FAMILIAR FACE: When Adam Plutko climbs the mound today, it will be the first start of his career against the Columbus Clippers. Plutko pitched for the Clippers from 2016-2019. His start against the Clippers will mark the 17th different team in the current International League that he has faced in his career. The only remaining IL teams he hasn't faced are Memphis, Nashville and St. Paul.

IN THE ZONE: Pitching has been at the forefront for the Saints for the last week, striking out 60 batters while issuing just 11 walks. The 11 walks issued since Tuesday are the fewest in Triple-A and tied for the fifth-fewest among full-season minor league teams. The Saints' 5.45 K/BB ratio is also the best in Triple-A and over two strikeouts better than the next-closest team (Salt Lake - 3.35). The 5.45 ratio since July 30 is the second-best among full-season clubs. The Saints' 2.65 K/BB ratio in 2024 is the best in Triple A.

> ON THE RUN: The Saints have stolen a base in their last 13 games dating back to July 21, tying the longest streak in franchise history. In that stretch, the Saints have gone 24-for-27 in stolen base attempts and successful in their last 11 tries. Their streak ties the franchise-record 13 game run from May 12-26. The Saints have been successful in 84.1% of their attempts this season, the second-highest mark in Triple-A and the ninth-best among full-season minor league teams.

> JULIEN JUMPING ON BASE: Edouard Julien has reached base in 31 consecutive games, riding the Saints' longest on-base streak this season. It is the second-longest franchise history trailing only Jake Cave's 49-game streak in 2022. It is tied for the third-longest streak in the International League this season. During Julien's 31-game streak, he is hitting 27/1/16/1/16 (1966 OPS) is hitting .274/.450/.416 (.866 OPS).

> **WILLIAMS RECORD WATCH:** Chris Williams hit his 12th home run of the season on July 21 and the 43rd of his Saints career. He has tied Mark Contreras for the career franchise lead at 43 long balls. His 43 home runs since his Triple-A debut on July 17, 2022 are tied for the 10th-most in the International League.
>
> \$ Since the start of July, Williams has clubbed seven home runs, tied

for the fifth-most in the International League. He also ranks among league leaders in that time with his 19 runs (T-6th), his .622 slugging percentage (6th) and 12 extra-base hits (T-8th).

ELECTRIC EELES: Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .411 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 20 of the 23 games he's played in, drawing 14 walks and been hit by a pitch four times. He is fifth among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .441 across three levels. Of the five players ahead of him, only two have played in Triple-A.

SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: In Yunior Severino's 54 games since May When Saints Score 4+ 47-20 SUMMERTIME SEVERINU: In Yunior Severino's 54 garnes since May When Saints Score 3- 52 In, he has hit .337 (68-for-202), with 12 home runs, drawing 39 walks, owning a 1.003 OPS. In that time, Severino leads the league in batting average, second in on-base percentage at .439, second with 45 RBI, third in OPS, fourth in slugging percentage at .564 and tied for third with Days In Second Place 58 hits. His 38 walks since May 21 are the tied for the sixth-most in the Days In Third Place...... 6 league.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 7/26 v OMA...made 10th start of the season, tossing his quality start of the year...threw 6.0 innings of one-hit baseball, walking one and striking out a season-high eight...walked one in the first inning before retiring seven in a row into the third inning when he allowed a two-out single...retired his final 10 batters faced through the sixth inning...was the 14th start in the IL in 2024 to go at least 6.0 innings allowing one-or-fewer hits and zero runs and the seventh such start to also have at least eight strikeouts...marked the second time this year Plutko has retired 10 in a row, matching his July 12 effort at Louisville in relief...received fifth win in 6-1 Saints victory

FROM THE TWINS TO THE TWINS: The last 2 seasons for Plutko have been spent in the KBO, where he has dominated for the LG Twins, going 26-8 between the 2022 and 2023 seasons. After signing for \$500,000 in 2022, he went 15-5 in his first season, re-signing for \$ 1.4 million in 2023. He followed that campaign with a season that saw him go 11-3, but did not make it to the championship series due to a hip injury.

REMEMBER THE PAC 12: Plutko finished his career as one of the best pitchers in program history at UCLA, where he finished his three-year stint there with second-most wins (29), starts (52) and IP (351.1) in school history. His career ERA of 2.25 and 272 career strikeouts both rank 7th on UCLA's all-time lists. His sister, Sara, was a three-year soccer letterwinner at University of Oregon and his wife, Allison, was a four-year gymnast at UCLA and was on same team as gold medalist Carly Patterson.

LEAVE A MESSAGE AFTER THE TONE: When he was promoted to Triple-A Columbus (Cleveland organization) in September, 2021 he missed the phone call from Cleveland's Director of Player Personnel Carter Hawkins because he was at a friend's wedding. They had just got done saying, "I Do" and got done taking the bridal party photos. Got a call from Cleveland and he put it straight to voice mail. When the call came again his wife Allison prodded him to answer because it could be important, so he did.

NOT PERFECT, BUT STILL PRETTY GOOD: On June 2, 2018, Plutko was spinning a gem with Columbus, not allowing a baserunner until the ninth inning at Syracuse when he issued a one-out walk. He followed that with a fly out and a strikeout to finish off the no-hitter. It was just the ninth complete-game no-hitter in the IL since 2005. It continued a stellar stretch for Plutko, who took a no-hitter into the sixth just two starts prior with Cleveland against the Chicago Cubs
