### Leading Off

Tonight, Reading continues its six-game series at Portland. Phillies No. 2 Prospect Mick Abel gets the start, opposite Isaac Coffey, who is making his double-A debut. Portland leads the season-series 4-3.

### Looking Back

It was an all-around 7-2 win for Reading last night. Tyler Phillips tossed his second-straight quality start, allowing one run and striking out four over six innings. Casey Martin and Matthew Kroon had three hits, and Johan Rojas added four. Oliver Dunn also homered. Reading's bullpen was strong, allowing no-earned runs over three innings of work behind Phillips.

### History for De La Cruz

Carlos De La Cruz now holds the longest on-base streak by an R-Phil, dating back to 2009. His walk last night put him on base for the 34th-straight game, passing Cameron Perkins mark set in 2014. The mark for De La Cruz was recognized on last night's Phillies broadcast.

### Can't Stop Johan

Johan Rojas had four hits and three stolen bases last night. It was Rojas' third four-hit game of the season and sixth of his career. Three stolen bases is the second time this season, with the last on Saturday; also, the eighth three-stolen base game of Rojas' career.

### Amongst the League Leaders

Johan Rojas and Carlos De La Cruz are tied for first in the Eastern League in runs scored with 46. Nick Yorke of Portland is tied with them. Rojas is second in the league in hitting at .323 and Matthew Kroon is fourth at .318. Rojas is second in the league in hits with 83 and De La Cruz is tied for third with 75 hits. De La Cruz is also tied for third in the league with 14 home runs on the season.

### Gettin' On Base

Oliver Dunn has quietly put together a 19-game on base streak, that dates back to May 26. Additionally, Johan Rojas has hits in nine straight; while Madison Stokes, Matthew Kroon and Herbert Iser have been aboard in seven in a row.

### Around the Organization

The Phillies fell in the first game of a three-game series with the Braves 4-2, while Brandon Marsh had three hits. Lehigh Valley fell at Worcester 7-5, but Jake Cave had two doubles and Drew Ellis drove in two runs. Jersey Shore opened its series against Rome with a 5-1 win in a game where Rixon Wingrove chipped in four hits. In Clearwater, the Threshers topped Dunedin 10-4 just up the road from BayCare Ballpark. Ryan Leitch hit a grand slam for the Threshers in the win for the First-Half Champions.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**June 21, 1971:** At Pittsfield, Mike Schmidt makes his Reading Phillies debut in a 3-2 loss to the Senators. Schmidt, batting 7th and playing shortstop, goes 2-for-4 and knocks in both R-Phils runs with RBI singles in the 2nd and 6th innings. Only 371 are in attendance to witness his first Minor League game.

### Shipping up to Portland

This is the second series of the season between Reading and Portland, with both at Hadlock Field. The Sea Dogs sit in second in the Northeast Division, 1.5 games back of Somerset. It will be a neck-and-neck battle with the Patriots this week for the first-half crown. Last week, Portland went 3-3 at Binghamton and next week, the Sea Dogs begin the second half at New Hampshire.

### Cup of Coffey

Righty Isaac Coffey makes his double-A debut tonight for the Sea Dogs. Coffey was promoted to Portland yesterday from high-A Greenville. With Greenville, he made 11 starts and went 4-2 with a 2.83 ERA. Over 60.1 innings, he allowed 51 hits and just ten walks, with 83 strikeouts. Coffey has allowed just 1.5 walks per nine, and has 12.4 strikeouts per nine. Coffey was a tenth-round pick by Boston out of 2023 College World Series Participant Oral Roberts and has accelerated through the system. He made just two appearances with their rookie team in 2022 and is already in double-A after just 13-career games.

**2023 Notes:** Phillies No. 2 Ranked Prospect. Holding opponents to just .191 average against, but allowing 5.2 walks per nine innings. After struggling at Richmond, turned in four-straight one run performances between Apr. 13 and May 5, going 2-0 over that span. Allowed season-high nine runs against New Hampshire on May 12, but responded with five-strong innings at Somerset May 19. On May 26 vs Harrisburg, had season-high nine strikeouts, but struggled with command late in outing, walking four and allowing six-earned runs. Followed with quality start at New Hampshire, then combined to go 10 innings and allowing three runs next two home starts last time out.

2023: Entered season as Phillies second-ranked prospect, trailing only Andrew Painter. Earned invite to Phillies spring training. Appeared in two games (one start) and threw three innings. Allowed no runs and one hit. Struck out two and walked two. 2022: Split season between High-A Jersey Shore and Double-A Reading. Went 7-8 over 18 starts with Jersey Shore. With Reading, he started five games and went 1-3 with a 4.01 ERA. 2021: Spent entire season with Single-A Clearwater. He started 14 games and went 1-3 with a 4.43 ERA over 44.2 nnings pitched. 2020: Was first round selection of Phillies out of Jesuit High School in Portland, Oregon. High School: First baseman and pitcher for Jesuit. Injured shoulder as sophomore and required surgery. As a junior Abel posted a 10-0 record with a 1.26 ERA and 111 strikeouts in 72+1/3 innings pitched while also batting .294 with 12 runs scored and 14 RBIs as he helped lead the Crusaders to a state championship and was named the Oregon Gatorade Player of the Year and a Junior All-American by MaxPreps. In 2019, he was selected for U-18 United States national baseball team. Entering his 2020 senior season Abel was named a preseason All-American by MaxPreps and Baseball America and was considered to be a top prospect for the upcoming draft. He was also ranked the fourth best collegiate prospect in the nation and committed to play at Oregon State University after his freshman year of high school. PERSONAL: Abel grew up in Cedar Mill, Oregon, and helped lead the Cedar Mill Little League team win a state title as a youth.
