MORROBEL MAGIC: Yeison Morrobel became the first player to hit for the cycle in Spartanburgers history on Tuesday in Greensboro. Morrobel started the game with a bang, homering on the first pitch. After a strikeout and a groundout, the lefty doubled in two runs in the 6th. He tripled with two outs in the 7th. Down to the final out, Luke Hanson extended the game for Morrobel in the 9th. He singled to record the cycle. Rafe Perich hit right after, needing a triple for the cycle. Instead he hit a 2nd HR.

MOORE IS THE MAN: Malcolm Moore became the first Hub City player to receive a South Atlantic League honor for his outburst in Asheville. Moore was dubbed SAL Player of the Week after a four-homer week. The former first-rounder hit 13-25 with 10 RBIs. Malcolm followed it up with a 6-18 week against Rome with 2 HRs. He drove in three of the four runs in the win on Sunday. Moore has started 10 of the last 12 games behind the plate for Hub City. He has caught 9 baserunners stealing during that stretch.

DJ'S DAY & THE MONTH OF MAY: DJ McCarty matched a career high on Sunday with 6.0 innings pitched, and for the first time in his career did so in scoreless fashion. McCarty also matched a career high in strikeouts with eight. He paved the way for Hub City's second shutout of the year, both coming last week against Rome. With the win, Hub City split the series and improved to 14-7 in the month of May. The Spartanburgers have not lost a series since Mid-April.

COLE & COLE: The Rangers have found a pair of trusty Independent League relievers from the free agent market in the last six months. Cole Stasio signed in January after pitching in Ogden in the Pioneer League. Stasio is 3-0 with a 1.19 ERA in his first 15 appearances in the minors. Opponents are hitting 0.80 against the former Baylor Bear. Cole Roland signed May 10 after starting the year in Hagerstown in the Atlantic League. Roland has not allowed a run in his first four outings.

HELLO GREENSBORO: The Spartanburgers and Grasshoppers match up for the first time in 2026. After this week, the two will meet for 9 more games across July and August. Last year, Greensboro won the season series over Hub City 7-5.

The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the

Down East Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager. The Spartanburgers play in the south division of the South Atlantic League. Chad Comer served as the first manager in Spartanburg's history, leading Hub City to a SAL South Division Championship in 2025. The Spartanburgers lost in the SAL Championship to the Brooklyn Cyclones, finishing the year 67-68.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ballpark seats over 5,000 people.



The Johnson Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Spartanburgers game was a 5-3 win over Bowling Green on April 15, 2025. Cole Swindell headlined the first concert in June 2025. Fifth Third Park hosted a record 4,798 fans in 2025 on the 4th of July for a Spartanburgers game and the Red, White & Boom celebration.



Carlos Maldonado - Manager

Maldonado begins his 11th year coaching in the Rangers organization and first with Hub City in 2026. He joins Hub City after spending three years as the Single-A manager and three years managing in the ACL and DSL. In 2023, he led Down East to a championship appearance. Maldonado was born in Maracaibo, Venezuela and signed as a free agent with the Mariners at age 17 in 1995. After time in the Mariners, Astros, White Sox and Pirates orgs, the catcher made his MLB debut with Pittsburgh in 2006. He played in 21 MLB games for the Pirates in 2006 & 2007 and 8 games for the Nationals in 2010 & 2012.



Mason Milkey - Pitching Coach

Milkey begins his 4th year coaching in the Rangers organization and first with Hub City in 2026. Milkey served as the pitching coach for the Arizona Complex League Rangers in 2024 & 2025 after spending his first year in the organization as a pitching coach in the Dominican Summer League. Milkey spent this past offseason as a pitching coach for the Caimanes de Barranquilla in the Columbian Professional Baseball League. Milkey was born in Edmonds, Washington and played collegiately for Whitman College.



Brian Pozos - Hitting Coach

Pozos begins his 5th year coaching in the Rangers organization and first with Hub City. Pozos served as the hitting coach in Single-A for the past three seasons and spent one year in the ACL in 2022. Pozos was a member of the 2023 Down East coaching staff that reached to the Carolina League Championship Series. Pozos was born in Burbank, California. The former infielder spent his first three collegiate years playing for the University of Portland before transferring to Chico State for his final two seasons.



Jorge Cortes - Development Coach

Cortes begins his 3rd year in the Rangers organization and first with Hub City after 7 years coaching in the D-Backs org. Cortes played 10 seasons in the minor leagues and played in the 2004 Futures Game representing the Altoona Curve. The former outfielder was born in Barranquilla, Colombia. He served as Colombia's hitting coach in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.



Landon Lassiter - Development Coach

Lassiter joins the Rangers organization this year after three years in the Orioles org. He previously worked as a scout for the Rays and started his coaching career as an assistant at Boston College. Lassiter was born in Thomasville, North Carolina and played collegiately for North Carolina. He was drafted in 2015 by the White Sox and played three years in their system.

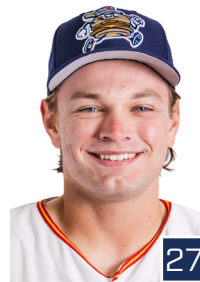
