INDY BITS

ABOUT GAME 1: With Game 1 tied 2-2 after seven innings, the Omaha Storm Chasers broke through in the eighth with a line-drive RBI single by Drew Waters in the eighth to defeat the Indianapolis Indians, 3-2. Jack Suwinski burst through in the first at-bat of the game, crushing a leadoff shot over the center-field fence. The Storm Chasers then responded in the fourth when Ryan Fitzgerald crushed a double that scored Devin Mann and Nick Pratto. In the fifth, the Indians tied the game on a Henry Davis RBI double in which Suwinski, representing the go-ahead run, was thrown out at home.

ABOUT GAME 2: Playing as the away team in Game 2, the Indianapolis Indians fell behind early to be defeated by the Omaha Storm Chasers, 7-1. Omaha opened the scoring in the first inning with two runs off bases-loaded walks. In the following inning, Omaha padded their lead with three more runs off a pair of RBI singles and a double from Fitzgerald. Down by six, the Indians plated their lone run on a bases-loaded walk in the fifth.

DOUBLEHEADERS: The Indians have played five doubleheaders so far this season with a 4-6 record after a sweep of Memphis at Victory Field, a sweep at the hands of Toledo at Fifth Third Field, and two doubleheader splits against the Mud Hens last homestand and a sweep at the hands of the Storm Chasers last night. In doubleheader games, the Indians have been outscored 38-60 by their opponents. In 2023, the Indians only played five of doubleheaders with a 4-6 record (1-5 at Victory Field) and outscored their opponents, 33-30.

EXTRA INNINGS: The Indians have played five extra-inning contests with a 1-4 record, two of those losses coming in doubleheaders and four of five coming by one run. Three games have been lost by extra-innings at Victory Field, on April 30 vs. Buffalo (11 innings), May 16 (1) vs. Toledo (9) and last night's opener vs. Omaha (8). In extra innings, the Indians have been outscored by their opponents, 8-4.

SUWINSKI SWINGS IT: Jack Suwinski launched a leadoff home run in the opener last night, going 2-for-4 as one of two multi-hit performances by Indians batters in the game. It was the fourth leadoff home run by an Indians batter this season and first at Victory Field since May 18 vs. Toledo (Ji Hwan Bae). Suwinski hit safely in each of his first three games with Indianapolis after being optioned by Pittsburgh late last week, and in four games is hitting .250 (4-for-16) with two runs, a triple, home run, RBI and walk. In his first game on Monday, he opened the game with a leadoff triple before plating the first run of the contest. In 35 career Triple-A games in 2022 and '24, he owns a .218 batting average (29-for-133) with five doubles, one triple, seven home runs and 19 RBI. He appeared in 49 games with Pittsburgh to begin the season, hitting .174 (24-for-138) with 16 runs, five doubles, four home runs and

FRAIZER EN FUEGO: Matt Fraizer went 2-for-3 to extend his hitting streak to eight games from May 19 (2)-30 (1) before going hitless in the nightcap last night. During that streak, he hit .400 (12-for-30) with six runs, five extra-base hits, eight RBI and five walks. In 13 total games with Indianapolis this season, he is hitting .304 (14-for-46).

DAVIS DOES IT: Henry Davis has reached base safely in each of his last 12 games and 19 of 20 this season with Indianapolis. Last night, he roped a game-tying RBI double in the fifth inning to score Andrés Alvarez, in which Jack Suwinski was thrown out at home plate as the go-ahead run. Since his on-base streak began on May 17, he ranks among minor league leaders in extra-base hits (T-2nd, 11), home runs (T-5th, 5), total bases (T-5th, 36) and slugging percentage (T-8th, 800). In 19 games with Indianapolis this season, he owns a .296 batting average (21-for-71) with 17 runs, seven doubles, six home runs, 16 RBI and 1.086 OPS.

BACK ON THE STREAK: After having his 27-game on-base streak since April 18 snapped on Wednesday night, Jake Lamb reached base safely in both games of last night's doubleheader. He has now reached base safely in 40 of 42 games with Indianapolis this season, leading team leaders in batting average (.333), on-base percentage (.420), OPS (.893) and hits (50).

DELAY'S NOT DELAYING: Jason Delay jumped out to a hot start with Indianapolis during his rehab assignment, going 2-for-6 with three runs, a double, three RBI and a walk in his first two games this week. He was placed on the 10-day injured list with right knee inflammation on April 3 (retro to April 1) and was later transferred to the 60-day. He appeared in one game to begin his rehab assignment with the Marauders, going 0-for-2 with a walk on May 25. Delay appeared in one regular-season contest with Pittsburgh after hitting .231 (6-for-26) with two doubles and two RBI in 13 spring training games. He spent most of the 2023 season in the big leagues with a .251 batting average (42-for-167), 13 extra-base hits and 18 RBI in 70 games.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue a seven-game homestand vs the Omaha Storm Chasers, Triple-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, tonight at 7:05 PM ET. They are looking to stave off their first series loss at home down 1-3 through four games. Continuing the series for Indianapolis today will be RHP Domingo Germán (0-1, 6.97), who has never faced Omaha in six Triple-A games (four starts) since the Storm Chasers joined the International League in 2021. Countering for the Storm Chasers will be RHP Luis Cessa (2-2, 4.08), who has made four starts vs. the Indians since 2015 with a 0-1 record, 4.50 ERA (10er/20.0ip) and 16 strikeouts.

THIS DATE IN 2007: Bryan Bullington improved to 8-2 on the season after tossing 8.0 two-run innings in a 10-2 win vs. Buffalo. The only runs surrendered by the Tribe starter came from a two-run home run off the bat of Bisons center fielder Ben Francisco. Bullington racked up three more wins over the course of the season to lead the team with 11

Domingo Germán: Right-hander Domingo Germán is set to make his third start of the year for Indianapolis against the Omaha Storm Chasers, today at 7:05 PM at Victory Field.

Last Outing: Germán toed the rubber for his first start on the road with Indians on 5/25 as he fanned five batters across 5.1 innings and took the no-decision.

Against the Storm Chasers: Germán has never faced Omaha.

Historic Germán: Domingo Germán spent the 2023 season with the New York Yankees. He made 20 total appearances (19 starts) while tossing the 24th perfect game in major league history on 6/28 at Oakland which was the fourth in Yankees history. He was placed on the restricted list on 8/2 and missed the remainder of the season.

Miscellaneous: Germán was signed by the Florida Marlins as an international free agent on May 27, 2010. On Dec. 19, 2014, he was traded to New York (AL) with RHP Nathan Eovaldi and RF Garrett Jones in exchange for RHP David Phelps and 3B Martin Prado. He had his contract first selected by the Yankees on November 4, 2016 and he made his MLB debut on June 11, 2017 vs. Baltimore. He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on March 16, 2024.
