TODAY marks game #34 of the 2023 season, the first game of a six-game roadtrip, and the first game of a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons. These two teams played 17 times during the 2022 regular season, with the Whitecaps winning the series 9-8. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 29th season in professional baseball, while Great Lakes is in their 16th year of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers. The last playoff meeting with Great Lakes came in the 2018 Midwest League Eastern Division Quarterfinals, with the Whitecaps sweeping a two-game series.

UP NEXT: The 'Caps come back to West Michigan for a six-game series against the Lake County Captains (Cleveland Guardians affiliate from May 23-28 at LMCU Ballpark before heading to Day Air Ballpark in Dayton, Ohio for a six-game series against the Dragons (Cincinnati Reds affiliate) from May 30-June 4.

STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The West Michigan Whitecaps used late offense and clutch pitching to earn a 6-2 victory over the Lansing Lugnuts in front of 4,440 fans on Mother's Day Sunday afternoon at LMCU Ballpark. Every Whitecaps hitter reached base as West Michigan collected four extra-base hits, including two home runs, in the victory. Meanwhile, Whitecaps starter Jack O'Loughlin posted five shutout innings as 'Caps pitchers didn't allow a walk and held Lansing to a 2-for-9 mark with runners in scoring position in the Mother's Day win. West Michigan grabbed the lead in the second inning as Izaac Pacheco blasted a solo home run before Luis Garcia roped an RBI double, taking the 2-0 lead. Lansing loaded the bases in the fourth but couldn't capitalize, as shortstop Euribiel Angeles popped out attempting to bunt to end the inning. 'Nuts outfielder Junior Perez opened the sixth inning with a single before coming around to score on a throwing error, trimming the deficit to 2-1. Lansing tied the game in the top of the seventh on a sacrifice fly from Perez before Whitecaps outfielder Roberto Campos smoked an RBI single, retaking the 3-2 advantage. West Michigan added crucial insurance runs in the eighth as outfielder Justice Bigbie pounded a two-run homer before Jace Jung added an RBI single to extend the lead to 6-2. The Lugnuts couldn't rally as 'Caps relievers Tyler Mattison and Gabe Sequeira combined for two shutout frames to secure the 6-2 victory. Whitecaps reliever Blake Holub (4-0) picks up his fourth win, allowing one run through an inning pitched. Bigbie finished the series going 13-for-21 with seven runs, four doubles, two home runs, and nine RBIs.

JUSTICE BEING SERVED: After going 13-for-20 in a series in Mid-May against the Lansing Lugnuts, Whitecaps OF Justice Bigbie collected his first-ever Midwest league Player of the Week award. Bigbie tallied four doubles, three home runs and nine RBI as the 'Caps took 4 out of 6 games with the 'Nuts from May 9-14 at LMCU Ballpark.

ENTERING ELITE COMPANY: With a 6-2 victory over the Lansing Lugnuts on May 14, Whitecaps Manager Brayán Peña collected his 150th victory tying former West Michigan and one-time Baltimore Orioles manager Phil Regan for 5th place on the all-time 'Caps wins list by a manager.

LEADING THE PACK: The Whitecaps enter today's game leading the Midwest League in numerous offensive categories, including team batting average (.262), slugging (.434), OPS (.779), runs scored (169), doubles (68), RBI (153), and second in homers (34). They also have the fewest team strikeouts at 246. On the mound, they feature the lowest team ERA (3.24) in the MWL.

DIFFERENT STRENGTHS: The Whitecaps have stolen just 8 bases this season, the fewest in MiLB. The next closest team is Reno (Triple-A, Diamondbacks) with 18.

BRINGING THE PENA: On May 4, Whitecaps pitcher Carlos Pena was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Month for April. The 24-year-old pitched to a 0.47 ERA in five starts, covering 19.1 innings in the first month of the season, as he allowed one earned run and held opponents to a .200 average. Pena struck out 26 batters and was unscathed upon in his first nine innings and his last nine innings of the month. Pena, 24, was signed by Detroit as an international free agent out of Santiago, DR, on March 6, 2019.

CROUCHING TIGER, HIDDEN WHITECAP: The Whitecaps received a boost when they received their 2022 captain from the Double-A Erie Seawolves, as catcher Josh Crouch rejoined the club on May 2. Crouch returns to West Michigan after being named a Postseason All-Star as a member of the Whitecaps in 2022. The 24-year-old was named the Best Defensive Catcher in the Midwest League in a vote among league managers for Baseball America. The Floridian hit .290-10-61 RBI in just 90 2022 games with the 'Caps.

GOING VIRAL: Whitecaps Broadcasters Dan Hasty and Nate Wangler were featured in what's now considered a viral video from the team's Twitter account in early April. Their video of calling a baseball game as if it was the Master's Golf Tournament collected over seven million views across social media, and has been featured by news outlets Golf Digest, Sports Illustrated and USA Today, influencers Rex Chapman, Darren Rovell & former 'Cap Ben Verlander -- who now serves as a podcast host for the MLB on Fox.

PROSPECTS APLENTY: The Whitecaps hold seven of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects. Players include those mentioned near the top right corner of this page.

HEALTH REPORT: The 'Caps IL holds four players in pitchers Jackson Jobe, Tanner Kohlhepp, and Matt Walker, and catcher Eduardo Valencia.
