#### MYERS, JOHNSTON POWER JUMBO SHRIMP

Dane Myers and Troy Johnston each homered on Sunday as Jacksonville bested Columbus 8-4. The Jumbo Shrimp got on the board in the top of the second on Santiago Chavez's RBI single. After a Clippers run in the bottom of the second, Myers went yard in the third. Columbus tied again in the bottom of the third. However, Jacksonville, aided by Johnston's three-run shot, scored four times in the fourth to take control. Columbus got a run back in the fifth before Peyton Burdick drove in two with a triple in the seventh A Clippers ninth-inning tally set the score at 8-4.

#### TROY MEETS WORLD

After struggling in Jacksonville to close the 2022 season, Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City this year. In 28 games with Jacksonville, Johnston is 42-for-115 (.365/.426/.617/1.043) with nine doubles, one triple, six home runs and 26 RBIs. Johnston has reached base at least once in every game, registering 15 multi-hit contests. His 28-game on-base streak is the longest by a Jacksonville hitter since Kenny Wilson, who reached base in 29 straight games from August 5-September 6, 2015. On the season, Johnston's 109 RBIs have come in just 111 games, and rank second in Minor League Baseball.

#### 'PEN PALS

Over the last two-plus weeks, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 18 games the club has played since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 26 runs, 21 earned, on 53 hits (7.8 H/9) in 61.1 innings for a 3.30 ERA. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to strike out 84 batters (12.3 K/9) against 38 walks (5.6 BB/9).

#### **HIGH FIVE!**

Jacksonville posted eight runs offensively on Sunday at Columbus, marking the 16th time in the last 24 games that the club has still tallied at least five runs. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp rank tied for second in the IL in hits (241), third in batting average (.287), fourth in OBP (.376), tied for sixth in doubles (44) and seventh in both runs scored (141 5.9 per game) and OPS (.822). Jacksonville was hitting just .256/.341/.417/.758 with 525 runs scored in 101 games (5.2 per game) as a team prior to this run.

#### SO CLOSE, AND YET, SO FAR

After winning the opening contest of a two-week, 12-game road trip on August 15 at Lehigh Valley, Jacksonville woke up in a tie for third place, only a half-game out of first. The Jumbo Shrimp have gone on to drop seven of their next 11 contests on their two-week road trip to fall to back into a tie for eighth place in the IL second-half standings, 3.5 games out of first place. Of those seven losses, five have come by three runs or fewer, including three by one run. Beginning Tuesday, Jacksonville has perhaps their best remaining chance to gain ground in the standings: a six-game home set against Charlotte, which is 11-40 (.216) in the second half.

#### IFRARSSIC PARK

Jerar Encarnacion endured a terrible slump in the middle of the year. In 46 games from May 16-July 14, the Bayaguana, D.R., native went just 23-for-163 (.141/.258/.380/.638) at the plate with just one double, one triple, 12 home runs. 19 RBIs and 24 walks (12.6 BB%). Encarnacion struck out a remarkable 80 times, a rate of 42.1 percent over his 190 plate appearances. In his last 24 games, however, the 26-year-old is 22-for-80 (.275/.404/.513/.917) with four doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs and 18 walks (18.9 BB%). Encarnacion has trimmed his strikeout rate to 34.3 percent (34 in 99 PA) during this recent hot stretch.

#### MEN OF STEAL

While Jacksonville ranks just 11th in the 20-team International League in stolen bases with 107, the club has been exceptional in their efficiency at swiping bags. The Jumbo Shrimp have been successful on stealing a base at 82.3 percent of their attempts, a figure that ranks fifth in Triple-A. Over their last 12 games dating back to August 14, Jacksonville base runners have been successful on 11 of 13 stolen base attempts (84.6 percent).

#### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has made 18 errors over their last 18 games, tied for the most in Triple-A during that span. However, the Jumbo Shrimp also rank in a tie for fifth at the level with 19 double plays during that span... Over his first 12 outings of 2023 Daniel Castano had a 2.65 ERA. He gave up 16 runs, 12 earned, on 14 hits in 11.2 innings (9.26 ERA) with 11 strikeouts against six walks in two starts over the road trip.
