WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Double-A Harrisburg snapped a three-game skid with a 7-2 win over Richmond (SF) last night...1B **ETHAN PETRY** launched his 19th homer of the season and 10th with Harrisburg, while adding an RBI single and a bases-loaded walk.

THESE WINGS NEVER DIE: Powered by a pair of home runs from LF **TREY LIPSCOMB**, the Rochester Red Wings secured a 5-2 victory over the Charlotte Knights (42-34, 64-55) on Saturday evening...Lipscomb went 3-for-4 at the plate and tallied four RBI, while RF **LEANDRO PINEDA** added two hits alongside a run of his own...six different arms saw time on the hill, with LHP **ERIK TOLMAN** earning his third victory of the season...the Red Wings look to win their 13th series of the season today, sending RHP **ZAK KENT** to the mound against Knight RHP Jonathan Cannon...

After last night's win, the Red Wings have now split or won nine of their last 10 home series against Charlotte dating back to 2011 (DNP 2021-25), going 24-12 over that span.

WHAT KENT HE DO?: RHP **ZAK KENT** will take the ball first this afternoon, making his first start since 9/20/2024 at TOL, with COL...he tossed 2.0 scoreless innings on one hit with a strikeout Wednesday night, and now owns a 0.64 ERA (1 ER/14.0 IP) across 12 appearances at ESL Ballpark...the 28-year-old Virginia native will be the 21st Red Wing to make a start in 2026...Kent is just four appearances short of 100 in his Triple-A career.

LIPPING UP TO THE HYPE: LF **TREY LIPSCOMB** nearly blew the top off of ESL Ballpark in last night's three-run victory, propelling the Red Wings to flight with his 23rd and 24th homers of the season...his first, an opposite-field long ball, cut the deficit to a single run while his seventh-inning slam came as a three-run shot that put the Wings up 5-2, and eventually the nail in the coffin...the former Tennessee Volunteer now boasts three separate multi-home run games in his career, with two occurring against CLT (7/29/25)...he now has 75 RBI, which overtakes his previous career-high in the category (72, 2023)...Lipscomb joins Travis Blankenhorn (75 in 2023) as the only Red Wings in the Nationals era (since 2021) to drive in at least 75 runs in a single season...his 24 home runs are tied for the most by a Rochester right-handed hitter since Adam Brett Walker hit 27 in 2016...

Among all Minor Leaguers who have faced the Knights (min. 40 AB), he holds the lead in batting average (.429), SLG (.786), OPS (1.215) and isolated power (.357).

CLEARED FOR LANDING: Following the start from RHP **EDDY YEAN**, LHP **JARED SIMPSON** tossed five strikeouts across 2.1 innings without allowing a hit or a walk...Saturday night marked the first five-K outing of his Minor League career, and his first game at the Triple-A level without allowing a hit or walk...RHP **LUIS PERALES** followed Simpson with five strikeouts of his own in two full innings of work, bringing his strikeout total to 19 over 18.0 innings pitched in four games as a reliever this season...the duo combined for 10 of the 14 strikeouts from the Red Wings' bullpen Saturday...

Since the All-Star break, the Red Wings' bullpen leads all MiLB in holds (19) and ranks second in strikeouts (174)...across Triple-A, they lead in ERA (3.01, 49 ER/146.1 IP) and rank second in batting average (.214)...they also rank fourth in the International League in wins (12), earned runs (49), WHIP (1.31), and K/BB (2.35).

GUS LIGHTYEAR: RHP **GUS VARLAND** came on once again in the ninth inning last night, and retired all three batters he faced to pick up his third save as a Red Wing...after locking things down for his second save Friday night, Varland is the second Rochester pitcher to notch a save on back-to-back days this season, joining RHP **EDDY YEAN** (6/2 & 6/3 at LHV)...the Minnesota native has not allowed an earned run in four-straight, and 11 of his last 12 outings with the Red Wings dating back to 7/11 at WOR...he is one of six International League relievers to turn in at least 10.0 innings, while allowing one or fewer earned runs over that stretch.

GLASSERPIECE: After working a walk in the seventh inning last night, DH **PHILLIP GLASSER** extended his on-base streak to 22 games dating back to 7/22...this is the longest such streak by a Red Wing in 2026, and is the longest since 3B **YOHANDY MORALES** reached safely in 25-straight from 7/1-8/5 in 2025...the Canton, Ohio native is reaching base at a .426 clip with an International League-leading 22 walks over the course of the streak...since making his Triple-A debut on 9/9/2025, Glasser ranks eighth in the IL in OBP (.392), and ranks sixth in batting average (.301).

(LEAND)ING THE WAY: RF **LEANDRO PINEDA** notched a pair of singles and scored a run in the winning effort...his single in the seventh inning kick started the Wings' comeback that saw himself and three of his teammates cross home plate...Saturday marked the 14th game of his first 15 as a Red Wing that the Venezuela native has reached base safely.

Entering his ninth professional season, first with the Nationals organization after he was claimed off waivers on 5/3/2026...originally selected in the ninth round of the 2019 MLB Draft by Texas, out of Virginia Military Institute...named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on 7/18/2018 and 8/8/2018 with High-A Hickory (TEX).

- Slated to make his first start since 9/20/2024 with Columbus in this afternoon's series finale.
- Recalled by Washington on 5/6 before appearing in a game for the Red Wings...appeared in four games in relief with the Nationals (6.35 ERA, 4 ER/5.2 IP), striking out five without allowing a walk...optioned to Rochester on 5/15...recalled by Washington a second time on 6/26...appeared in four additional games with the Nationals before he was optioned on 7/5.
- Through seven day games with the Red Wings this season, carries an ERA of 1.08 (1 ER/8.1 IP) and WHIP of 1.08...also holding batters to a .200 in such contests.
- Recorded seven consecutive efforts with no earned runs from 7/12-8/1...also allowed just three hits over the span.
- With a record of 4-0, holds the team lead in wins without a loss of any Red Wings pitcher on the current active roster.
- Opened the 2026 season with Minnesota, appearing in two games out of the bullpen before being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on 4/5...made eight relief appearances to a 3.38 ERA (4 ER/10.2 IP) before being designated for assignment on 4/28...claimed off waivers by Washington on 5/3 and assigned to Triple-A Rochester.
- Split the 2025 season between Triple-A Columbus (34 G) and Cleveland (12 G), posting a 2.84 ERA (12 ER/38.0 IP) with 50 strikeouts and 21 walks with Columbus, and a 4.58 ERA (9 ER/17.2 IP) with Cleveland.
- Pitched to a 1.00 ERA (2 ER/18.0 IP) over his first 13 Triple-A appearances in 2025, earning a save and striking out 29 to just nine walks.
- Has appeared in 14 MLB games between Cleveland (12 G) and Minnesota (2 G), holding a 4.64 ERA (11 ER/21.1 IP) with 18 strikeouts, 13 walks, and a 1.59 WHIP.
