YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels shut out the SeaWolves, 2-0. It was their second shutout win of the series. Matt Frisbee started and worked 4.2 scoreless innings before leaving with an apparent injury in the fifth inning. He had four strikeouts. Evan Gates replaced him and threw 3.1 hitless innings, striking out four. After issuing a walk to start his outing, he retired the next 10 consecutive batters. Tyler Myrick closed out his fourth save with a scoreless ninth. The Flying Squirrels took the lead with an RBI triple by Dilan Rosario in the third inning. Carter Howell brought him in to score with a single.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the fifth of a six-game series at The Diamond. The week marks Erie's only visit to Richmond this season. The Flying Squirrels were swept in six games at UPMC Park from May 7-12. Richmond returns to Erie for a six-game series from August 27-September 1.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 12-4 in their last 16 games after going 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They have won five-of-six in each of their last two series, including at home against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie last week. From Wednesday to Thursday, the Flying Squirrels have lost back-to-back games for the first time since May 11-12.

THE SEAWOLVES are in third place in the Southwest Division, two games behind first-place Akron and Harrisburg. Erie has dropped six-of-its-last-nine games dating back to last Wednesday. This season, Erie has the second-lowest team ERA (3.07) in the Eastern League. Erie's roster includes three of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Troy Melton (No. 10), INF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 13) and OF/INF Trei Cruz (No. 29). Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes two Erie players, including Melton (No. 10) and Lee (No. 12).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Ryan Murphy makes his 11th start of 2024 and his second of the year against the SeaWolves. He last pitched on Sunday afternoon at Bowie and allowed one run over four innings, striking out six. Against the SeaWolves on May 8, he pitched five innings, tied for his longest start of the season, and allowed two runs (one earned) with a Double-A career-high eight strikeouts but was charged with a loss. Murphy spent all of last season with the Flying Squirrels, going 2-9 with a 4.36 ERA in 29 outings. His 27 starts were tied for the most in the Eastern League. Murphy struck out 107 batters last year, sixth-most in the Giants organization. He had a 5.21 ERA (28 ER/48.1 IP in his first 14 outings through June 22, but over his next 14 outings from June 28-September 10, he posted a 2.77 ERA (17 ER/55.1 IP) with 61 strikeouts. Murphy made his Double-A debut in June of 2022, one of two starts with Richmond that year before he was shut down with an injury. In his first professional season in 2021, he pitched for Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene and struck out 164 batters, which was the third-most in the minors for the year. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College in New York, which was then an NCAA DII program. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect. FOR ERIE: Right-hander Wilkel Hernandez makes his 10th start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, Hernandez allowed three runs in 4.2 innings against the Curve on Sunday night with five strikeouts. On May 9, he faced the Flying Squirrels in Erie and set a season high with six innings pitched, allowing one run on two hits with five strikeouts. A native of La Carlota, Venezuela, Hernandez is in his first Double-A season. Last year, he went 3-8 with a 3.65 ERA in 26 games (20 starts) for the High-A West Michigan Whitecaps. Hernandez was originally signed by the Los Angeles Angels as an international free agent in 2015. He was traded to the Tigers along with OF Troy Montgomery on December 13, 2017 for lan Kinsler.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (7,172).

GRANTING WISHES: In his last 15 games since May 15, **Grant McCray** is batting .404 (19-for-47) with two homers, six doubles, three triples, nine walks, nine RBIs and 15 runs scored, raising his season batting average from .135 to .219. He picked up a season-high three hits last Tuesday night at Bowie and matched it last Friday night. For the season, McCray is batting .135 (14-for-104) when batting first in the lineup compared to .404 (19-for-47) when batting third, fifth or sixth in the order. McCray is tied for first in the Eastern League in triples (3), fifth in extra-base hits (20) and tied for seventh in doubles, (11). On Monday, he was named Eastern League Player of the Week after he hit .550 (11-for-20) with a homer, three doubles, two triples, four walks, eight runs scored and five RBIs for the series in Bowie. Prior to going 0-for-1 on Friday night, McCray had reached base in 14 consecutive games dating back to May 12, which was tied for the third longest active streak in the Eastern League and is the longest by a Flying Squirrels player so far this season.

