BIG SEVENTH PUSHES ROCKHOUNDS OVER ROUGHRIDERS:

The Frisco RoughRiders could not overcome a four-run seventh for the Midland RockHounds in a 4-1 loss from Momentum Bank Ballpark on Wednesday night. Frisco (21-14, 65-39) starter Dane Acker was the bright spot for the Riders, allowing just four hits over five shutout innings while walking three and striking out eight batters. The Riders found the screboard first in the top of the first inning when **Max Acosta** drove in **Josh Hatcher** to make it 1-0. Midland (22-13, 62-42) then answered in the seventh with three-straight run-scoring doubles. Brennan Milone ripped a two-run go-ahead double to start it against Jackson Kelley (2-1) before Henry Bolte and Daniel Susac both doubled in runs of their own to balloon the lead to 4-1. Colin Peluse (3-2) took home the win for Midland with two runless relief innings while Shohei Tomioka clamped the game down for his first save of the season. Hatcher paced the Frisco offense with three hits, but the Riders have just scored two runs over the first two games of the series.

START ME UP

RoughRiders starting pitchers have been dominant over their last eight games, owning a 1.37 ERA (6ER/39.1IP). Overall, Frisco has allowed just 19 earned runs in their last eight games for a 2.44 ERA (70.0IP).

CHICKS DIG THE LONG BALL:

The RoughRiders have hit 14 home runs over their last 14 games, tied for the fifth-most in the Texas League over the last two weeks. During that span, the Riders are third in the Texas League with a .732 OPS, second with a .255 batting average and are sixth with 4.0 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .160 (19-for-119) with runners in scoring position over their last 14 games

READY TO ROCK(ER)

RoughRiders starting pitcher Kumar Rocker has been fantastic in his two starts with the RoughRiders since returning from his "Tommy John" surgery rehab this season. In the two starts, he has pitched seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and one walk with eight strikeouts. Additionally, he has been incredibly efficient, averaging just 11.4 pitches per inning with the Riders. Rocker, who was selected by the Rangers as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2022 draft, is the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers organization and the No. 1 pitching prospect.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 35-15 at Riders Field this season. Their 35 wins and .700 winning per-centage at home are both first in Double-A and first among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +74 run differential, a 3.73 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .761 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 30-24 with a 3.27 ERA, but a +21 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .636 OPS (10th in the league). Cody Freeman is slashing .339/.398/.594/.992 at home this season with nine of his 13 home runs. His .339 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home stadium.

OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 28 games, he is hitting .290 (31-for-107)/.389/.514/.903 with 11 doubles, two triples, three home runs and 17 RBIs. Over his last 25 games, he is batting .298 (28-for-94)/407/532/939 with nine doubles, two triples, three home runs and 17 RBIs. He has reached in 25 of his 28 games with the Riders. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen is the second-best in the Texas League this season, owning a 3.12 ERA, which is also the fourth-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.50), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .228 BAA is on pace to tie the best in the franchise's history (.228 in 2021).

WE'RE GOING DANCING

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.
