**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve continue a six-game set with the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, their only meetings of the season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Altoona picked up their fourth shutout win of the season with a brilliant 6 inning outing from **Luis Ortiz** and five combined RBI from **Aaron Shackelford** and **Connor Scott** to send the Curve to a 6-0 win.

**IMMACULATE AGAIN:** Right-hander **Luis Ortiz** fired the fourth immaculate inning in franchise history on Tuesday, August 9 in Altoona's 6-0 win over Binghamton. Ortiz became the first pitcher in franchise history to throw two immaculate innings. With his 8 strikeouts, Ortiz now has 103 strikeouts on the season; becoming the first Curve pitcher with 100 strikeouts in a season since **Taylor Hearn** in 2018. Should he stay on turn in the rotation, he would have 7 more starts in the regular season; giving him a solid chance to set the team's franchise record for strikeouts in a season (**Ian Snell**, 2004: 142). He would need to average 6 strikeouts per start the rest of the way to lock down the mark.

**ENDY'S TIME:** Prior to Altoona's series with Binghamton, the Pirates promoted the No. 5 prospect in the system according to MLB.com, **C Endy Rodriguez**. Named the South Atlantic League's Player of the Month in July after he batted .373/.489/.773 with 6 2B, 8 HR, and 21 RBI in 21 G. Rodriguez ranked highly in several categories in the South Atlantic League at the time of promotion: 7th in BA (.302), 8th in HR (16), 5th in OBP (.392), 2nd in SLG% (.544), 2nd in OPS (.936), 4th in H (96), T-2nd in 2B (23), T-2nd in XBH (42), 3rd in R (63). In his team debut on Tuesday, August 9, he went 1-for-3 with a 2B, RBI and a BB.

**ALL-STAR SWOON:** Following the four-day All-Star break, Altoona dropped 12-of-15 games to send their season record under the .500 mark. Altoona dropped 2-of-3 in Harrisburg coming out of the break before dropping 5-of-6 in a series at Bowie and 5-of-6 in a series at PNG Field to Akron. Altoona batted 2-for-33 (.061) with runners in scoring position in their series with Akron.

**SOMETHING ABOUT THE TRIPLE:** **Jared Triolo** tripled three times in the Curve's series with Akron. It is the first time that the Curve have had one player triple three times in the same series since **Austin Meadows** did so in 2016 with three triples in Altoona's series with Binghamton from June 3-5. Meadows hit five triples in a four-day span, hitting two in two games in Akron before hitting three in two games against Binghamton at PNG Field.

**STOLEN HEARTS:** The Curve have stolen 129 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 40 games to play. Altoona is on track to have 3 players, **Liover Peguero** (21), **Jared Triolo** (20), **Andres Alvarez** (19), with 20 stolen bases for the first time since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

**TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL:** Altoona pitchers have surrendered 112 home runs across 64 of their 103 games played this season. Altoona allowed a home run in a season-high 8 straight games from July 26 - August 3, falling shy of the franchise record of 11 (5/19-29, 2013).

**A TREE-IDENTIFICATION WALK:** After drawing just 19 walks in 42 games across April and May, INF **Jared Triolo** drew 20 walks in 25 games in June. Over his last 39 games (6/21 - Present), Triolo has a .397 on-base percentage which has raised his season OBP mark from .359 to .369. Triolo reached base safely in 19-of-23 games in July, his 56 BB are T-2nd in the EL.

**NO LEAD IS SAFE:** Altoona has held a lead after 5 innings in 46 of 103 games played this season and hold a 34-12 record in those games. Since May 17, the Curve are 23-3 when they hold a lead after 5 innings.

**THE ARTISTS FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE B-METS:** Managed by Reid Brignac, Binghamton's coaching staff features a wealth of MLB experience with Brignac (9 years), Pitching Coach Jerome Williams (11 years), Hitting Coach Tommy Joseph (2 years, plus 5 seasons in the Eastern League), and Bench Coach Mariano Duncan (12 years). The Ponies feature several top prospects according to MLB.com: SS Ronny Mauricio (#3), OF Carlos Cortes (#15), C Hayden Senger (#20), C Nick Meyer (#27) and RHP Brian Metoyer (#30).

