LHP MASON ALBRIGHT (0-1, 4.76) vs. LHP Wes Benjamin (2-4, 7.11)

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes and Chihuahuas meet for the second of four series on the year and the first in El Paso ... Albuquerque won its first series last week since Aug. 27-Sept. 1, 2024, vs. Reno ... Albuquerque has won seven of its last nine ... Mason Albright is expected to start for the Isotopes while Wes Benjamin is slated to take the hill for the Chihuahuas.

SERIES DUB: Albuquerque won its first ever series against Sugar Land (19th all-time set against the Space Cowboys) ... First series victory against Houston's Triple-A affiliate since Aug. 20-23, 2016, when they swept the Fresno Grizzlies in four games.

VS. ELP: Albuquerque and El Paso split the first series between the clubs in the Duke City from April 15-20 after splitting a doubleheader on Sunday, April 20.

ONE-RUN GAMES: The Isotopes evened their record in onerun games at 10-10 with the triumph Sunday. This was their first such contest since May 24 at Reno (8-7 victory), ending a span in which 10 of 16 games were decided by a lone tally.

LAST NINE: Over Albuquerque's last nine games, the club is first in Triple-A in homers (20) and total bases (154), second in runs (64), doubles (21) and third in hits (104).

PUNCHOUTS: Albuquerque recorded 17 strikeouts in a nineinning game Sunday for the fourth time (also: May 12, 2014, at El Paso; April 22, 2022, at Round Rock; June 14, 2023, at Tacoma). The team record of 18 punchouts was set in a 17-inning contest on May 10, 2015 at Sacramento.

THE Q: Andrew Quezada fanned 11 Sunday, the 35th time an Isotopes pitcher recorded double-digit strikeouts in a contest, and first since Karl Kauffmann on Sept. 9, 2022 vs. El Paso (also 11).

LAST AT-BAT: The Isotopes recorded their eighth last at-bat victory of the season Sunday, and the second that did not come via walk-off (other: May 2 vs. Salt Lake).

26: With the Isotopes recording their 26th victory Sunday, they have matched their win total from the first half in 2024. Three series remain before this year's midway point.

QUALITY: Sugar Land's Brandon Walter tossed the ninth quality start against the Isotopes in 2025 and seventh since May 2 (last: May 30 vs. Sugar Land, Jason Alexander).

TAKE YOUR BASE?: Albuquerque did not draw a walk Sunday for the second time this year (also: May 21 at Reno). It was their first victory without a free pass since Aug. 17, 2023 vs. El Paso.

RIT: Ryan Ritter extended his career-long hit streak to 17 games Sunday, longest active in PCL. During streak is slashing .453/.500/1.027 with 10 doubles, three triples, nine homers and 29 RBI ... Longest hit streak by an lsotope since Greg Jones (18, Aug. 25-Sept. 15, 2024) ... Second-longest active in all of MiLB (Edward Duran – Dunedin Blue Jays, 22 games).

-During hit streak leads MiLB in average, hits, total bases, homers, RBI, OPS and slugging ... Has 23-game on-base streak, longest active streak in PCL ... Has 13 multi-hit games in his last 16 contests and team-leading 20 in 2025 ... Has an extra-base hit in 15 of his last 16 contests ... Has increased batting average from .218 to .307 during streak.

-Since May 1, slashing .386/.447/.911 with 11 doubles, three triples, 12 homers and 33 RBI after hitting .224 over first 26 games. During stretch, leads all of MiLB in slugging, OPS, total bases, extra-base hits, tied for 1st in home runs and RBI.

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson went 1-for-3 Sunday, and is slashing .381/.487/.683 with six doubles, two triples, three homers and 12 RBI in his last 17 games. Was also hit by a pitch for the 11th time this season, the most in all of Triple-A.

WARMIN' UP: Warming Bernabel recorded two hits Sunday for the second-straight evening. Marks his sixth time in 2025 with back-to-back multi-hit games ... Has a hit in seven of his last nine games (12x31 with four doubles and five walks).

MR. BRUIN: Sean Bouchard recorded his fourth multi-hit game of the year Sunday in 14 contests with Albuquerque ... Tallied a doube and homer, first game with two extra-base hits since July 30, 2024, at Las Vegas.

AMADOR: Adael Amador has hit safely in 10 of 13 contests at Triple-A this season ... Has three multi-hit games.

YF: Yanquiel Fernández went 0-for-3 Sunday, ending his 12game on-base streak. During stretch slashed .404/.481/.596 with six doubles, one homer, six RBI and seven walks.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Ryan Ritter is 1st in runs (44), total bases (128), OPS (1.059), slugging (.643), XBH (32) and RBI (45), 2nd in homers (16), 4th in OBP (.416), T-5th in hits (61), T-6th in triples (3), 8th in walks (34), and 9th in average (.307) ... Warming Bernabel is T-4th in doubles (16) ... Sterlin Thompson is T-6th in triples (3) ... Julio Carreras is 10th in stolen bases (11).

TOG: Sunday's game finished in 2:11, Albuquerque's quickest nine-inning contest since July 20, 2024 at Sacramento (also 2:11).

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

AARON MUNOZ: Takes over as Isotopes hitting coach after Jordan Pacheco was named one of two new hitting coaches for the Colorado Rockies on May 12 ... Began the 2025 season as the hitting coach for the ACL Rockies ... Spent nine seasons (2016-2024) as the Rockies bullpen catcher ... Was Isotopes bullpen catcher in 2015 ... Originally drafted by the Blue Jays in the 34th round of the MLB Draft ... Played parts of four seasons in the Minor Leagues (2011-14), making it to Double-A.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
