TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve play their final series of the regular season against their slated playoff opponent, the Erie SeaWolves.

Max Alba makes his first career start against Altoona tonight. A 26-year-old, Alba was signed by the Tigers as a minor league free agent in July of 2022, his first foray into pro ball came as a 39th round selection in 2018 out of Liberty. He attended Franklin HS in Franklin, Wisconsin.

No. 1: Baseball's top prospect, Konnor Griffin, has a hit in 15-of-18 games with the Curve, batting .348 (24-for-69) with a 1.034 OPS since joining the Curve on Monday, August 18. He has 6 multi-hit games since joining the Curve and has reached base safely in each of his last 16 games played.

Griffin, at 19 years, 3 months and 26 days, is the youngest player in franchise history to suit up for The Curve. Griffin is the tenth player in franchise history, just the third infielder, to join Altoona while ranked as the No. 1 prospect in baseball, first since Paul Skenes in 2023. Griffin ranks among all minor league players in runs scored (1st, 114), stolen bases (9th, 65), hits (3rd, 157), 4th in RBI (94), 6th in OPS (.952) and batting average. (5th, .334).

Griffin is the first Pirates minor leaguer to steal 60 bases since Manny Ravelo stole 70 bases in 2001 with Single-A Lynchburg and Hickory.

PLAY THE SONG: For the first time since 2018, the Altoona Curve will play postseason ball after they eliminated the Richmond Flying Squirrels with a 4-2 win on Sunday, September 7. Altoona will host Erie for Game One of the Southwest Division series on Tuesday, September 16 at PNG Field, just the second time in franchise history the teams will match up in the playoffs. The Curve swept the SeaWolves in 2004 on their way to a championship series defeat at New Hampshire.

TERMINATING: Infielder Termarr Johnson has gone 13-for-33 (.394) across his last 11 games, adding 10 walks for a .545 onbase percentage. Johnson turned in his most well-rounded month of the season in August, batting .318 with 4 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR and 10 RBI (.798 OPS) leads the club with 32 multi-hit games this season.

20 NICK'S: First baseman Nick Cimillo is the first Curve batter since 2022 (Andres Alvarez, Aaron Shackelford) to hit 20 homers in a season with Altoona. Cimillo, who is fourth among PIT MiLB ibehind teammates Esmerlyn Valdez (26), Konnor Griffin (21) and Javier Rivas (21), returned from the All-Star break with a vengeance. In his last 42 games, he's picked up 27 extra base hits (.277 BA, 1.020 OPS). Cimillo led all Double-A players with 11 HR the most in a calendar month since Brad Eldred in August of 2005 hit 11.

Cimillo had an 11 game hit streak end on September 11, batting .400 (18-for-45), with 4 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 17 RBI, with an insane 1.371 OPS, though he still holds a 12-game on-base streak entering play on Friday night.

DUCE IS LOOSE: Infielder Duce Gourson has emerged as one of Altoona's most underrated players in the Second Half of the season. In his last 25 games, he is 32-for-91 (.352) with 4 2B, 3 HR, 11 RBI and 17 BB (since August 7). Gourson had a seasonlong 12-game hit streak end on Thursday, September 4, he has reached in 16 straight games overall.

THE 'MERYLN OF VALDEZ: Outfielder Esmerlyn Valdez homered four times across three games August 28-30, marking the first time in his career that he's homered in three straight games. Valdez leads all Pirates minor leaguers with 26 homers this season. In August, Valdez batted .311 with a 1 2B, 6 HŘ and 19 RBI, he ranked 3rd among Eastern League players in HR and 4th in RBI in the calendar month.

In his last 12 games, Valdez has a hit in 9 of them, he's gone 18-for-48 (.375) with 3 2B, 4 HR, 12 RBI, totaling a 1.144 OPS.

RECORD WATCH: Righty Wilber Dotel finished his regular season in the top-5 of strikeouts in a single-season in franchise history. His 131 strikeouts are 4th-most in a single season in franchise history, right behind **Rudy Owens'** mark of 132 strikeouts in 2010. Ian Snell holds the franchise record with 142 strikeouts in 2004.

THE SAGINAW KID: Infielder Mitch Jebb has 33 stolen bases this season, 5th-most by an Eastern League player this year. He is the first Curve player to steal 30 bases in a season since **Jared Oliva** stole 36 bases in 2019. Only two players in franchsie history (**Rajai Davis** and **Rich Thompson** in 2005) have stolen 40 bases in a season for the Curve.

ALTOONA CURVE COACHING STAFF

Andy Fox Manager (1st Season) Career Record: 45-94

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

Matt Ford **Pitching Coach** 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005). His 14-year playing career wrapped up in 2009 after a season in Korea and two seasons in Japan. He is a native of McKeesport, PA.

Casey Harms Hitting Coach 1st season/11th overall

Harms begins his fifth season as a Pirates instructor in 2025 and ioins Altoona after serving as Greensboro's Bench Coach in 2024. Harms joined the Pirates in 2021 as the Hitting Coach in the FCL. He played outfield at Division III Occidental College in Los Angeles and went on to coach in the collegiate ranks at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018) and Santa Barbara City College (2019-2021). He also spent two seasons as the Manager for the Waterloo Bucks in the Northwoods League (2019-20) and led the team to a 28-13 record and a league championship in 2020.

Gary Green Bench Coach 4th season/20th overall

Green returns for a fourth season in Altoona and his 20th season as a minor league instructor with the Pirates. He has previously served as the Bench Coach in Indianapolis (2022) as well as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Field Instructor for the Pirates (2011-2021). A Pittsburgh native, Green's father, Fred, won a World Series with the Pirates in 1960. Green spent 11 seasons managing in the Tigers minor league system (99-10). A former Major League infielder for parts of five seasons, Green was drafted 27th overall by the Padres in 1984 and played on Team USA in the 1984 Olympic Games.