AWARDS SEASON: Along with Grant McCray being named Eastern League Player of the Week, John Michael Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday. He pitched six hitless innings on Thursday night at Bowie. He also threw seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and has combined for 13 hitless innings when facing Bowie this season. Bertrand became the second pitcher in team history to win two Pitcher of the Week awards in the same season, joining Eric Surkamp (2011). Along with Surkamp, Bertrand is the fourth pitcher in team history to win the Pitcher of the Week award multiple times, joining Matt Frisbee and Matt Gage. Last week marked the fourth time the Flying Squirrels have swept the league's weekly player and pitcher awards, joining Daniel Mayora and Justin Fitzgerald (July 9-16, 2012), Steven Duggar and Andrew Suarez (July 18-24, 2016) and Brett Auerbach and Wil Jensen (August 1-7, 2022).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Andy Thomas is batting .289 (13-for-45) over his last 13 games since May 15 with a homer, three doubles and 12 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .226. Thomas has picked up two hits in four-of-his-last-11 games played dating back to May 16 and has picked up three doubles in that same stretch. On May 24 at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high. On Friday night, he reached base three times (2 BB, HBP).

WILL POWER: Will Wilson has base 17 times in his last nine games going back to the start of last week's series in Bowie. Last Tuesday, he went 1-for-4 with a two-run homer. He followed with a 2-for-5 performance last Wednesday and added a solo home run. Last Thursday night, Wilson went 0-for-1 but walked three times. He picked up three hits and a walk last Friday night. He went 3-for-5 on Wednesday night against the SeaWolves and had Richmond's only hit on Thursday. In his last nine games, Wilson is hitting .367 (12-for-33). Wilson is now ranked seventh in Flying Squirrels franchise history with 26 career homers.

BLANK SPACE: The Flying Squirrels have shut out the SeaWolves twice this week. On Tuesday, **Hayden Birdsong** covered six scoreless innings while **Nick Swiney** and **Tyler Myrick** worked the final three in a 5-0 win. On Friday night, **Matt Frisbee** started and pitched 4.2 innings before being replaced by **Evan Gates**, who worked a career-high 31 innings. Myrick threw a scoreless ninth to close his fourth save of the year. Friday was the sixth shutout of the season by the Flying Squirrels and the fourth at The Diamond. Their six shutouts are tied for second-most in the Eastern League this season, even with Erie and Harrisburg while trailing only Akron (8).

OPEN THE GATES: This season, **Evan Gates** has posted a 1.59 ERA (5 ER/281 IP), which is second-lowest in the Eastern League (min. 25 IP), trailing only Somerset reliever Jack Neely (1.40 ERA). Gates posted a 0.86 ERA (2 ER/21.0 IP) over his first 12 appearances of the season through May 18. After allowing four runs (three earned) in his two outings last week against the Baysox, he pitched 3.1 scoreless innings on Friday against the SeaWolves, the longest outing of his career, and struck out four batters. In that appearance, he issued a walk to the first batter he faced before retiring the next 10 batters in order to finish his night. Since joining the Flying Squirrels in 2022, Gates has pitched 64 Double-A games, combining for a 3.40 ERA (35 ER/92.2 IP).

PROSPECT WATCH: Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

MAY WRAP: The Flying Squirrels went 13-14 in the month of May, including going 1-10 from May 1-12 and 12-4 from May 15-31. The Richmond pitching staff posted a 4.10 ERA (104 ER/228.1 IP), which was seventh in the Eastern League. The Richmond offense hit .215 (183-for-853), 11th in the league. Richmond also ranked 10th in runs scored (107) and tied for 10th in homers (21). Grant McCray led the league in SLG (.602), ranked tied for first in triples (3), second in extra-base hits (15), third in OPS (.994), tied for third in doubles (8) and fourth in total bases (50). Hayden Birdsong has the eighth-best qualified ERA (2.16).
