

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield

ROAD WARRIORS: To date, the Cardinals have been the best road team in the Texas League. Winning 3 of the first 4 games in Frisco this week, Springfield is 35-20 (.636) away from Hammons Field this season, and .500 at home (29-29). The Cardinals' .636 road winning percentage is the 2nd best in all of Double-A behind the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (NYM) who are 36-19 (.655).

This week represents a clash of strengths; the RoughRiders own the best home winning percentage in Double-A at .655 (36-19). With wins in 4 of the first 5 games of the series in Frisco, the Cardinals have become the first road team to win a series at Riders Field this season.

POWER SURGE: The 2024 season has been a tale of two halves when it comes to the Cardinals' power numbers. Dispite going homerless in their last 2 games the Cards have still hit 43 HR in 44 games in the 2nd half, and has already eclipsed its 1st half total of 37. The Cards are on pace for 67 longballs in the 2nd half of Texas League play, a number that would have been good for 3rd in the 1st half

The Cardinals lead the league in runs scored (233, 5.3/game), SLG (.414) and OPS (.762) in the 2nd half. In the 1st half, the Cards were 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712).

CARDIAC CARDS: This week in Frisco, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in each game of the series, Springfield is 3-1 this week at Riders Field. The Cards have scored 17 of their 28 runs this week in the 7th inning or later, and have outscored the Riders 13-5 from the 8th inning on. Entering the series with 12 blown saves in 108 games, the RoughRiders have been charged with a blown save in 4 of the 5 games so far in the series

HITTING (IN) THE "DOG DAYS" OF AUGUST: After putting together their best month of the season with a 16-7 July, the Cardinals have gotten off the a good start in the month of August at 9-6. The Cards lead all of Double-A with a .289 batting average through the month's first 15 games and have also scored a league-high 84 runs (5.6/game). The Birds have racked up double-digit hits in 6 of their last 7 games, totalling 89 knocks during that time and for the season have an average (.268) 15 points higher than any other team in the league.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 37 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the Euless, TX native leads all qualified hitters in the circuit with a .370 average, 10 HR and 33 RBIs and is slugging a league-high .654 and with a 1.071 OPS. In his first 44 games of the season, Crooks batted .282 with 1 HR and a .786 OPS. He has hit safely in 14 of his last 15 games and is batting .420 (21-for-50) with 4 HR over 13 games in August.

MONTH OF TORRES: Cardinals leadoff man Bryan Torres is enjoying a red-hot start to the month of August. In 13 games, Torres is tied with Jimmy Crooks leading all gualified Texas League hitters with a .420 batting average (21-for-50) and has also scored a league-high 11 runs. He set a new career high and tied a franchise record for hits in a game with a 5-for-5 performance on Wednesday night at Frisco. During his current 6-game hitting streak, Torres is 15-for-27 (.556).

LEAGUE LEADERS: Among active, qualified hitters Bryan Torres (.321/.410) and Jimmy Crooks (.324/.410) are 1-2 atop the league in batting average and OBP, while Crooks leads the circuit in OPS (.921) and SLG (.511). Torres is 1st in hits (118) while Nathan Church is 2nd with 110.

KING OF THE "K": With 11 K's on Saturday night and 37 strikeouts over his last 4 starts, Cardinals starter Quinn Mathews continues to lead MiLB in whiffs. With 168 K's, Mathews leads Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson of the Cleveland organization by 12 (156).

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer Matt Svanson has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. Svanson is a perfect 22-for-22 and his 45 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 22 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 20.0 IP (0.45 ERA) and is 12-for-12 in save opportunities. Svanson has been unscored upon over his last 17 appearances, allowing just 9 H with 14 K over his last 18.0 IP. The Cardinals are 47-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.
