RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (31-16)







LHP Jakob Wright (0-0, 0.00 ERA) vs. RHP Jeter Martinez (1-2, 8.10 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue their longest road trip of the year, as they take on the Modesto Nuts (SEA), the two-time defending Cal League Champions, in the third game of a six-game set and game nine of a 12-game, 13day road trip. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, June 3rd to face the San Jose Giants. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE NUTS: Today's game is the third of 12 against the Nuts and the third of six at John Thurman Field. In 2024, the Quakes went just 2-10 against the Nuts, 1-5 here in Modesto. In 2023, they went 3-6, just 1-5 here in Modesto. The last time the Quakes won a series here in Modesto was in 2021, when they went 4-2.

LAST GAME: The Nuts capitalized on four Rancho Cucamonga errors, six walks and two hit batters, on their way to an 8-5 win over the Quakes on Wednesday night at John Thurman Field in Modesto, tying the series at one win each. Modesto's Austin St. Laurent broke a 4-4 tie with a sac fly in the fifth off Rancho reliever Nicolas Cruz (1-1) giving the Nuts the lead for good. Modesto reliever Andrew Carson (1-0) pitched a scoreless fifth and was credited with the win. Rancho finished with just seven hits, one night after collecting 14. Joendry Vargas and Victor Rodrigues had two hits each, while Jaron Elkins (6) homered and scored two runs. Eduardo Guerrero had a hit, a walk and two runs scored.

UP-AND-DOWN ROAD TRIP: This road trip has not been nearly as consistent as the Quakes have played overall in 2025, as they've won just three of the first eight games. After suffering just their second series-loss of the year in Stockton (2-4), the Quakes have split the first two games here in Modesto. They played one of their better games of the year in Tuesday's win, only to follow that up with a rough loss on Wednesday. Rancho's offense is still tops in the league at .271 with a league-best 40 homers in 47 games. Their ERA (3.86) is second only to San Jose (3.31).

THE BIG Q: Eduardo Quintero has been playing at an MVP-caliber level in 2025. He's currently tied for the league lead with eight homers, seventh in the league in RBIs (31),on-base percentage (.418) and average (.313). He also leads the league in slugging (.558) and is third in OPS at .970. MLB Pipeline rates him as the Dodgers' eighth-best prospect. **ROSTER MOVES:** On Wednesday, the Quakes activated INF Mairo Martinus from the Temporary Inactive List. On Tuesday, C Gio Cueto was activated from the IL and RHP Domingo Geronimo was added from Great Lakes. RHP Michael Vilchez was placed on the Development List, RHP Jholbran Herder and LHP Octavio Becerra were both placed on the IL, while Angel Diaz was sent to the ACL.

SO LONG, MODESTO: 2025 marks the final season of professional baseball in Modesto, CA. In 2026, the franchise rights will be moved to Ontario, CA. The city of Modesto has had professional baseball and has been a member of the California League since 1946. Modesto has won 11 Cal League titles, including the last two (2023-2024). They have played at John Thurman Field since 1955 and have gone by the Nuts, the Athletics, the Red and the Colts.

JAKOB WRIGHT: 21-year-old left-hander Jakob Wright makes his fourth appearance of his pro career and first against Modesto. Wright has been on the Injured List once in 2025 and also missed a nearly-three-week stretch where he actually never went on the IL. In his last outing, he started and pitched just one inning in a no-decision at Stockton on May 23rd, allowing one walk with one strikeout over a scoreless frame. It marked his first outing in 19 days. Wright was drafted by the Dodgers in the fourth round of the 2024 draft out of Cal Poly Pomona.

JETER MARTINEZ: 19-year-old right-hander Jeter Martinez makes his eighth start of the year and his first against the Quakes. In his last outing overall, he allowed four runs (three earned) on four hits and four walks over 3.1 innings in a no-decision at Inland Empire on May 22nd. Martinez signed with the Mariners in January of 2023 out of Mexico. **BROADCAST HOME:** Catch all the 2025 action with the "Voice of the Quakes" Mike Lindskog, from the ease of your phone, smart device or computer.
