FROM THE DOG HOUSE

IN THE WIN COLUMN The RiverDogs secured their first victory of the season last night in dominant fashion, winning 13-5. As a staff, RiverDogs arms punched out 20 Woodpeckers hitters, marking the team's first 20+ strikeout performance since July of 2021 and third overall dating back to 2005. With the bats, the RiverDogs exploded for 13 runs. Six hitters recorded multi-hit games while each of the ten to record a plate appearance reached base at least once. They finished the night going a season-high 7-for-19 with runners in scoring position. In 2025, the club reached the 13-run total twice, scoring 14 runs on back-to-back nights at Kannapolis last June.

CREM OF THE CROP: Right hander **Aidan Cremaresa** dominated in his first professional start last night, fanning 12 Fayetteville hitters over five innings of two-run ball. After allowing a first inning homer, the righty finished the game with 4.1 scoreless innings while allowing just one additional hit. In total he punched out 12 of the 18 total batters he faced. In the process, he became the first RiverDogs arm to strikeout 12 batters since Deivi Garcia in 2018 when the team was affiliated with the Yankees.

WALLACE'S TURN: Right hander **Alex Wallace** is slated to make his professional debut tonight. The 6'8" California native was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 15th round last season out of McLeannan Junior College in Texas. He made 10 starts as a sophomore and pitched to a stout 3.86 ERA. In the process, he fanned 52 hitters over 42 frames. He mixes in a four-seam fastball, change up, cutter and curveball.

CLASH OF THE TAITN: Rays No. 29 prospect **Taitn Gray** led the way offensively last weekend versus Myrtle Beach, finishing 5-for-9 with two extra-base hits. In the process, he reached base at a .636 clip while striking out just once. He enters the week ranking second in the Carolina League in average (.556) and hits (5). He was drafted in the third round last year by the Rays after winning Iowa's Gatorade Player of the Year Award after an illustrious career at Dallas Center-Grimes High School (IA). Only 18 years old, he is lauded for his unique combination of elite bat speed and bat-to-ball skills.

THIS IS 46: The Charleston RiverDogs embark on their 46th season in affiliated baseball in 2026, and 32nd year as the RiverDogs. In 2025, they finished 68-62 and missed the postseason for the first time since 2019, while affiliated with the Yankees. They also seek their seventh consecutive winning season, dating back to 2019. In franchise history, Charleston is 2967-2984, including their time as the Rainbows (1985-93) and the Royals (1980-84). As the RiverDogs they are 2169-2095. They will play the 6000th regular-season game in the franchise's history on Tuesday, May 19 at Hickory.

COASTAL CRUSHER: Rays No. 12 prospect **Caden Bodine** made his organizational debut last weekend after being acquired in the Shane Baz trade from Baltimore last December. In 60 games for the Chanticleers in 2025, the switch hitter slashed .318/.454/.461 with five home runs, anchoring one of the nation's most dominant teams. He guided the club's pitching staff to the second-best ERA in the country, while helping lead the program to a record setting 56 wins, highlighted by a 26-game winning streak and a College World Series Finals appearance. For his efforts, he became the first player in school history to win the Buster Posey Award, presented annually to the nation's top collegiate catcher. He notched his first RiverDogs hit on Friday night.

DP SAYS HELLO: The RiverDogs' Opening Day roster features eight players from the Rays' Top 30 rankings (MLB Pipeline). Leading the way is No. 4 ranked **Daniel Pierce**, the Rays first-round pick (14th overall) from the 2025 draft out of Mill Creek High School (Hoschtong, Georgia), located just under five hours west of Charleston. Pierce is widely praised for his defensive acumen and strong baseball instincts. He will make his professional debut this weekend. He earned his first pro hit with a 107 mph single to left in the second inning on Saturday.
