JOHNSTON HURLS GEM BUT LATE COMEBACK FALLS SHORT: Kyle Johnston threw five innings of one-hit baseball but was held to a no-decision as the Fisher Cats stranded the tying runner in scoring position in the top of the ninth in a 2-1 loss to the Patriots Tuesday night. Austin Martin matched his career high with three hits in the loss.

COMING BACK LIKE JORDAN: Blue Jays number three overall prospect Jordan Groshans is expected to return to the lineup tonight for the first time since 5/18. Sportsnet.ca reported he's had mild lower-back soreness. Groshans has played both shortstop and third base through his first 11 games at Double-A.

THE STREAKS: Otto López wasted no time, smacking a first inning single to extend his hit streak to a Double-A Northeast leading sixteen games. His 16-game streak is the longest in Minor League Baseball and the longest for New Hampshire since Vladimir Guerrero Jr hit in 16 straight back in 2018. Gabriel Moreno's on-base streak ended despite his RBI sacrifice fly in the ninth inning.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: May 27, 2008---The Fisher Cats scored four times in the top of the ninth inning to rally past Trenton 5-3 at Waterfront Park. All of the runs scored with two outs. Travis Snider had an RBI single and a passed ball tied the game. Jacob Butler drove in a run with a double and Ryan Patterson added an RBI single.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Weather was a factor across the Blue Jays system last night. Toronto was rained out at Yankee Stadium. The teams are playing a single-admission doubleheader today at 4:05 p.m. Alek Manoah is scheduled to make his MLB debut against Domingo German (hurr-MAHN) in the first game. Manoah did not pitch for the Fisher Cats....Wednesday's game between the Triple-A Buffalo Bisons and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre was suspended before the teams could take the field in the top half of the fourth inning. Buffalo was ahead 2-0 thanks to a Nash Knight solo home run and a run-scoring wild pitch. The teams are scheduled to resume at 5:05 p.m....Adv. A Vancouver fell 7-3 to Everett...Tampa and Dunedin split a twinbill. The D-Jays took the nightcap 4-3 after falling 7-1 in the opener.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats will close out the season series this week against Somerset, before returning home for their first look at the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (New York Mets).

ON THE HILL: Troy Miller will make his Double-A debut tonight after being called up from Vancouver. He posted a 2-0 record with a 1.84 ERA. He will be going up against Glenn Otto, who averages nearly two strikeouts per inning with a 2-1 record.
