ABOUT LAST NIGHT... After two runs scored through two batters in the top of the first, the Vancouver Canadians blanked the Hillsboro Hops (Diamondbacks) over 27 outs and rallied to win 3-2 Wednesday night at Ron Tonkin Field.

Adam Kloffenstein got the start and found himself trailing 2-0 after a lead-off double and a two-run home run, but the 20-year-old bore down and struck out the side before going on to work a total of 5.2 innings in which he scattered three hits, three walks and K'd a season-high seven batters.

Vancouver started their comeback in the bottom of the first. Luis De Los Santos tripled to start the frame before Tanner Morris singled him home to make it 2-1. Davis Schneider's lead-off home run in the bottom of the second - his fifth of the year and second in his last three games - tied the game at two.

Kloffenstein and Hops starter Marcos Tineo (L, 0-1) dueled into the sixth before Will McAffer (W, 1-3) came on with two outs and a man aboard before retiring the only batter he needed to face to strand the go-ahead run on base. He pitched a scoreless seventh before the C's got to Tineo in the bottom of that inning. With a runner at third and two outs, a wild pitch brought home Will Robertson - who had singled earlier in the frame - to put the Canadians ahead 3-2 for their first lead of the night.

McAffer passed the baton to Hagen Danner, who worked around a pair of two-out walks to leave the tying and go-ahead runs on base before Cobi Johnson (S, 2) stranded a lead-off single at first to hang a zero in the ninth and secure the 3-2 win.

BATTLE FOR THE 'BORO: Vancouver and Hillsboro go head-to-head this week in their third of five series this season. It's the first time the C's have been the home team; they're 6-6 in 12 games against the Hops at Ron Tonkin Field in 2021. The Canadians took four of six in their first meeting May 18-23 before the Diamondbacks affiliate did the same July 13-18. These two teams are evenly matched; the C's have outscored the Hops 62-57 so far.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN BASEBALL HISTORY: August 5, 1921 - Pittsburgh's radio station KDKA provides listeners with the first-ever broadcast of a major league game. Harold Arlin, detailing the action in the Pirates' 8-5 victory over the Phillies at Forbes Field, becomes baseball's first play-by-play announcer.

IMPRESSIVE SHOWING: Adam Kloffenstein, Will McAffer, Hagen Danner and Cobi Johnson combined to shutout the Hops from the third batter of the game until the final out.

BACK-TO-BACK-BACK: Last night was the first time the Canadians have won three consecutive games since July 10-13, when they beat Spokane twice to end the series then took down the Hops 3-2 behind Eric Rivera's eighth inning two-out RBI single. That stretch was the last time the C's had won three in a row since June 6-9 between Eugene and Spokane. The last time they won four straight was May 16-May 20, the final four games of the historic eight-game winning streak.

THE T-MO SHOW: Tanner Morris has quietly put together one of the best stretches at the plate by any C's hitter this year. He has a hit in his last eight games - 11-31 (.355), 2 2B, 2 R, 4 RBI, 3 BB - to match a personal high, which he set July 13-22 (16-30 [.533], 2 2B, HR, 5 R, 7 RBI, 5 BB). Since that first streak, he has a knock in 16 of his last 17 and 22 of the last 27 games he's played in. The former Virginia Cavalier has raised his average 35 points in the last month.

ON THE SCHNEID: Davis Schneider continues to excel despite limited starting opportunities. His homer last night was his second in the last three games he's played in and third in his last eight. In 11 July games, the Voorhees, NJ native hit .359 (14-39), got on base 41% of the time and slugged .564 while raising his average from .121 to .253.

ON THE HILL: Burlington, Ontario's Alex Nolan makes his first start of the year for Vancouver. He's worked solely in relief so far this year, but he's logged 7.2 innings over his last two outings including 4.1 frames against Everett on July 23 when he allowed one run on one hit. Nolan, 25, is in the midst of his second professional season; he signed with Toronto as a free agent out of Brock University in 2019 and debuted for the C's where he went 1-3 with a 3.22 ERA in 12 games (six starts) across 58.2 innings in the Northwest League. He was released during the pandemic but resigned this year and began the season with Low-A Dunedin.

Kyler Stout makes a spot start for Hillsboro. He has worked solely in relief this year; through 18 games, the right-hander is 0-2 with a 3.50 ERA across 18 innings pitched. Stout, 26, was an 18th round pick (549th overall) in 2018 out of Oral Roberts, where he was an All-Summit League First Team reliever and broke the Golden Eagles' all-time saves record with 28 over four seasons.
