RIDERS TAKE FINALE OVER DRILLERS:

The Frisco RoughRiders trailed in the first inning but came back to win the series finale 4-2 against the Tulsa Drillers on Sunday from Riders Field. Frisco (24-21, 55-58) traded runs with Tulsa (17-28, 58-56) in the first inning, with Kellen Strahm providing the Riders' run on his RBI single to score Trevor Hauver. Evan Carter was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded the next inning to give Frisco the lead. Tied 2-2 in the seventh inning, Frisco scored two runs after Strahm walked and Zavala singled to begin the inning. Chris Seise's sac fly scored the go-ahead run and Scott Kapers tacked on an RBI single. Grant Wolfram (9-0) collected the win with 2.1 innings with one run allowed out of Frisco's bullpen. He struck out three batters. Nick Krauth went 5.1 innings in his start with one run. Justin Slaten recorded the final two outs of the eighth inning with one strikeout and no runs allowed. Antoine Kelly pitched the ninth inning without a run allowed and picked up his 10th save in 10 opportunities this year. Jake Pilarski (1-1) suffered the loss with two runs scoring while pitching the seventh inning. Strahm and Hauver both had multi-hit efforts, while Frainyer Chavez doubled for Frisco's lone extra-base hit. Chavez and Jax Biggers both walked twice and the Riders totaled seven walks while giving up just four.

NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 17 games in August, (9-9 record) the RoughRiders lead the Texas League with a 3.73 ERA while allowing a league-low 14 home runs and .229 BAA. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant on Tuesday in Corpus, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. Nick Krauth then followed up with a second quality start, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when **Owen White** and **Jack Leiter** completed the feat. On the offensive side in the month, Frisco is second-to-last in the Texas League with a .724 OPS and last in runs per game with 4.5 per contest.

WINS AND LOSSES WITH RISP:

The RoughRiders won four in a row in Corpus Christi before losing their last six of their last eight entering Tuesday's game. Over the four wins in a row, the Riders allowed just three runs on the pitching side (0.75 ERA) while scoring 4.8 runs per game and hitting .250 (8-for-32) with runners in scoring position. Over the last eight games, Frisco has allowed 51 runs (5.91 ERA) while scoring 4.3 runs per game and hitting .204 (19-for-93) with runners in scoring position.

THE ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on the road this season. In the second half, Frisco is a league-best 12-9 on the road and they have the second-best road record overall in the Texas League at 30-27. Away from Riders Field, Frisco is averaging a league-best 5.8 runs per game and they have a league-high 107 doubles on the road as well. At home, the Riders are just 23-29 on the season, only trailing Wichita for the worst home record in the Texas League.

HAUV YOURSELF A YEAR:

Trevor Hauver has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 47 games since, he is batting .293/.399/.483/.882 with 13 doubles, six home runs, 29 RBIs and 36 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 35 points and his OPS 91 points.

CARTER WALKS SO THE ROUGHRIDERS CAN RUN:

Evan Carter has been fantastic at drawing walks and getting on base this season. Carter's 71 walks are second in the Texas League despite only playing in 77 percent of the RoughRiders games this year. His 16.4 percent walk rate this year is fourth-highest in the league as well. He has walked 21 times in his last 20 games. His .410 OBP on the season is ninth in all of Double-A and among all 12 players in Double-A with a .400 OBP or better, Carter is the youngest at 20 years old.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 28 games, Hicks is batting .323 (31-for-96)/436/438/.874 with six doubles, a triple, a home run, 14 RBIs, 18 walks and 14 runs scored. In his last 15 games, he is batting .340 (17-for-50) with a .912 OPS.

K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on Thursday in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all nine save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with Evan Carter hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (3) and Evan Carter). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

-Broke into the UW career and single-season record books including: career starts (T6th, 40), innings pitched (3rd, 284), career strikeouts (6th, 205) and single-season strikeouts (7th, 103) over his three seasons.
