**Today** is the fifth of a six-game series and an 18-game season series between the Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and Captains, High-A affiliate of the Guardians. The Nuts are 131-140 all-time vs. Lake County, 60-77 in Eastlake, 1-3 so far this year.

**Yesterday: Lansing 8, Lake County 7.** On a long, twisting night, the Nuts and Caps waited through a 31-minute delay and then played for 3:08. Lansing took a 2-0 lead in the first inning, the Captains tallied three unanswered runs, the Lugnuts took a 6-3 lead with four runs in the fourth, Lake County tied the game in the fifth, each team scored in the sixth for a 7-7 tie, and then the Nuts won the ballgame on a run-scoring throwing error by Jeffrey Mercedes in the eighth.

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts and Captains wrap things up with a Sunday matinee before Lansing returns to Michigan's state capital to welcome in archrival West Michigan.

### LUG-NOTES

**Prospecting:** The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**) and No. 24 (**Nate Nankil**). Baseball America's recent re-ranking of A's prospects puts Devin Taylor at No. 10, Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

**Starting Spotlight:** Taipei native **Tzu-Chen Sha** took on Lake County three times last year. On July 26 in Eastlake, he allowed one run on two hits in four innings in a no-decision; on August 26 in Lansing, he allowed five runs on seven hits in four innings, taking the loss (with a home run served up to Ryan Cesarini); and on August 31, he was saddled with another loss, giving up six runs on nine hits in just 4 2/3 innings in his penultimate appearance of the year.

**Breaking Out:** Before his 1-for-3, 2-BB, 3-R performance yesterday, **Ali Camarillo** had been in a 1-for-19 slump with two runs and two walks in his last six games.

**Casey at the Bat:** **Casey Yamauchi** notched his sixth 3-hit game of the season yesterday; he's 23-for-60 this month, with a .383 average, a .465 OBP and a .948 OPS.

**Atop the MWL:** Lansing's offense has struck out just 351 times this season, the lowest total in the Midwest League and the third lowest total in all of Minor League Baseball. **Casey Yamauchi** topped the circuit last year in K% (7.5%) and is repeating again this year (9.4%). The three lowest swinging strike percentage hitters in the MWL are all Lugnuts: **Davis Diaz** (3.7%), **Justin Riemer** (4.4%) and **Yamauchi** (4.7%). No player in the Midwest League has seen more pitches than **Devin Taylor** (860, 99 more than the next highest hitter, 5th in all of MiLB), averaging 4.43 pitches per plate appearance.

**Family Ties:** Lansing outfielder **Myles Naylor's** older brother, Bo, played for the Lake County Captains in 2019, batting .243/.313/.421 in 107 games, with 18 doubles, 10 triples and 11 home runs as a 19-year-old. (Myles and Bo's oldest brother, Josh, came up to the Majors through the Marlins' and Padres' systems.)

**Green Power:** On May 12, **Rodney Green, Jr.** launched a 490-foot home run into the second floor of the Outfield Lofts apartments, the longest tracked home run of the 2026 season, Major League or Minor League.

**Bolting to the Show:** The most recent Lugnut to make his MLB debut was 2024 Lugnuts outfielder **Henry Bolte**, who went 2-for-2 for the A's on May 13 to become the 203rd all-time Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues and the third this season (**Daniel Susac**, **Eduardo Rivera**).

**Cooperstown Bound:** An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

### MAY 23 IN LUGNUGS HISTORY

**2016:** Jon Harris struck out 11 in seven scoreless innings for the second straight start, and the Lugnuts won at Dow Diamond, 3-0. In Harris's season debut, Opening Day on April 9 at Great Lakes, he had allowed three runs in 2/3 of an inning. In five starts since then, he allowed one unearned run in 32 innings.

**2018:** In an hour and 56 minutes, the South Bend Cubs beat the Lugnuts, 1-0, on a Miguel Amaya leadoff home run in the bottom of the eighth at Four Winds Field. Nuts starter Zach Logue pitched eight innings, striking out four, and used only 90 pitches, 69 for strikes. The Cubs' Brendon Little allowed three hits in seven innings, striking out five.
