## NEWS AND NOTES

**ZERO:** Nashville was shutout for the fourth time this season and the first time at home in 2026. The last shutout loss at home also came at the hands of the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp with a 9-0 loss on August 6, 2025. Wednesday night was the 44th time the Sounds have been shutout at home since 2015. Jacksonville's Braxton Garrett is the first opposing pitcher to work 8.0 IP against the Sounds at First Horizon Park since Round Rock's Cy Sneed did so on April 18, 2019. Wednesday was the Sounds first 1-0 loss (9 Innings) since July 30, 2025, vs. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

**BULLPEN BULLIES:** After the bullpen worked six scoreless on Wednesday night, Nashville's bullpen has not allowed a run over its last 21.0 IP dating back to the final out in the top of the second inning on Saturday against Gwinnett. During the span, Sounds relievers have combined for 15 strikeouts, three walks, and 14 hits allowed. Brewers no. 27-rated prospect **Craig Yoho worked his 16th straight appearance with Nashville without an earned run allowed dating back to April 29.** During the streak, he has allowed just seven hits, with 25 strikeouts and four walks allowed. **Blake Holub tossed his seventh straight game without an earned run dating back to May 21.** He has gone 8.1 IP overall without an earned run allowed since May 17 (7 H, 8 K, BB). The Sounds bullpen currently leads all full-season minor league teams with a 3.60 ERA (154 ER/385.1 IP) this season.

**HONEST ABE:** Nashville was held to five or fewer hits for the 21st time this season and the 11th time at home. Eight of the 21 games with five or fewer hits this season have now come over the last 26 games since the start of June. One of Nashville's five hits on Wednesday came from Ethan Murray, who is riding a season-long six-game hitting streak since June 23. Murray is hitting .333 (6-for-18) during the stretch with a RBI, walk, and three runs scored.

**BROCK 'N' ROLL:** Brock Wilken tallied another multi-hit performance to his line in Tuesday against the Jumbo Shrimp, going 3-for-4 with his first 3-run blast of the season. The three hits marked his fifth multi-hit of the season and third 3-hit game. Wilken has recorded 44 RBI which ranks second-most on the team and the seven homers are tied for the fifth-most for a Nashville player this season. Milwaukee's no. 20-rated prospect is tied for 9th in RBI (44) among minor league hitters in the Brewers' farm system. He is hitting .182 (42-for-231) and 21 XBH for the Sounds this season. His 21 XBH account for exactly half of his season hits and he ranks fourth on the club behind Eddys Leonard (25), Jeferson Quero (23), and Jett Williams (21). Of 47 career home runs in the minors, Tuesday night marked just his second career three-run homer.

**QUERO BLAST:** Jeferson Quero crushed his 10th homer of the season with a solo shot on Tuesday night. The 10 homers are tied for the team lead with Eddys Leonard and Luke Adams. He has posted four homers in his last 12 games since the start of the Memphis series on June 16, adding 11 RBI along the way with a .375 AVG (18-for-48). Quero's 47 RBI leads the team, and is tied for sixth among minor league hitters in the Brewers' farm system as well as tied for sixth in the farm system in home runs. The Brewers no. 9-rated prospect has now reached 10+ homers in a season for the fourth time in his six-year professional career.

**JUNE BOOM:** With two more home runs in Tuesday's series opener against Jacksonville, the Sounds ended the month of June with 36 home runs. Nashville finished the month with the fourth-most homers hit in the International League, and fifth in Triple-A. The 36 home runs finishes as the 12th-most in any single month for Nashville since 2005. The Sounds hit 47 combined home runs through the first 57 games of the season. Brewers no. 12-rated prospect Luke Adams paced all Nashville hitters with eight home runs, and finished tied for fifth in Triple-A in June. His previous high for homers in a single month during his minor league career was five, which he hit in July of 2024 with High-A Wisconsin and June of last season with Double-A Biloxi.
