## GET TO KNOW YOUR C'S DONNIE MURPHY, MANAGER

### You played in Vancouver as a member of the visiting team when you were in the minors. Do you have any memories of Nat Bailey Stadium or the city itself?

I remeber the stadium being packed every nights. The atmosphere was really great, and the city in general is pretty awesome. That's what you heard from all the guys who had been there before. They'd talk about how cool city was and, you know, how incrdible the energy was everywhere. That's something that's going to be truly missed this season.

### *This season is your first as a manager. How would you describe your managerial style?*

Most importantly, we are going to be a very aggressive team. That's the main thing I tried to impart to these guys in Spring Training, and especially on the bases. We're also going to really pound on the fundamentals. And so, as I said, just being aggressive, being competitive and pushing for perfect execution while having fun. Fundamentally, I think that's my style. When I was a player I considered myself a grinder, and that's going to carry over to how I manage as well.

It was different. The new facility in Dunedin is incredible, but it felt a little bit like you were stuck with all the protocols and safety measures in place. The Blue Jays made it really easy for us to do our jobs, all things considered. There's plenty of space to have meetings, do work, the weight room is gigantic. We got a lot done in a short amount of time and I'm really proud of the guys for how they put in the work while dealing with all the restrictions. There was so much excitement; everybody is just excited to be abck to baseball and I think it really makes you appreciate what we had before and what we missed last year. Add on top of that the fact that the big league club is doing well and on the upswing, so everyone in the Minors wants to work even harder so they can get up and contribute. It's a really cool vibe going on in the entire organization right now.
