## FRES-NOTES

**KING OF THE HALF:** Tanner Thach heads into the second half as one of the most productive hitters in all of Single-A baseball. The Grizzlies first baseman leads all Single-A players in RBI (68), hits (93), and total bases (150) while ranking second nationally in batting average (.355), tied for second in extra-base hits (33), tied for eighth in home runs (11), and fifth in OPS (.998). No other player in Single-A ranks among the national top five in hits, RBI, total bases, batting average, and OPS simultaneously.

**THE BEST ONE-TWO PUNCH IN SINGLE-A:** Few clubs in Single-A can match the production Fresno has received from Tanner Thach and Roldy Brito. Thach leads all of Single-A in hits, RBI, and total bases, while Brito ranks second nationally in hits (85), fourth in total bases (128), and fourth in RBI (55). The duo occupies the top two spots in the California League hit race and has helped power Fresno to one of the top offensive resumes in the minors entering the second half.

**OFFENSE WITH NATIONAL NUMBERS:** The Grizzlies don't just rank among the California League's best offenses—they stack up with anyone in Single-A baseball. Fresno enters the second half tied for second among all 30 Single-A clubs in batting average (.273), third in hits (623), third in total bases (981), third in RBI (399), and fourth in OPS (.793). Only San Jose and Ontario rank ahead of Fresno among California League clubs in OPS, giving the league three of the nation's top four offenses by that measure.

**FINISHING GAMES IN STYLE:** Close games became a Fresno specialty during the first half. The Grizzlies collected five walk-off victories and enter the second half with one of the California League's strongest late-game combinations. Seth Clausen is tied for second in the league with six saves while Dylan Crooks ranks fifth with five. Clausen owns a 1.74 ERA and .122 opponent average, while Crooks carries a 1.78 ERA and .141 opponent average. Their success has helped Fresno rank second in the California League with 17 saves and provided the backbone for a club that remained in contention throughout the first half.
