The Fightin Phils finish a six-game series with the Portland Sea Dogs on Sunday night. It is the 18th-of-21 matchups between the teams this season and final-of-12 in Reading. Reading won the season-series over Portland last season 11-9, with a 5-3 record at home, and 6-6 on the road. The teams play next at Portland from July 19-21. Portland currently leads the season-series 11-6.

The Fightin Phils rode timely offense and clutch pitching to a 5-2 win over Portland on Saturday night. Reading struck first with two runs in the second inning, thanks to a RBI single from Trevor Schwecke, then Bryce Ball doubled home Schwecke. Portland tied the game up at two in the top of the fifth. Carlos De La Cruz then launched his third home run of the week, a solo shot, into right-center field to put Reading up 3-2. Otto Kemp added the insurance runs with his second home run of the week, a drive to left-center field to make it 5-2. Tristan Garnett and Eury Ramos each picked up holds with scoreless frames of relief, including two for Garnett. Then, Tommy McCollum danced around three walks and some trouble for a scoreless ninth and his seventh save.

### Carlos De La Cruzin

Carlos De La Cruz continued his hot week on Saturday night with two hits and a go-ahead home run in the fifth inning. So far this week, De La Cruz is slashing .364/.440/.773, with a 1.213 OPS. He's added eight runs, three home runs and six RBI. For the month of June, De La Cruz is slashing .333/.433/.686, with a 1.119 OPS. In June, he's added 15 runs, 3 doubles, five home runs and 13 RBI. De La Cruz has the ninth-best batting average in the Eastern League in June (minimum 20 ABs). His other June ranks are: runs (T-1st), hits (T-5th), home runs (2nd), RBI (T-4th) and OPS (7th).

Kendall Simmons is currently riding a 17-game on-base streak dating back to May 21. Over that streak, he's slashing .298/.429/.632, with a 1.061 OPS. He's added 13 runs, two doubles, one triple, five homers and 14 RBI over that stretch. Simmons 17-game on-base streak is currently the longest active streak in the Eastern League, after Blaze Jordan's 20-game on-base streak was snapped Friday night.

The Fightin Phils have been hitting home runs at a much-higher clip as of late. After hitting two home runs Saturday night, Reading has homered in 10-of-11 games. Additionally, the Fightin Phils are now second in the Eastern League with 63 home runs hit this season. In June, Reading has hit 21 home runs, which is best in the Eastern League this month. Erie is in second place with 18. The Fightin Phils 21 home runs in June also lead all of Double-A for the month.

Otto Kemp has had an excellent first week in Baseballtown since being called up from High-A Jersey Shore on Tuesday. This week, Kemp is 5-18, with four runs, two doubles, two home runs and eight RBI. Four-of-his-five hits have been for extra-bases and he has an OPS of 1.131. Kemp's reached base in all five games with Reading and has a four-game hitting streak. Kemp's eight RBI are second in the Eastern League for the week.

Marcus Lee Sang's diving catch in the second inning of Friday night's game was on ESPN SportsCenter Friday night as the number eight play on it's daily top-10 plays. It's the first time a Fightin Phils play was on SportsCenter since Johan Rojas' diving catch against Richmond on July 3, 2023.

Portland enters tonight in second place in the Eastern League's Northeast Divison with a 33-29 record. Portland most recently split a series at home against the Akron RubberDucks. Following this week, Portland returns home and welcomes Richmond to Hadlock Field. Portland's roster features 10 players ranked amongst the Boston Red Sox top-30 prospects: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (3), Wikelman Gonzalez (5), Luis Pereles (9), Blaze Jordan (19), Eddinson Paulino (22), Hunter Dobbs (25), Angel Bastardo (26) and Kristian Campbell (30).

Righty Bryan Mata will make a big-league rehab appearance with Portland tonight. Mata is on the Red Sox 40-man roster, but has yet to make his Major League debut. He was placed on the 15-day IL March 28 with a right-hamstring strain. Mata's made one-rehab appearance each with Portland, High-A Greenville and the FCL-Red Sox. In 2023, Mata went 0-3, with a 6.33 ERA over nine games and seven starts for Triple-A Worcester. The 25-year old signed with Boston in 2016 at 16-years old as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela.

2024 Notes: On Fightin Phils Opening Day Roster. Hit around in Apr. 6 loss at Bowie. Allowed eight-earned runs on seven hits in just 2.1 innings pitched. Eight runs allowed were a career high. Struggled in second-straight outing on Apr. 13 vs Portland. Allowed five-earned runs, including two more homers, while suffering second-straight loss. Also racked up season-high four walks and four strikeouts. Four walks was one shy of career-high. Was on Development List from Apr. 14-21. Struggled with comman Apr. 21 at Binghamton, lasing just 2.2 innings and walking four for second-straight outing. Placed on 7-day II. Apr. 23 and activated prior to start on May 8. Best outing of season May 8 vs Hartford, where he tossed season-high 4.1 innings pitched in no-decision. Lasted just one-plus inning May 16 at RIC, allowing five hits and six runs in loss to Flying Squirrels. Allowed three-earned runs over four innings May 21 vs BNG. First win of season came in best outing of year May 26 vs BNG. Pitched four innings out of bullpen, serving as bulk guy behind Kolby Allard. Struck out season-high eight hitters and allowed just one walk and run. Came out of bullpen for second-straight outing May 31 at HFD, allowing three runs over four innings. Suffered fourth loss June 8 vs HBG, allowing five runs on six hits over four innings.

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Signed a minor league contract with the San Diego Padres as an International Free Agent on July 8, 2017. Elected free agency from the Padres on November 6, 2023. Signed a minor league contract with the Philadelphia Phillies on December 16, 2023.

2023: Spent the entire season with Double-A San Antonio in the Padres organization. Led the team in strikeouts and innings pitched. Earned his first win since 2019 on May 11 against Corpus Christi, pitching six innings, allowing no-earned runs, and picking up eight strikeouts. Had a 3.88 strikeout to walk ratio (31 SO, 8 BB) in five May starts and struck out 31.8% of the batters faced (34-107) in five June starts. Had at least six strikeouts in seven-straight games from May 23 through June 28, which was tied for the longest such streak in the Texas League. Pitched in one postseason game.
