**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Curve, 4-1, to snap a five-game losing streak. **Justin Wishkoski** opened the scoring with a sac fly in the top of the second inning. **Carter Howell** picked up an RBI on a fielding error by the Curve later in the second to open a 2-0 lead. In the fourth, **Victor Bericoto** drove a two-run single to extend the lead to 4-0. The Curve broke the shutout with an RBI single by **Tres Gonzalez** in the bottom of the eighth. **Nick Morreale** made his first Double-A start for Richmond and worked four scoreless innings, striking out three. **Nick Swiney** followed him out of the bullpen and threw three scoreless innings, striking out four. **Mat Olsen** closed his fourth save of the season, covering the final four outs. The Flying Squirrels offense had 10 hits, including two each by **Ismael Munguia**, **Howell** and **Morgan**, but went 2-for-13 with runners in scoring position and stranded 10 runners on base.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, in the finale of a six-game series at PNG Field. This is the first of two trips to Altoona for Richmond this year. The Flying Squirrels won two-of-six at The Diamond from June 4-9, dropping the final four games of the series. The Curve also return to Richmond for a six-game set from August 20-25 and the Flying Squirrels close the regular season in Altoona from September 10-15.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 5-12 in their last 17 games dating back to July 13 after winning their previous four games. They had lost five straight games from Sunday through Friday before beating the Curve on Saturday night. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .228 and averaging 3.75 runs per game (191 runs/51 games) at home compared to a .232 batting average and 4.62 runs per game on the road (231 runs/50 games).

**THE CURVE** have gone 4-1 in the series after going 1-8 in their previous nine games. Altoona's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including RHP **Bubba Chandler** (No. 1), RHP **Thomas Harrington** (No. 5), INF/OF **Charles McAdoo** (No. 12), INF **Tsung-Che Cheng** (No. 13) and LHP **Hunter Barco** (No. 16). MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes seven Altoona players, including **Chandler** (No. 1), **Harrington** (No. 6), **Cheng** (No. 8), **Barco** (No. 13), OF **Jase Bowen** (No. 19), OF **Tres Gonzalez** (No. 26) and **McAdoo** (No. 29).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **John Michael Bertrand** makes his league-leading 21st start of the season and his fourth this year against the Curve. In the first game of this week's series on Tuesday, Bertrand was charged with a loss after surrendering four runs over 5.1 innings. Over his six July starts, Bertrand went 3-2 with a 2.25 ERA (9 ER/36.0 IP). This season, he leads the Eastern League and ranks second in the minors in double plays induced (15). He also leads the league in groundball percentage (52.1%). Bertrand is tied for first in the league in games started (21), second in innings pitched (112.2), sixth in ERA (3.43) and eighth in WHIP (1.20). Bertrand also faced the Curve on June 4 and threw six scoreless innings with eight strikeouts in a win. In the finale of that series on June 9, he allowed five runs over six innings in a loss. This year, he has made eight scoreless starts, all at least five innings, which is the most in the Eastern League. Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. **For more on Bertrand, see page two.**

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **Brad Case** makes his eighth Double-A appearance of the year and his second of the series. He pitched on Wednesday night and allowed two runs, recording two outs. It was his first outing back with the Curve after spending time on the injured list from May through July. Case began the season with the Curve, his fourth season spending time in Altoona dating back to 2021. He has also pitched three games with Triple-A Indianapolis this season and four games on a rehab assignment between the Florida Complex League and Low-A Bradenton. Case was selected by the Pirates in the 17th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of NCAA DII Rollins College in Florida.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Flying Squirrels have turned 74 double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Altoona is ranked second with 69. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 15 double plays this year, which is the most in the league, ahead of three pitchers tied for second with 11, including Altoona's **Po-Yu Chen**. It is also the second-most in the minors. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. On July 10 against the Senators, **Seth Lonsway** induced three double plays, which is tied for the most by one pitcher in a game in the league this year. Bertrand matched that with three double plays behind him on July 19 against the RubberDucks.

**KING OF THE HILL:** **Turner Hill** is batting .367 (11-for-30) with two doubles, a triple and five RBIs in his last eight games dating back to July 23, including three multi-hit games. He went 3-for-4 last Sunday afternoon against the Rumble Ponies, including a double. In his next game played on Wednesday at Altoona, he again picked up three hits, including a double. On Thursday night, he belted a bases-clearing, three-run double. Since his Double-A debut on June 27, Hill is ranked seventh in the Eastern League in batting average (.302).

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 42 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .301 (50-for-166) with three homers, eight doubles, eight walks and 20 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he has not homered in his last 32 games. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 14-of-34 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .298 (39-for-131) in that stretch.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked eighth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,653), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

**LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS:** There have been 57 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which is three shy of the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 28 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes an appearance by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves. There have been 30 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season. In this week's series at Altoona, three players have made their Flying Squirrels debuts, including **Zach Morgan**, **Justin Wishkoski**, **Justin Wishkoski** and **Julio Rodriguez**. Pitcher **Jack Choate** was assigned to the Flying Squirrels this week but has not yet debuted.

**DEADLINE DEALS:** The MLB trade deadline was Tuesday at 6 p.m. and Flying Squirrels reliever **Eric Silva** was traded to the Detroit Tigers for **Mark Canha** and will join the Erie SeaWolves. Silva became the fifth player all time traded from the Flying Squirrels at trade deadline time. The most recent deadline day trades directly impacting the Flying Squirrels were in 2021. That year, pitcher **Caleb Kilian** was traded to the Cubs as part of a deal for **Kris Bryant** and reliever **Jose Marte** was sent to the Angels as part of a package for **Tony Watson**. In 2012, catcher **Tommy Joseph** was traded from the Flying Squirrels along with two other players to the Phillies for **Hunter Pence**. In 2010, pitcher **Daniel Turpen** was swapped to the Red Sox for **Ramon Ramirez**. Current Flying Squirrels catcher **Andy Thomas** was a trade deadline acquisition for the Giants along with reliever **Michael Stryfeler** in 2022 for **Matthew Boyd** and **Curt Casali**. In 2022, **Tristan Peters** became the only players sent straight to Richmond after being traded at the deadline when he was picked up from the Brewers for **Trevor Rosenthal**.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** One of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, which is **SS Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including **Velasquez** (No. 18), OF/1B **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).