**THE FIRST PONY TO RIDE:** Garrison Bryant takes the ball in game two of the series on Wednesday night. Bryant was drafted in the 36th round in 2016 by the Mets out of Clearwater HS in Clearwater, FL. Bryant was born in Deerfield, NH, but found his way to Florida to better position himself to get a scholarship to play football in college; he committed to the New Mexico Military Institute before the Mets found him while scouting another player. He signed for \$100,000 to forgo his commitment to college football and embark on the baseball dream. Bryant had a solid start to the season at High-A Brooklyn recording a 3.18 ERA in 65.0 IP with 58 strikeouts. He's made three starts for Binghamton allowing nine runs in 11.0 IP. He features a fastball in the low-90's with a slider and change-up from a three-quarters arm slot.

## TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY

**2000** - Rico Washington and Eric Fruniss each blasted a pair of home runs in the same game during a 13-2 win at Reading. It was the first time the Curve saw two players sock multiple homers in the same game.

**2003** - The Curve split a doubleheader vs. Harrisburg in front of 9,255 fans, the highest attended regular-season game in franchise history. 4-2 loss in G1, 4-3 win in G2

**2004** - Altoona visits Manchester, NH for the first time and win the series opener 6-2. Nate McLouth's second 30-plus game on-base streak of the season is extended to 32 games with a 2-4 day.

## CAREER NOTES

**2022:** Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Threw 8.2 scoreless innings to start the season, holding opponents to a .077 batting average against before allowing 6 runs on 6 hits, including 2 HR (4 total) in the second inning of his third start of the season on 4/23 vs. New Hampshire... Threw 5.0 scoreless innings on 4/29 at Akron pitching in front of dozens of family and friends. Canal Park is just 35 minutes from his native Massillon, OH... Threw 14.2 scoreless innings in road games to start the year... His 31 strikeouts in May were tied for 6th-most by an Eastern League Pitcher (Burrows also had 31 K's in May)... Placed on IL on 6/4 (shoulder) and activated on 6/25, was the first time in his life that he's missed a start due to injury... Placed on Temporary Inactive List on 7/1 to be the Best Man in his older brother's wedding, activated on 7/6... **Has allowed 2R or fewer in 14-of-17 outings this season...**

**2021:** Made his professional debut splitting the season between High-A Beloit and Double-A Pensacola in the Marlins system... Combined to go 6-4 with a 4.18 ERA in 21 appearances, 20 starts... Led all Marlins minor leaguers with 136 strikeouts, ranked second in walks with 49, and sixth in the organization with 99.0 innings pitched... Began the season with High-A Beloit and went 2-0 with a 2.79 ERA in four starts in the month of May, struck out 28 batters in 19.1 innings pitched... Struck out a career-high 11 batters in his fourth professional start on May 28 against Peoria, also allowed five hits and walked two in 4.1 innings... Lasted 3.1 innings or shorter in each of his first three starts in the month of June before picked up his third win of the season on June 19 at Peoria, allowing one run on two hits and one walk in 5.0 innings with five strikeouts... Went a career-high 6.0 innings on July 1 vs Wisconsin and struck out seven, allowed two runs on four hits... Came out of the bullpen on July 13 against Quad Cities following a rehab start by Marlins RHP John Curtiss, picked up nine strikeouts in 4.2 innings... Struck out 10 and allowed just one run in 6.0 innings at Cedar Rapids on July 20 in his final start with the Snappers... Made his Double-A debut with Pensacola on July 27 and fired 5.0 no-hit innings against Mississippi with eight strikeouts... Turned in a dominant month of August with Pensacola

Went 8-0 with a 0.50 ERA and 78 strikeouts in 56 innings pitched in 2017. Threw 7.0 innings, struck out seven batters and held Lakota West to one run in the 5-1 state semifinal victory... Also played basketball for three years... **Was high school teammates with Tigers prospect Dillon Dingler, they both played baseball and basketball for Jackson High School and won state championships in Baseball and Basketball as seniors...** Kyle's father, Todd, coached the basketball team... His father played baseball at Youngstown State... Earned his degree from Ball State in Business Administration in three years... Signed with the Marlins for a bonus of \$1,129,700... Road roommates with OF Connor Scott in 2021 in Beloit, rooms with him now in Altoona and on road trips with the Curve...
