TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue the second half of their season with a three-game set at Harrisburg.

LAST TIME OUT: The Curve dropped a 2-1 heartbreaker in which they picked up ten hits and six walks.

MY KIND OF FELLOW: Right-hander Drake Fellows has hit his stride in Altoona's rotation, tossing a career-long 7.0 innings and striking out a career-high 9 in a tough-luck 2-1 loss at Harrisburg on July 1. Fellows has allowed 2 runs-or-fewer in 7-of-9 outings with the Curve.

THIS MONTH'S LEADERS: On their way to securing a winning record in the month of June (14-12), several Curve players ranked among the Eastern League leaderboards: INF Joe Perez ranked 4th in RBI (22), RHP Bubba Chandler ranked 7th in ERA (2,49), 2nd in W (3), 4th in WHIP (0.87) and T-2nd in strikeouts (35), Yoyner Fajardo ranked 9th in batting average (.324), and T-2nd in SB (8), and RHP Po-Yu Chen tossed a league-high 36.2 IP.

THE CHEN CHRONICLES: Righty Po-Yu Chen overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as the calendar flipped to June. Chen fired a career-high 8.0 innings and struck out 9 on June 7 at Richmond to lead the Curve to a 3-1 win. Chen allowed just one run four times in his last six outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.88 ERA (13 ER / 40.2 IP) with 31 strikeouts.

BUBBA'S BURGERS: On Thursday, June 27 at PNG Field, **Bubba Chandler** struck out a career-high 11 batters in 6.2 innings against Akron. Chandler's second straight 10K performance was just the third time in franchise history that a Curve pitcher had struck out 10-or-more batters in back-to-back outings joining **Tyler Glasnow** (7/21/15 vs Erie, 7/26/15 vs Akron) and **Roansy Contreras** (5/4/21 vs Bowie and 5/11 at Binghamton). Chandler and **Braxton Ashcraft**'s combined four 10-strikeout games this season make the Curve one of six teams, and the lone team at Double-A or Triple-A, to have two pitchers strikeout 10 or more in a game twice.

Since his return from the IL on May 29, Chandler has walked just 4 batters in 29.1 IP with 38 strikeouts, recording a 3-2 record with a 2.76 ERA (9 ER / 29.1 IP) with a 0.89 WHIP. Chandler was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23), the first to receive the honor since **Mike Burrows** and **Quinn Priester** took home weekly honors during the 2022 season.

Chandler is also the 22nd player in franchise history to be selected to the MLB Futures Game which will take place on July 13 at Globe Life Field, home of the Texas Rangers. Altoona has had 21 players previously selected to the MLB All-Star Futures Game since its inception in 1999. C Henry Davis (2022), and RHP Roansy Contreras (2021) were the most recent players selected to the roster, 3B Ke'Bryan Hayes was the last Curve player to participate in the game, doing so in Washington, DC in 2018. Chandler would become the first active Curve player to pitch in the Futures Game since RHP Dovydas Neverauskas pitched in 2016 at Petco Park in San Diego.

HE WILL McADOO: Infielder Charles McAdoo made his Double-A debut with a bang on Saturday, June 23 at Bowie. McAdoo made a terrific play in the first inning in the field and then went 2B, BB, 2R HR in his first three at-bats for the Curve. McAdoo homered in each of the first two games he played for Altoona. He's reached base in 8-of-9 games joining the Curve, batting 273/.415/.667/1.118 with 2 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 4 RBI, 8 BB, and 10 K. He ranks 1st among PIT MiLB in H (84), 2B (17), RBI (56), T-1st in SB (15), and 1st in OPS (1.003), min. 150 AB's in minor leagues.

A BIG ADDITION: Utilityman Yoyner Fajardo has reached base safely in 16 straight games, during which he's batting .350/.444/.383 with 2 2B, 5 RBI, 10 BB, 8-9 SB. His .324 batting average in June ranks 7th in the Eastern League during the

K SPELLS TROUBLE: Altoona has struck out at least 10 times at the plate in a game 38 times this season in 76 games.

THE MEN FROM THE UPPER CHAMBER: Delino DeShields is back for his second season managing the Washington Nationals Double-A affiliate. Harrisburg features the next wave of Nationals stars highlighted by outfielders Robert Hassell III (IL), and Brady House. OF Dylan Crews was promoted to Triple-A with 6 games remaining in the first half and the Senators narrowly missed out on the SouthWest Division title.

THE FIRST TO FILIBUSTER: Michael Cuevas takes the ball for Harrisburg tonight. Cuevas has started three times against Altoona this season, allowing 7 runs in 16.1 IP, he struck out a career-high 9 in 6.0 IP on April 30. Cuevas was Washington's 23rd round pitck in 2019 out of Brennan HS and works with a low-90's fastball and a good slider and changeup to keep hitters off-balance
