklyn and has a career-high 14 overall after 10 long balls with Low-A St. Lucie.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league and the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball, having allowed 490 runs in 123 games (4.0 runs/game).

THAT'S OFFENSIVE!: The Cyclones have scored just 515 runs in 123 games (4.2 runs/game) which ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League and tied for ninth-worst in MiLB in fewest runs.

SHERVYEN FOR PRESIDENT: INF **Shervyen Newton** won the South Atlantic League's Offensive Player of the Week Award for his week in New Jersey against the Phillies High-A farm club, going 9-for-23 (.391) with three doubles, three home runs, 10 RBIs, and eight runs scored in the six-game sweep.

RANKINGS: Dominic Hamel ranks as the No. 12 prospect in the New York Mets organization and the No. 5 pitching prospect in the system.

TREND BEHIND RIGHTED: Of his 17 runs allowed with Brooklyn, eight have been runners who reached on a walk. Hamel has a walk rate of 21% over his past three starts.

PROMOTED: Dominic Hamel, who is the Mets No. 12 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, earned the promotion from Low-A St. Lucie, joining the Cyclones on the Fourth of July.

ST. LUCIE: With the Low-A St. Lucie Mets, Hamel made 14 appearances and 13 starts, posting a 3.84 ERA in 63 1/3 innings. Hamel posted a 27% strikeout rate, 11% walk rate, and a 3.91 FIP.

DOM-INANT JUNE: Hamel posted a 2.84 ERA in June, making five starts. He struck out 30 and walked 10 in 25 1/3 innings.

BEGINNINGS: The Arizona native was drafted by the Mets in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist, signing for \$755,300 and made two appearances for the Florida Complex League Mets last year.

COLLEGE DAYS: Hamel pitched at Dallas Baptist in 2020 and 2021 after two seasons at Yavapai College. At Dallas Baptist in his senior season, Hamel set a school record with 136 strikeouts in 91 2/3 innings.
